Release of 15th Installment under PM-KISAN scheme

Eligible PM-KISAN beneficiaries asked to seed their land, e-KYC & Bank Account with Aadhaar by Sept.30

Port Blair, Sept. 11
The Government of India with a view to augment the income of the farmers, launched the Central Sector Scheme- 'Pradhan Mantri Kisan Samman Nidhi' (PM-KISAN) during the financial year of 2018-19 which is 100% funded by Govt. of India. Under the Scheme, eligible farmer families receive

financial benefits of Rs. 6000/- per year payable in 3 equal installments of Rs. 2000/- each, every four months.
Till now, 14 Installments have been released by the GoI. The 14th Installment was released by the Hon'ble Prime Minister, Shri Narendra Modi on 27th July, 2023 directly to the bank accounts of the PM KISAN beneficiaries.

For smooth transfer of benefits of 15th Installment for the period August - November, the Govt. of India has made the following mandatory requirement which is to be completed by 30th September 2023:
1. e-KYC is completed.
2. Land details is entered in PM-KISAN portal

Nicobar Islands, on 13th October, 1999 and subsequent instructions issued by it on the subject from time to time, shall apply to these elections. Further, instructions issued by the Election Commission of India on Model Code of Conduct from time to time shall also be followed.

After the onset of COVID-19, Ministry of Home Affairs, Ministry of Health & Family Welfare, Govt. of India, as well as the Andaman and Nicobar Administration, have issued guidelines/SOPs from time to time. These guidelines/SOPs shall be observed scrupulously during these General Elections. Further, Election Commission, Andaman and Nicobar Islands, has also issued broad guidelines separately based on the Election Commission of India's guidelines and Standing Committee of All India State Election Commissioners' recommendations for conduct of General Elections/Bye-Elections during the period of COVID-19 with respect to conduct of elections. Major illicit liquor manufacturing operation thwarted at Bakultala jungle

Rangat, Sept. 11

In a significant breakthrough for law enforcement, a crucial tip-off received by the Police Station Rangat this morning led to the discovery of a substantial illicit liquor production operation deep within the dense jungle of Shyamkund, Bakultala. As part of the continued crackdown on illicit liquor manufacturing, a team was assembled under Inspector R.K Mazumder, the SHO of PS Rangat.

The dedicated team,

comprising of PCs Anil Yadav, Sonu Kumar Yadav, Sheetal Das, Ram Prakash Rao, Cts Subol Bepari and William launched a coordinated raid deep within the Shyamkund forest. The team successfully uncovered and confiscated a substantial quantity of illicit liquor production equipment. The seizure included 21 tins and drums, containing approximately 450 liters of Lahan, alongside various utensils and wood supplies required for the preparation of

illicit liquor, found hidden at different locations within the jungle. All the confiscated materials were destroyed, delivering a significant blow to the illicit liquor manufacturing network. The entire operation was conducted under the vigilant supervision of Shri Vishesh Dhatteerwal, SDPO Rangat, and the overall direction and supervision of Ms. Niharika Bhatt, IPS, Superintendent of Police, N&M Andaman District, a press release from SP (N&MA) said.

No...../F. No 3-53/2018-UD- In exercise of powers conferred on him under Section 202 of the A & N Islands (Municipal) Regulation, 1994, the Lt. Governor (Administrator), A & N Islands hereby proposes to make the following amendment in "Port Blair Municipal Council Building Bye-Laws" published in the A & N Gazette vide Notification No. 161/99F. No. 3-53/97-LSG dated 13.10.1999 and subsequently amended vide Notification No. 50/2019/F. No. 3-53/2018-UDdated 21st February, 2019 :-

Suggestion/Objection, if any, on these rules may be furnished/submitted to the Secretary, Port Blair Municipal Council within a period of 30 days of its publication for consideration.

1. **SHORT TITLE COMMENCEMENT:-**

i. These Bye-Laws be called the Port Blair Municipal Council Building (Amendment) Bye-Laws, 2023.

ii. They shall come into force with immediate effect.

2. After clause 4.9(6) of the PBMC Building Bye-Laws 1999 (hereinafter called the Principal Bye-Laws), the following clause shall be added as below:-

***4.10.The builder/RWA should be mandated to ensure that:-**

A. (i) While preparing the building plans, there is a need to mandate to have properly demarcated sections within buildings and on rooftops for housing Broadband / digital connectivity infrastructure / antenna. These areas should have access to power supply for reliable, always-on services

(ii) Access to building as well as CTI facilities inside the building should be available on a fair, transparent and non-discriminatory manner to all Service Providers.

(iii) The permission to in-building access and/or CTI facilities inside the building should not be seen as a source of revenue generation for builders but as a means for facilitating penetration of broadband access and thereby helping in socio-economic growth of all the residents.

(iv) Charges (rentals/power rates etc.) levied to the TSPS/IP-1s should be fair, transparent and non-discriminatory and should be on residential rates.

(v) Suitable provision for the creation of Common Telecom Infrastructure (CTI) inside the newly constructed public places like Airports, commercial complexes and residential complexes, be incorporated in the Building Bye Law.


