## 18<sup>th</sup> G20 Summit successfully concludes at Bharat Mandapam in New Delhi

Port Blair, Sept. 10

The 18<sup>th</sup> G20 Summit successfully concluded in New Delhi today with India handing over the Presidency to Brazil. In the closing ceremony, Prime Minister, Shri Narendra Modi handed over the ceremonial gavel to the President of Brazil, Mr. Luiz Inacio Lula da Silva. Speaking on this occasion, Shri Modi expressed confidence that under the Presidency of Brazil, the G20 would be able to achieve the common goals. He also proposed that one virtual session of the G20 forum may be conducted at the end of November to review the progress of the agenda decided in this Summit.

After receiving the gavel, the Brazilian President said that in the present world, wealth is more concentrated while millions of human beings still go hungry. He underlined the need to address the issue of inequality in income,

healthcare, education, food and gender.

Earlier, Prime Minister, Shri Narendra Modi chaired the third session namely 'One Future'. Chief Coordinator for India's G20 Presidency, Shri Harsh Vardhan Shringla said that during the Summit, African Union's inclusion in G20 and adoption of the New Delhi Declaration were huge achievements for India.

On the first day of the Summit yesterday, the G20 member nations unanimously adopted the New Delhi Leaders Declaration. It is being seen as a significant victory for India's G-20 presidency. India's image as the voice of Global South is reflected in the 37-page declaration which says that member countries need to urgently accelerate their actions to address development and climate challenges, promote Lifestyles for Sustainable Development (LiFE), and

conserve biodiversity, forests and oceans. It advocates scaling up financing from all sources to accelerate progress on SDGs. It recognizes the importance of WTO's 'Aid for Trade' initiative to enable developing countries, to effectively participate in global trade. Strengthening Global Health and Implementing One Health Approach is also a key aspect of the declaration which focuses on strengthening primary health care and health workforce and improving essential health services and health systems to better than pre-pandemic levels, ideally within the next 2-3 years. Ending plastic pollution got mentioned in the declaration. Financing Cities of Tomorrow got special mention in the declaration which emphasizes the need for enhanced mobilization of finances and efficient use of existing resources in our efforts to make

the cities of tomorrow inclusive, resilient, and sustainable. Artificial Intelligence got mentioned in the declaration which says that it promotes responsible AI for achieving SDGs. Women-led development was one of the core issues of discussion and the declaration says that members will promote women's inclusion into the formal financial system by strengthening their access to economic resources, particularly through digital finance and microfinance. Member countries also agreed on creating a Working Group on the Empowerment of Women.

Meanwhile, UK Prime Minister, Shri Rishi Sunak and his wife, Smti. Akshata Murty visited the Akshardham Temple this morning and offered prayers. US President, Mr. Joe Biden left for Vietnam after attending the G20 Summit in New Delhi.

New Delhi, Sept. 10

Prime Minister, Shri Narendra Modi today held a series of bilateral meetings with the Heads of the State of France, Germany, Turkiye, Canada, South Korea and the President of the African Union on the sidelines of the G20 Summit in New Delhi. During the meeting, Prime Minister, Shri Modi and French President, Mr. Emmanuel Macron reviewed the progress in bilateral relations

since their last meeting in July this year in Paris. They also exchanged views on important international and regional developments. According to the joint statement, both India and France decided to carry forward their discussions on mutual partnership in the Indo-Pacific region and Africa, including in infrastructure, connectivity, energy, biodiversity,

sustainability, and industrial projects. In a social media post, Prime Minister, Shri Modi said, both the countries discussed a number of topics and look forward to ensure India-France relations scale new heights.

Speaking to the media at the International Media Centre in the national capital, French President, Mr. Macron said, the G20 Summit has sent across the message of unity. He

added that India and France will further deepen defence cooperation. He added that both India and France support deep reforms of international institutions to reflect the current reality of the world.

Prime Minister, Shri Modi also held a meeting with Turkiye President, Mr. Recep Tayyip Erdogan. Later, talking to the media, the Turkiye President said, India conducted

the G20 successfully on the theme of 'One Earth, One Family, One Future'. On the expansion of United Nation Security Council (UNSC). Mr. Erdogan said, the rotational system should be adopted to give chance to every member country. He supported India's candidacy as a permanent member in UNSC.

During the meeting with the President of the

African Union and Comoros, Mr. Azali Assoumani, Prime Minister, Shri Modi congratulated him on the African Union becoming a permanent member of the G20. Both the leaders also talked about advancing India-Comoros ties in sectors like trade, investments and maritime cooperation. Prime Minister, Shri Modi also held bilateral talks with Canadian Prime Minister, Mr.

Justin Trudeau. Both the leaders discussed the full range of India-Canada ties across different sectors. Later, addressing a press conference, the Canadian Prime Minister said, India is an extraordinarily important economy in the world and an important partner of Canada.

During bilateral talks with German Chancellor, Mr. Olaf Scholz, Prime Minister, Shri Modi

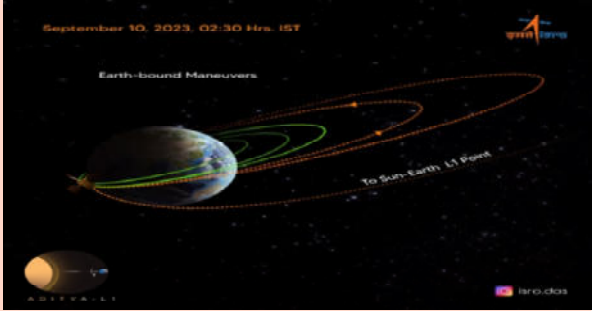
thanked him for enriching the G-20 Summit with his views saying that India and Germany can continue working together in clean energy, and innovation and work towards making Earth a better planet. ## ISRO successfully conducts the third earth-bound orbit raising manoeuvre of its Solar Mission Aditya-L1

New Delhi, Sept. 10

India's first Solar Mission, Aditya-L1 has successfully performed the third earth-bound manoeuvre early morning today. Indian Space Research Organisation (ISRO) said the third Earth-bound manoeuvre was performed successfully from ISTRAC, Bengaluru. ISRO's ground stations at Mauritius, Bengaluru, SDSC-SHAR and Port Blair tracked the satellite during this operation. ISRO added that the next manoeuvre is scheduled for September 15, 2023, around 02:00 Hrs. IST.



Earlier on September 5, Aditya-L1 successfully performed the second earth-bound manoeuvre, attaining an orbit of 282 km x 40225 km. After the successful landing of Chandrayaan-3 near the South Pole of the Moon, the ISRO launched the country's Maiden Solar Mission Aditya-L1 from the Satish Dhawan

Space Centre in Sriharikota on September 2. It carried seven different payloads to have a detailed study of the Sun, four of which will observe the light from the Sun and the other three will measure in-situ parameters of the plasma and magnetic fields. (Source: india.gov.in)

## CCS arrests one person for possession of ganja

### Appeals to citizens to be vigilant and report any suspicious activities to Police

Port Blair, Sept. 10

Police Station Central Crime Station (PS CCS) received critical information on Sept. 5 regarding possession of ganja by one Bappa Sutradhar, a 23 years old individual employed as a Cook at Chennai Tiffin Centre, located in Mohanpura Market. Bappa Sutradhar, a permanent resident of Nadia District, West Bengal, currently resides in a rented accommodation in Mohanpura area.

Acting swiftly on this information, the dedicated team from PS CCS uncovered that Bappa Sutradhar had

clandestinely received a shipment of approximately 2 kilograms of ganja from West Bengal, concealed ingeniously within a footwear parcel, through HF Courier Services around four days ago. During the subsequent police operation, a total of 1.570 kilograms of Ganja was recovered from his possession. Bappa Sutradhar has been arrested and further interrogation is underway as the case is being investigated thoroughly.

A&N Police has urged all residents to maintain vigilance and

promptly report any information concerning criminal activities to the authorities. Central Crime Station is committed to taking swift and stringent action against those involved in illicit drug trafficking, leaving no room for leniency.

Meanwhile, the general public have been requested to remain vigilant and report any suspicious activities related to drug trafficking or substance abuse to the Police on telephone numbers- 112/100, 232586, 233307 & 9531856080, a press release from SP (CID) said.

## A&N Pollution Control Committee issues guidelines for idol immersion

### Puja Committees asked to adhere to the guidelines

Port Blair, Sept. 10

Andaman and Nicobar Idol Immersion Rules 2018 were published in the Andaman and Nicobar Gazette No. 23 dated 05-03-2018 in compliance of Hon'ble National Green Tribunal order dated 06-10-2017 in O.A 51/2016/EZ. The Rules framed covers the general guidelines idol making ban on use of synthetic colors, height of super structures and idols. In this connection, the A & N Pollution Control Committee, Deptt. of Science & Technology, A&N Administration has directed all the Idol makers and Puja Committees to follow the guidelines for idol immersion as mentioned below:

> Idols should be made from natural materials as described in the holy scripts. Use of traditional clay for idol making rather than baked clay, Plaster of Paris (POP) etc. shall be

encouraged, allowed and promoted.

> There shall be a complete ban on the use of POP in idol making till it is established that the POP has no negative impact on the water quality and aquatic biodiversity.

> Painting of idols should be discouraged. In case idols are to be painted, water soluble and non-toxic natural dyes are to be used.

> There shall be a complete ban on the use of synthetic colour for painting of idols that would require immersion as part of final ritual of the festival.

> The height of the super structure of the idol shall be less than 40 ft. and the idol also shall not exceed 20ft in height.

> Materials used in worship like flowers, vastras (clothes), decorative materials (made of paper and plastic) etc. should be

removed before immersion of idols.

Biodegradable materials should be collected separately for recycling or composting at designated sites whereas the non-biodegradable materials should be collected separately for disposal in sanitary landfills or as prescribed by the local Municipal Authority or local body. Clothes may be sent to local orphanage(s).

> Idol Immersion should be done between low tide line and high tide line (irrespective of its depth) in identified places with permission of District Administration only.

> Single use plastic should not be used during celebration.

A&N Pollution Control Committee has appealed to the citizens to make this Puja celebration 'Plastic Free', a press release received here said.

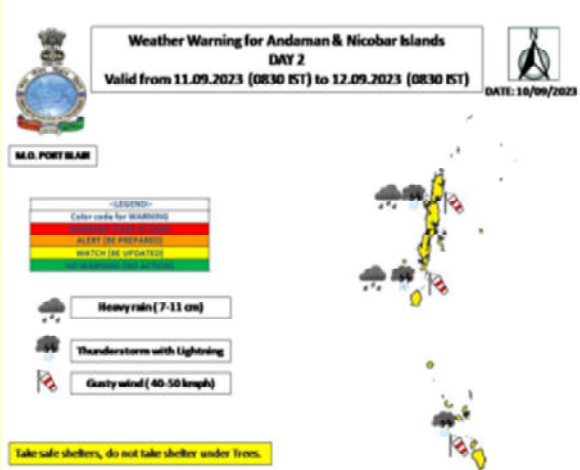
## Heavy rain to occur in Isles

Heavy rain (07-11 cm) is likely to occur at one or two places over Nicobar Islands and thunderstorm and lightning accompanied with gusty wind (speed reaching 40-50 kmph) is also likely to occur at one or two places over A&N Islands on Sept. 11, 12 & 13. Thunderstorm and lightning accompanied with gusty wind (speed reaching 30-40 kmph) is likely to occur at one or two places over A&N Islands on Sept. 14.

Due to strong monsoon current over the Southeast Bay of Bengal and Andaman Sea with wind speed exceeding 45 kmph and sea condition become rough over the area, fishermen have been advised not to venture into the sea till Sept. 14. 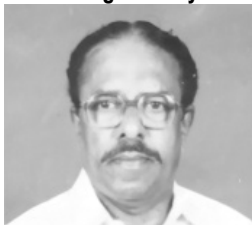

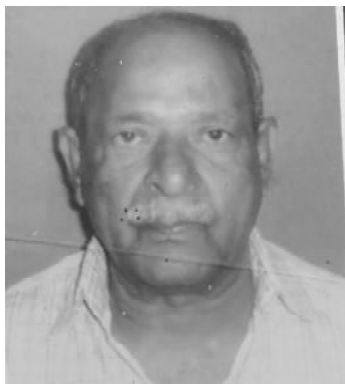
