Providing social security to citizens through Pradhan Mantri Suraksha Bima Yojana

136476 persons insured under the scheme in A&N Islands so far

Port Blair, Oct. 30 Pradhan Mantri Suraksha Bima Yojana (PMSBY) is one of the three social security schemes introduced by Government of India. Launched in May 2015, it is an accident insurance scheme that covers people aged between 18 years and 70 years against death, total disability, and partial disability. The scheme is available to people in the age group of 18 to 70 years with a bank account who give their consent to join / enable auto-debit on or before 31st May for the coverage period 1st June to 31st May on an annual renewal basis. Aadhaar is the



primary KYC for the bank account. Pradhan Mantri Suraksha Bima Yojana covers the policyholders against the healthcare expenses i.e. a benefit of Rs. 2 lakh is given to the nominee in case of an accident leading to the death of the policyholder, a benefit of Rs. 2 lakh is provided in case of permanent total disability and benefit

of Rs. 1 lakh is provided in case of permanent partial disability.

In A&N Islands, 136476 persons have been covered under this insurance scheme upto Sept. 2023. So far, 12 claims have been settled and a sum of Rs. 24 lakh has been disbursed. As per the scheme, a premium of Rs. 20 per annum is to be deducted from the

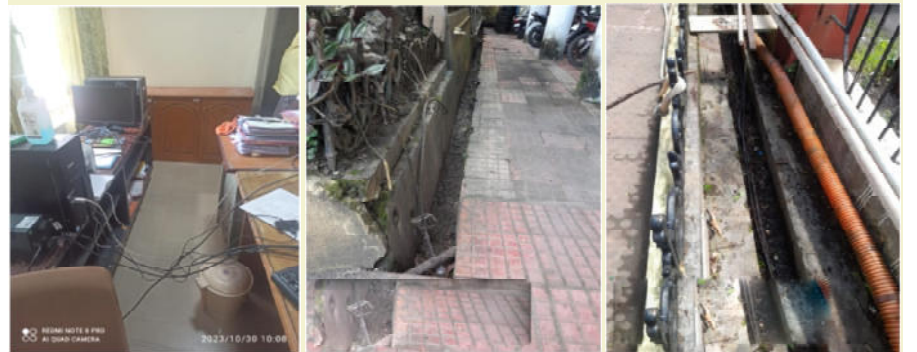

Registration on CBuD App mandatory before excavation on roads and public places by agencies taking up the work

Pot Blair, Oct. 30

Very often various agencies constructing infrastructure projects require digging/cutting of roads and excavating at public places. Such digging/ cutting and excavating at public places often damage the existing underground infra like Optical Fiber Cables, Water Pipelines, Electric Cables, Sewerage Pipelines, etc. of other Utilities Asset Owners causing them huge economic losses, inconvenience to citizen and associated business losses to other stakeholders.

To address this critical issue and ensure the safety and efficiency of excavation activities, Department of Telecommunications,

Ministry of Communications, Government of India has come out with a mobile app 'Call Before u Dig (CBuD)' which provides an interface for excavator agencies/ contractors to send alert/informowners of existing utility assets about their upcoming excavation route. This will enable the utility owners to assist the excavating agencies to identify the route of the existing infrastructure so that damage to the existing infrastructure could be avoided. The mobile app 'Call Before u Dig (CBuD)' was launched by Hon'ble Prime Minister of India on 22.03.2023. All excavators and utility agencies in A&N Islands are advised to register their excavation inquiries on the CBuD

application before commencing any digging activities.

This registration is mandatory and failure to comply with these instructions will be considered a violation of the Indian Telegraph-Infrastructure Safety Rules, 2022. Violators may face penal charges in accordance with the established rules and regulations. The Department of Telecom encourages individuals and agencies to report any instances of excavation activities that have not been registered in the CBuD application. Such information can be brought to the attention of the Office of DDG, DoT, A&N West Bengal LSA, Port Blair, a press release from Secretary (IT) said.

Social Welfare Deptt. implementing National Family Benefit Scheme

Eligible beneficiaries may obtain form from Directorate of Social Welfare or Offices of CDPOs

Port Blair, Oct. 30

The Directorate of Social Welfare is implementing the National Family Benefit Scheme (NFBS) which is administered by the Ministry of Rural Development under the National Social Assistance Program (NSAP). As per the scheme, an amount of Rs. 20000/- will be given as a lump sum assistance to the bereaved household in the event of the death of the breadwinner.

It is clarified that any event of death (natural or otherwise) would make the family eligible for assistance. A woman in the family, who is

a homemaker, is also considered a 'breadwinner' for this purpose. The family benefit will be paid to such surviving member of the household of the deceased poor, who after local inquiry, is found to be the head of the household. For the purpose of the scheme, the term 'household' would include spouses, minor children, unmarried daughters, and dependent parents. In case of the death of an unmarried adult, the term household would include minor brothers/ sisters and dependent parents. The death of such a breadwinner should

have occurred while/ she is more than 18 years of age and less than 59 years of age. The assistance would be given in every case of the death of a breadwinner in a family.

The eligibility criteria for availing the Scheme is that the family should belong to the BPL category. The eligible beneficiaries may obtain the form from the Directorate of Social Welfare or Offices of the CDPOs at Urban Project, Ferrargunj, Rangat, Diglipur, Car Nicobar and other outstations, a press release from Directorate of Social Welfare said.

Free ferry and ship services for inter-island and mainland vessels.

Disability Allowance:

A monthly disability allowance of Rs.2,500 per beneficiary to ease financial burdens.

Assistive Devices:

Provision of assistive devices tailored to the specific needs of Divyanga individuals, based on their disability type and income criteria.

Niramaya Health Insurance:

Inclusion in the Niramaya Health Insurance scheme, offering comprehensive health care coverage.

Disability Scholarships:

Opportunities for disability scholarships, empowering individuals to pursue education and skill development.

Streamlined Documentation:

Elimination of the need for multiple copies of documents, as the UDID Card comprehensively captures all necessary details that can be easily accessed.

Single Document for Identification:

The UDID Card serves as the sole document for the identification and verification of disabled individuals, making it more convenient for them to avail various benefits.

Progress Tracking:

The UDID Card plays a pivotal role in tracking the physical and financial progress of beneficiaries.

Ban on manufacturing, sale, storage, purchase and use of Chinese Manjha/Nylon/Synthetic Material/ Glass coated thread used for kite flying

Port Blair, Oct. 30

The Principal Bench of the Hon'ble National Green Tribunal (NGT), New Delhi in its order dated 11.07.2017 in O.A.No.384/2016 and 442/2016 in the matter of Khalid Ashraf & Anr-Vs-UIO & Ors and People for Ethical Treatment of Animals (PETA) India -Vs -UIO & Ors respectively has directed the prohibition of the use of nylon thread, Chinese Dor, and synthetic thread coated with harmful materials for kite flying.

As per the directions of Ministry of Environment, Forest& Climate Change (MOEF&CC) and CPCB it is to inform that manufacture, sale, storage, purchase and use of Chinese Manjha or thread used for kite flying which is made of nylon or any synthetic material and/ or coated with synthetic substance and is non-biodegradable is prohibited. Units manufacturing "Synthetic fibre including rayon, tyre cord, polyester filament yarn" shall

submit an Annual Self-declaration statement to ANPCC that they are supplying their product only to valid users and not to any entity involved in manufacturing Chinese Manjha / Nylon/ Synthetic Material/ Glass coated thread for kite-flying.

All concerned authority and general public have been advised to abide by the directions and non-compliance, if found, may be intimated to the Member Secretary, ANPCC for necessary action as deemed fit, a Public Notice issued by ANPCC said.

account holder's bank account through 'auto-debit' facility in one installment.

The PMSBY policy is ideally a financial aid for economically backward families. It provides adequate health insurance coverage to the insured in case of their death or disability due to accident. The premiums paid towards the plan can be claimed for tax deductions under Section 80C of the old income tax regime. Also, the sum of up to Rs.1 lakh received by the beneficiaries is non-taxable under Section 10(10D) of the Income Tax Act, 1961.

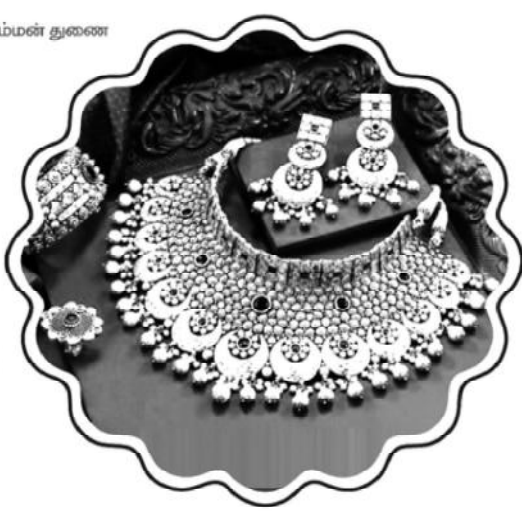
