India will have no place for corruption, casteism & communalism: PM

New Delhi, Sept. 3

Prime Minister, Shri Narendra Modi has said that India will be a developed nation by 2047 where corruption, casteism and communalism will have no place. In an interview to a news agency, he said, India will be in top three economies of world in near future, citing country's record of jumping five spots in less than decade. Prime Minister said, dialogue and diplomacy is only way to resolve conflicts in different regions. He said, whether as G20 President or not, India will support every effort to ensure peace across the world.

Prime Minister asserted that the 'Sabka Saath Sabka Vikas' model can be the guiding principle for the welfare of a world shifting

from a GDP-centric approach to a human-centric one. He said, in G20, India's words and vision are being seen by the world as a roadmap for the future. He said, the theme of India's G20 Presidency 'Vasudhaiva Kutumbakam' is not just a slogan but also a comprehensive philosophy derived from

country's cultural ethos. He said, Africa is a top priority for India in G20. Shri Modi said, no future plan of Earth can succeed without all voices being heard. He said, the rapid and sustained progress made by India naturally evoked interest across the world and many countries have been watching India's

growth story very closely. Shri Modi said, the countries are convinced that this progress is not an accident but is happening as a result of a clear, action-oriented roadmap of 'Reform, Perform, Transform'.

Prime Minister said, for a long time, India was perceived as a nation of over one billion hungry stomachs. But now, India is being seen as a nation of over one billion aspirational minds, more than two billion skilled hands, and hundreds of millions of young people. ISRO successfully performs first orbit raising manoeuvre of its solar mission Aditya- L1

New Delhi, Sept. 3

Indian Space Research Organisation (ISRO) has successfully performed the first earth-bound manoeuvre of the country's maiden solar mission, Aditya-L1, from ISTRAC Bengaluru. In its tweet, the Indian Space Agency has said that ISTRAC has successfully carried out the Earth bound manoeuvre today morning and the spacecraft has attained a new orbit of 245 kms by 22,459 kms. The satellite is healthy and operating normally, it added.



The next manoeuvre is scheduled for the 5th of September around 3.00 pm. The satellite will undergo four Earth bound orbital manoeuvres before placing in the transfer orbit towards the Lagrange point L1 in 125 days. Aditya-L1 mission will provide information

on Solar corona and conduct in-situ observations of the solar wind at L1 point which is about 1.5 million kilometres away from Earth. The Polar Satellite Launch Vehicle C57 had successfully launched Aditya-L1 spacecraft yesterday. (Source: india.gov.in)

A&N Police has urged the citizens to exercise extreme caution, while conducting financial transaction. With an aim to prevent financial losses through online frauds, the general public should take the following precautions:

➤ Never share your Banking password, OTP (one time password) or Debit/Credit Card

details with others.

➤ Never scan QR Code, when you are to receive money. It is only required for transferring money to other accounts.

➤ Beware of phishing scams trying to steal your Banking or UPI information. Look out for fake emails and websites that try to collect information and do not click on unknown/unfamiliar links.

➤ Always use familiar websites for online shopping rather than shopping by searching products on search engines.

Search results can be misleading and may lead to malicious websites.

➤ Ignore advertisements/deals, if they claim that you can earn money with little or no work or you can make money on an investment with little or no risk. If an offer seems too good to be true, it is most likely to be a scam.

➤ Beware of fake loan apps that provide quick and easy loans. Such illegal apps will seek a variety of information and permissions from applicants, which is then misused to blackmail them later. If using digital loan app, please ensure that it has RBI authorization.

Sir Vishweswaraya, an eminent Indian Engineer. The event will allow students to witness the gripping landing sequence of Chandrayaan-3's remarkable journey

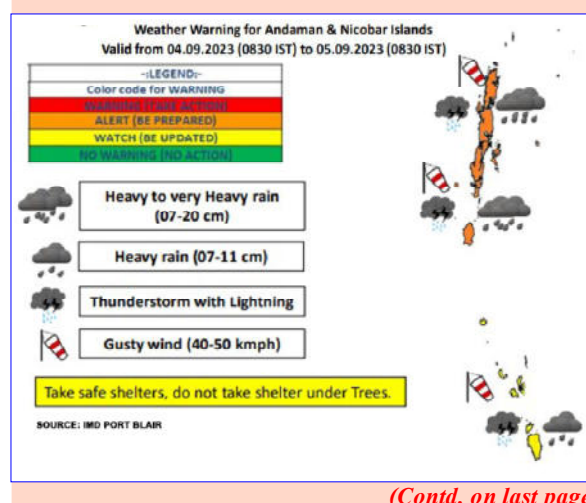

Indian Coast Guard conducts rescue operations in Nicobar group of Islands; saves 12 lives in distress



Port Blair, Sept. 3

Indian Coast Guard conducted two rescue operations in Nicobar group of Islands and saved 12 lives in distress in less than 24 hrs. Both operations were undertaken by ICGS Rajdhwaj. The efforts of the ship are singular as both missions were undertaken 300 km

apart. On the night of 1st Sept., 2023, ICG Ship Rajdhwaj rescued 11 lives in distress and provided towing assistance to IFB Harishma (Reg No. IND-AN-SA-MM-2121). IFB Harishma alongwith 11 crew had left from Junglighat harbour on 24th Aug., 2023 for fishing in Nicobar

group of Islands. On 1st Sept., 2023 at around 1500 hrs, water ingress took place in the engine room of IFB due to rough seas leading to short circuit of 2 batteries and starting motor. The crew of the fishing boat tried to rectify the defect, however all efforts were futile. At about

ISRO to wake up Chandrayan-3's rover Pragyan on 22nd of this month after it was put to sleep following completion of all its assignments on Lunar surface

New Delhi, Sept. 3

As 14 days of daylight ends on the Moon, the Indian Space Research Organisation, ISRO has put off the payloads on the solar-powered Rover Pragyan that is safely parked on the surface of the Moon.

In its tweet, ISRO said that APXS and LIBS payloads are turned off and the Chandrayaan 3 Rover set into sleep mode.

The battery is fully charged on the Rover and is oriented to receive the light at the next sunrise expected on the 22nd of September. The receiver is kept on. ISRO tweet further adds that it hopes for a successful awakening for another set of assignments. If not, the Rover will forever stay on the Lunar surface as India's lunar ambassador. Country received over 162 millimetres of rainfall in August this year

New Delhi, Sept. 3

The country received over 162 millimetres of rainfall in August this year, which is 36 per cent less than its Long Period Average of around 255 millimetres. The India Meteorological Department said, rainfall over all India was lowest since 1901 against previous record of 191.2 mm in 2005. The Weather Office said, that during August this year, the country experienced extremely heavy rainfall events mainly over Himachal Pradesh, Uttarakhand, Assam, Meghalaya, Sub Himalayan West Bengal, Sikkim, Bihar, Odisha and East Madhya Pradesh.

IMD has also said that monthly rainfall for September over the country as a whole is most likely to be normal. Met Department has forecast normal to above normal rainfall over many areas of northeast India, adjoining east India, foothills of the Himalayas, and some areas of east-central and south peninsular India. Below-normal rainfall is most likely over most areas of the remaining parts of the country. (Source: india.gov.in)

NPS has been made available to every Indian Citizen from the 1st of May, 2009 on a voluntary basis. Atal Pension Yojana was launched on the 1st of June, 2015 which has given the much-required impetus to the social security schemes.

In pursuit of the objective to promote pension and retirement planning, PFRDA annually celebrates the 1st of October as National Pension System Diwas (NPS Diwas). 1930 hrs, on receipt of request for assistance, ICGS Rajdhwaj on area patrol was diverted towards the fishing boat for rendering assistance. The Indian Coast Guard ship proceeded with best speed and carried out extensive search in area braving rough weather conditions. With dedicated and persistent efforts ICG ship located the boat and brought the IFB and her crew to safety of Carnic harbour.

In the second mission, ICGS Rajdhwaj evacuated Mr. Magdael Edilberto Pelingnon, a Filipino national suffering with severe abdominal pain from MV Thermopylae, off Campbell Bay on the night of 2nd Sept., 2023. On receipt of distress from the vessel, proceeded with best speed from Car Nicobar to Campbell Bay and evacuated the patient to Primary Health Centre Campbell Bay. The patient is now stable and under medical observation.


