## Raksha Mantri dedicates to the nation 90 BRO infrastructure projects built across 11 States/Union Territories

### Timely completion of infrastructure projects in border areas is new normal of New India: RM

New Delhi, Sept. 12 (PIB)

Raksha Mantri, Shri Rajnath Singh has dedicated to the nation 90 infrastructure projects of Border Roads Organisation (BRO), worth over Rs 2,900 crore, spread across 11 States/Union Territories. The projects were inaugurated by the Raksha Mantri at an event in Jammu today. These include Nechipu Tunnel in Arunachal Pradesh; two airfields in West Bengal; two helipads; 22 roads and 63 bridges. Of these 90 projects, 36 are in Arunachal Pradesh; 26 in Ladakh; 11 in Jammu & Kashmir; five in Mizoram; three in Himachal Pradesh; two each in Sikkim, Uttarakhand & West Bengal and one each in Nagaland, Rajasthan and Andaman & Nicobar Islands. The reach of Project Swastik extends to Andaman & Nicobar Islands, where the southernmost



tip of India lies. The road inaugurated today in A&N Islands is located in Campbell Bay and connects the southernmost tip of India, i.e. Indira Point.

The BRO has completed the construction of these strategically-important projects in record time; most of them in a single working season using state-of-the-art technology. In his address, the Raksha Mantri described the BRO as 'bro (brother)' of the Armed Forces, asserting that, through its infrastructure projects, BRO is not only securing India's

borders, but also playing a key role in the socio-economic development of the far-flung areas.

Shri Rajnath Singh credited the timely completion of these projects to the hard work & dedication of its personnel as well as the commitment of the Government under the leadership of Prime Minister, Shri Narendra Modi. "Together with BRO, we are ensuring that the nation is secure and border areas are developed. Timely completion of infrastructure projects in far-flung areas has now become the new normal of New India," he said.

identification of water sources, creation of bore wells, check weirs, and rejuvenation of water bodies are being carried out earnestly, keeping in mind the requirement and needs of the populace. To meet the required power, 10 more MW will be added soon and it will eventually resolve the power shortage. Besides concerted monitoring of power production and consumption, regular pruning of tree branches are being done, so as to prevent line fault. Regarding the road, he said, plans have been chalked out to carry out the repair work immediately after the rainy season. He remarked that the Administration is committed to the welfare of the people and no stone will be left unturned to address the issues faced by the general public be it in any sector.

In his address, the Member of Parliament lauded the leadership of the Chief Secretary under whose guidance and support, the grievances of people are being redressed timely. Island Agro-climatic Zone.

To implement the project, two districts, i.e. South Andaman and Nicobar, have been selected in first instance. The Gram Panchayat based water resources management planning will be completed and piloted in these two districts from September 2023 to October 2025.

The main goal of the project is to improve water resource management harmonised with land, vegetation and climate change to develop sustainable natural resources management and productivity enhancement models in the respective agro-climatic zones. WASCA aims to support in co-creating innovative models for Island communities leveraging MGNREGA and schemes from other line Departments through convergence.

The Workshop was attended by the Officers of Rural Development, Forest Department, Agriculture Department, Fisheries Department, AH&VS Department, APWD and CIARI. The Pradhans of different Gram Panchayats and MGNREGA staff of South Andaman & Nicobar District attended the workshop physically as well as virtually through VC.

Shri Krishan Tyagi, Project Manager, WASCA, GIZ, India, New Delhi briefed about the increasing climate risks and necessity to implement suitable climate resilient measures and how scientific GIS based planning will support for the holistic development. The experiences from the coastal State of Tamil Nadu will help in the resolution of island natural resources management. Dr. R. Rengalakshmi, Director, Ecotechnology, M S Swaminathan Research Foundation, explained the models and impacts of the WASCA I project implemented in Ramanathapuram District, a coastal ecosystem in Tamil Nadu. She also shared the draft plan made for the Gram Panchayat Mithakhari under Ferrargunj Block of South Andaman to pilot the project.

While addressing the gathering, Smt. Veditha Reddy, Secretary (RD) highlighted the scarcity of drinking water from January to May in many of the Islands. She stressed the importance of water conservation in the Islands adopting scientific and convergence approaches and make A&N Islands as 'Water Surplus region'.

Shri Birendra Chaudhary, IFS, Deputy Conservator of Forest, Department of Environment and Forest expressed that since more than 80 per cent of the land is under forest cover, relevant soil and water conservation measures need to start from that upper slopes and Department of Forest will extend necessary support to the Gram Panchayats. Dr. Eknath B Chakurkar, Director, Central Island Agricultural Research Institute (CIARI) recommended that both soil and water conservation methods should go together. He highlighted how different land, soil and water conservation technologies in the CIARI campus improved the water resources. Shri Vikram Singh, Director, Department of Agriculture and Fisheries showed a prototype to harvest the rainwater at the household level using a simple filter based device. He sought the technical support of CIARI and GIZ-India to fine-tune such innovative technologies. He also extended his support in implementing the water resources management plan in the Islands. Shri Abhishek Bhukal, Director (in-charge), Department of Rural Development appreciated the WASCA framework in augmenting water resources.

The Block Development Officers, Assistant Engineers (MGNREGA) and Gram Rozgar Sewaks (MGNREGA) from South Andaman and Nicobar districts participated in the training programme in both physical and virtual mode, a press release from Secretary (RD) said.

Indian Coast Guard rescues stranded fishing boat

Port Blair, Sept. 12 Indian Coast Guard District Headquarters at Campbell Bay coordinated the rescue of stranded fishing boat 'Bhaskar III' (IND-AN-SA-MM-2018) on Sept. 10. The boat with nine crew had left Port Blair for fishing on 25<sup>th</sup> Aug., 2023 and was operating near Little Nicobar when it became incapacitated on Sept. 8, as its propeller shaft got damaged in rough seas. As a result, the IFB started drifting in the open sea without sufficient food and water.

During routine air surveillance, ICG Dornier aircraft sighted the IFB, with its crew waving their hands to draw attention of the aircraft. Understanding that the boat seemed to be in distress, the ICG aircraft passed the information to the nearest ICG Station at Campbell Bay. On receipt of the distress, ICG Ship Rajkiran was diverted towards the position of the boat. The ship proceeded with best speed towards the fishing boat, braving the rough seas, inclement weather and strong winds. On arrival at the position, ICGS Rajkiran established communication with the boat and tried to rectify the defect. However, due to lack of spares the defect could not be rectified at sea and the boat was taken under tow to the nearest harbour, Campbell Bay. ICGS Rajkiran entered Campbell Bay harbour in the early morning hours of 11<sup>th</sup> Sept., 23 and the distressed boat was handed over to the local fisheries authorities. The rescue operation was undertaken with alacrity and resulted in saving of nine precious lives at sea. The operation validated the commitment of ICG in providing assistance to mariners in distress at sea, in line with the ICG Motto 'We Protect', a press release from ICG said.

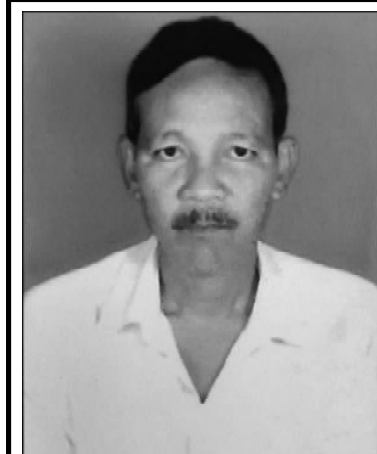
