Philosophy of 'Sabka Sath, Sabka Vikas' is inspired by Gandhian thought: Vice President

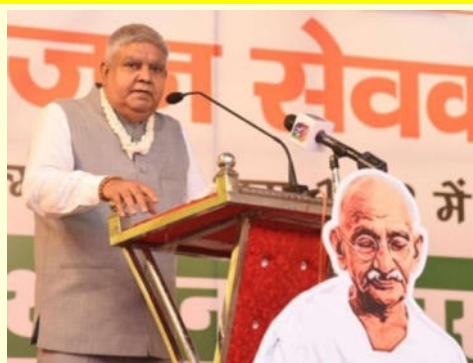
"For the many dangers facing the world today - from poverty to climate change to wars - Gandhi Ji's thoughts provide a solution to all"

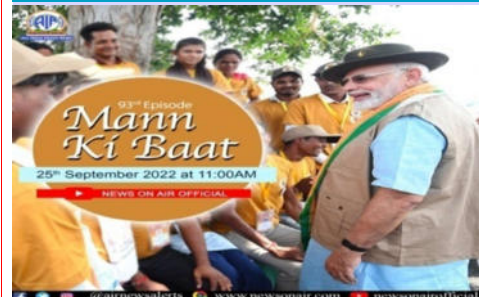


resurgence. "It was a call for social unity and political freedom", he said. Noting Gandhiji's contributions, the Vice President said that the Mahatma endeavoured

5580 'Soil Health Cards' issued under selected Villages Programme (UT Plan) to farmers of A&N Islands

Farmers urged to get their soil assessed for issuance of 'Soil Health Card'

Port Blair, Sept. 24

In the absence of scientific analysis of soil, blindfolded applications of fertilizer and growth supporters have been used on the farm lands. This not only results in unwanted expenditure for the farmers but also affects the soil health negatively. To address this problem, the 'Soil Health Card Scheme' was launched by the Prime Minister on 19th of



Feb, 2015 and is being implemented under Rashtriya Krishi Vikas Yojana (RKVY), Ministry of Agriculture & Farmers Welfare.

The main objective of this programme is to issue Soil Health Cards, every 2 years to all

farmers, so as to provide a basis to address nutrient deficiencies in fertilizer application practices besides it also aims to ensure quality control requirements of fertilizers, bio-fertilizers and organic fertilizers under the

Fertilizer (Control) Order (FCO), 1985, including revision of standards and testing protocols keeping in view the advances in research and technology and covering organic inputs under quality control regime and to

promote Integrated Nutrient Management (INM) through judicious use of chemical fertilizers, including secondary and micro nutrients, in conjunction with organic manures and bio-fertilizers for improving soil health and its productivity. The Soil Health Card (SHC) contains the status of soil with respect to 12 parameters i.e. available Nitrogen (N),

Fish being a perishable commodity, the Department has prioritized the establishment of adequate ice production and cold storage facilities for enhancing the trading and export of seafood from these

Islands. The aim of developing such facilities in private sector by extending financial assistance under Pradhan Mantri Matsya Sampada Yojana is to increase the participation of traditional fishermen community in the fisheries business as well as for ensuring adequate supply/availability of ice in

affordable rates for the fishermen community.

The Scheme for Financial Assistance @ 40% for general fishers and 60% for women and tribal beneficiary to construct 10/20/30/50 MT capacity Ice plant/Cold Storage under Pradhan Mantri Matsya Sampada Yojana is available with the Department.

Govt. to launch 'Swachh Vayu Sarvekshan'

New Delhi, Sept. 24

Ministry of Environment, Forest and Climate Change is going to launch Swachh Vayu Sarvekshan that promotes ranking of 131 cities in the country for implementing City Action Plans prepared as part of National Clean Air Programme for reducing air pollution upto 40 percent by 2025-26.

For this survey, 131

cities are categorized into three groups based on population. 47 cities are in the first group having population more than 10 lakh. 44 cities are in the second group having population between 3 to 10 lakh. Third group consists of 40 cities having population less than 3 lakh.

Cities are required to do the self-assessment as per the framework

provided on the Ministry's online portal. This assessment is carried out annually. Cities have to report implementation of activities and measures taken in respect of solid waste and road dust management, management of construction and demolition waste, control of vehicular emissions and industrial pollution. Phosphorous (P) & Potassium (K) (macronutrients), Sulphur (secondary-nutrient), Zinc(Zn), Iron(Fe), Copper (Cu), Manganese (Mn) & Boron (B) (micronutrients) and pH, Electrical Conductivity (EC) & Organic Carbon(OC) (physical parameters).

Based on these parameters, fertilizer recommendations with suitable fertilizers both in organic and inorganic form and soil amendment required for the cultivable area is also indicated. During 2021-22 & 2022-23 (till date) a total of 5580 Soil Health Cards have been issued under selected Villages Programme (UT Plan).

Farmers have been requested to use organic manures, bio-fertilizers, farm yard manure and decomposed farm wastes for cultivation aspects, to improve soil health and its fertility thereby ensuring adequate availability of nutrients in soils to meet the requirement of plants at critical stages of growth and enhances soil microbial activity in abundance. Timely application of all essential plant nutrients in readily available form, in optimum quantities and in the right proportion suitable for specific soil/crop condition is the prime objective of issuing soil health cards to farmers.

Farmers have also been requested to contact the Assistant Director (Agri./ Assistant Director (Soil) through the concerned Circle In-Charge/Sub Depot In-Charge of their respective areas to get their soil of farming area collected and analyzed in order to obtain the 'Soil Health Card' with proper recommendation periodically.

Law & Justice Minister emphasizes on adoption of Alternative Dispute Redressal Mechanism to reduce pending cases in courts

New Delhi, Sept. 24

Union Minister for Law and Justice, Shri Kiren Rijiju on Saturday emphasized on adoption of Alternative Dispute Redressal Mechanism to reduce the pending cases in courts across the country. Addressing a seminar organized by Bar Council of India and Bihar State Bar Council in Patna, Shri Rijiju said 4.8 Crore cases are pending in courts and to reduce this there is a need to promote alternative ways like mediation and arbitration. He also said Legal Aid Service Authorities can play a

crucial role to get rid of the problem by promoting more and more Lok Adalats.

Shri Rijiju said for accessible justice to common man of the country the Government is promoting tele law facility and digital courts. He also said that advocates should work on pro bono concept as the Government is providing free legal aid in far flung areas of the country with the help of National Legal Aid Services Authority (NALSA). He also stressed upon standardization of law education in colleges, improvement of court

infrastructure in the lower judiciary system. The Union Minister said that the Government has allocated a budget of 9 thousand Crore rupees for improvement of court infrastructure in the country. He also spoke about activation of Fast Track Courts in full strength. Shri Rijiju appealed to Chief Ministers and Chief Justices of the High Courts to devise a set up for functioning of 1800 Fast Track Courts in the country. He said presently 896 Fast Track Courts are functional against the sanctioned strength. (Source: india.gov.in)

Owners of mechanized fishing vessels advised not to venture into fishing Zone A of Nicobar District for fishing

Port Blair, Sept. 24

Instances of unauthorized entry of mechanized fishing vessels of South Andaman into near coastal shores of Nicobar District have been reported by the Indian Coast Guard, Police Marine Force and the tribal community which is being viewed seriously by the Department of Fisheries. Such act by the

mechanized fishing vessels is affecting the livelihood of tribal community. Hence, all the owners of mechanized fishing vessels of South Andaman have been strictly warned to not to venture into fishing Zone A of Nicobar District for fishing (i.e. Territorial waters upto 6 nautical miles from appropriate base line of the Island).

Violation of the same shall lead to penalty and also liable to suspension/cancellation of Fishing License/Registration under the A&N Marine Fishing Regulation, 2003 and rules framed there under. The violation shall also attract action under PAT Regulations, 1956, a press release received from Directorate of Fisheries said.

Tearful Roger Federer bids adieu to professional tennis with Laver Cup

London, Sept. 24

A tearful Roger Federer waved goodbye to professional tennis after teaming up with fellow great Rafael Nadal at the Laver Cup. The 41-year-old received a long ovation after walking off court for the final time as he retired as a professional. The Swiss, who won 20 Grand Slam singles titles, is considered one of the best players in tennis history. He said, it has been a wonderful day, he is happy, not sad. He said, it feels great to be here.

Federer cried as he hugged Nadal and other players, then took acclaim from thousands of fans who chanted his name at the O2 Arena in London.



Nadal also could not hold back the tears. The 36-year-old Spaniard cried as he sat alongside Federer while the pair listened to British singer Ellie Goulding, who rounded off a memorable night with a performance.

Federer and Nadal - for so long rivals at the top of the men's game - joined forces to play doubles against American pair

Jack Sock and Frances Tiafoe in the annual team event between Europe and the rest of the world. Despite Federer not having played competitively for over a year, the veteran duo pushed Sock and Tiafoe before losing 4-6 7-6 (7-2) 11-9 as Team World levelled at 2-2 at the end of play on the opening day.

their community. Dr. Satyavir Singh, Principal Scientist, and Dr. Anil Khippal, Principal Scientist from ICAR-IIWBR, Karnal stressed the importance of barley and millets and advised the farmers to adopt the technologies. Shri T. Joy, Agriculture Officer of the Department of Agriculture highlighted the need of adopting mixed farming, use of Jeevan Amrit, making of vermicompost, and utilization of vegetable seed kits for the kitchen garden. Dr. Y. Ramakrishna, Principal Scientist, and Head spoke on the role of KVK and possible technological intervention with the scientific support of his team in coconut crop and value addition for better remuneration. Dr. S.K. Zamir Ahmed, Principal Scientist impressed upon taking up nutritious kitchen gardening with vegetable seeds in the top verandah of the shelter with seedlings of vegetable seeds in grow bags, and pots so that the fruits can be utilized for family consumption.

The team exhorted the farming community of Perka village to start a small nutritious kitchen garden either by a single farmer or within a group to set an example for others to follow. The farmers also interacted with the scientific team and got their doubts cleared. A set of vegetable seeds comprising HYV of Bhendi, Amaranthus, and cowpea were distributed. A total of 55 farmers attended the programme, a press release received from CIARI said.
