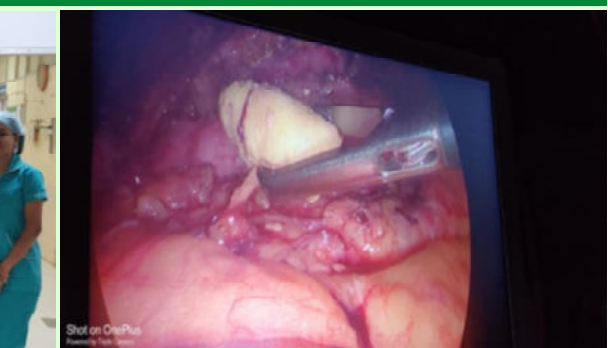
## Super specialized minimally invasive pancreatic surgery performed on 35 year old male at GB Pant Hospital/ ANIMS

A 35 year old male chronically suffering from severe pain in abdomen, after every meal was diagnosed with chronic calcific pancreatitis. It is a medical condition, in which the pancreas (an important organ

for digestion) becomes persistently inflamed and due to repeated inflammation, stones form within the pancreas. He was treated at multiple hospitals with no solution to his ailment. He was admitted in GB Pant



Hospital and was examined and evaluated by Surgeons with blood investigation and USG abdomen and contrast CT scan and was prepared for the definitive curative surgery.

On 7<sup>th</sup> August,

2023, a team of Super Specialist Surgeons headed by Dr. Saji Vargheese and Anesthesiologist, Dr. Narayan & Dr. Ramya performed a supra major advanced minimally invasive pancreatic surgery

lasting for 6 hours, namely Laparoscopic L a t e r a l Pancreaticojejunostomy. Intraoperatively, his pancreas was found to be studded completely with large stones. The stones were removed and his pancreas was connected to his intestines to resume its function.



These surgeries are only done in selected specialized centers at mainland usually done via open technique. Post operatively, he had a quick recovery. And now, he is able to eat well without any pain, a press release from ANIIMS said.

One convicted under POCSO Act

Port Blair, Sept. 5

The Hon'ble Special Judge, Shri Bhawani Shankar Sharma on 5<sup>th</sup> September, 2023 convicted one accused person namely Manojit Joydhar, resident of Lal Pahad, Chouldhari Village, Ferrargunj Tehsil in a sexual assault case committed by him against a minor girl, then aged 11 years. It is averred that on 30.05.2018, when the victim boarded the Auto-rickshaw of the accused who was the driver of the said Auto-rickshaw stopped at some place and finding

the girl alone he touched her inappropriately and expressed his intention to remain with her at night. He was then found under the influence of liquor. The incident was brought to the notice of the mother who informed the said incident to concerned PS i.e. PS Ograbraj and a case was registered against the accused person under Section 7&8 of POCSO Act read with Section 354 of Indian Penal Code (IPC) and the investigation was taken by SI Benedict. The prosecution

examined 6 witnesses and the Hon'ble Court after conducting trial found the accused person guilty of the offence and sentenced him to suffer 4 years rigorous imprisonment under Section 7/8 of POCSO Act and ordered him to pay a fine of Rs. 25,000/- in default of payment of such fine further rigorous imprisonment of 6 months. The case was conducted for and on behalf of the State by Special Public Prosecutor, Miss. A.S. Zinu, a press release received from the SPP said.
