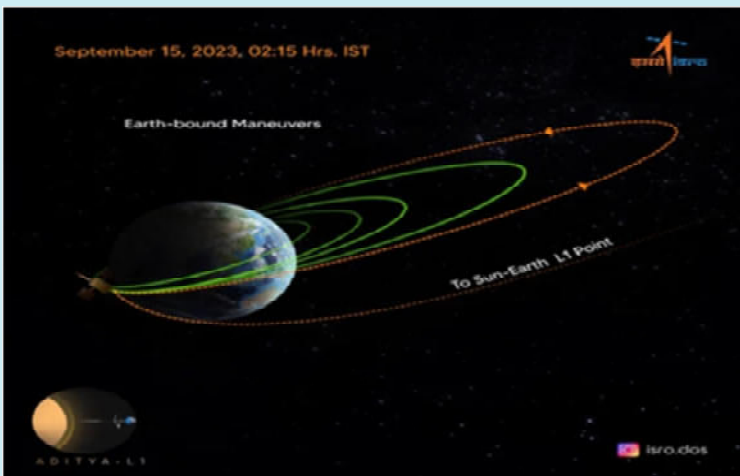

## Aditya- L1 spacecraft successfully completes fourth earth-bound orbit manoeuvre

New Delhi, Sept. 15

India's first space-based mission to study the Sun, Aditya-L1 spacecraft successfully underwent the fourth earth-bound manoeuvre early morning today. ISRO's has posted on X handle that the Ground Stations at Mauritius, Bengaluru, SDSC-SHAR and Port Blair tracked the satellite during this operation. The new orbit attained is 256 km x 121973 kms. "The next manoeuvre Trans-Lagrangean Point 1 Insertion (TLI) -- a send-off from the Earth -- is scheduled for September 19, around 02:00 Hrs. IST." With



Lagrange Point.

Aditya-L1 is the first Indian space-based observatory to study the Sun from a halo orbit around the first Sun-Earth Lagrangian Point (L1), which is located roughly 1.5 million km from the Earth. A spacecraft placed in the halo orbit around the L1 Point has the major advantage of continuously viewing the Sun without any occultation or eclipses.

This will provide a greater advantage in observing solar activities and their effect on space weather in real-time. (Source: india.gov.in)

Millet is a collective term referring to a number of small-seeded annual grasses that are cultivated as grain crops, primarily on marginal lands in dry areas in temperate, subtropical and tropical regions. Some of the common millets available in India are Ragi (Finger millet), Jowar (Sorghum), Sama (Little millet), Bajra (Pearl millet), and Variga (Proso millet). Millets are less expensive and nutritionally superior to wheat & rice owing to their high protein, fibre, vitamins and minerals like iron content. Millets can help tackle lifestyle problems and health challenges such as obesity and diabetes as they are gluten-free and have a low glycaemic index (a relative ranking of carbohydrate in foods according to how they affect blood glucose levels).

More than 25 MBBS students comprising of 7 different teams participated in this event, innovated various millet based easy to cook recipes and demonstrated their skill. The highlight of the competition was that all the delicacies were cooked without using flame. Team 5 'Scrumptious Delicacies' comprising of S. # International Day For the Preservation of Ozone Layer ( Ozone Day)

International Day for the Preservation of the Ozone Layer is celebrated on 16<sup>th</sup> September every year. In 1994, September 16<sup>th</sup> was designated as "International Day for the Preservation of the Ozone Layer" by the United Nations General Assembly. Since then, 16<sup>th</sup> September is celebrated as International Day for the Preservation of the Ozone Layer (World Ozone Day) each year.

So, this year the theme of the World Ozone Day of 2023 is Montreal Protocol: fixing the Ozone Layer and reducing climate change.

The Ozone Layer is a fragile shield of gas, which protects the Earth from the harmful portion of the Rays of the Sun, without an Ozone Layer, harmful UV rays of the Sun would reach us and harm us.

#### History of Ozone Layer depletion

Depletion of Ozone Layer was for the first time identified during the 1980s. Chlorofluorocarbons (CFCs) and other halogenated substances are mainly responsible for manmade ozone depletion. The catastrophic effect of depleting Ozone Layer is already visible in the form of damage to crops and plants, increased risk of skin cancer, cataract and reduction of plankton population.

#### Search for ozone-friendly alternatives

Its depletion had generated worldwide concern that leads to the adoption of Montreal Protocol Treaty. This treaty regulates the manufacture of chemicals that damage the Ozone Layer and at the same time encourages member nations to search for other ozone-friendly alternatives. Depletion of Ozone Layer occurs when intense cold conditions induce radical catalytic reactions that convert atmospheric chlorine from artificially produced chemicals into atomic halogens which destroy ozone. The main source of this halogen is the photo dissociation of man made halo carbon refrigerants and aerosols such as CFCs, HCFCs, fleons and halons. All these are together referred to as Ozone Depleting Substance (ODS).

#### Products that cause ozone depletion

Though the list of ODS is not exhaustive, some commonly



used products have been identified that have a substantial effect on the atmospheric Ozone Layer. Here is a list of 5 most commonly used products that are detrimental for the health of Ozone Layer:

1. Inhalers
2. Fire extinguisher
3. Aerosol sprays (insecticide sprays, body and hair sprays, spray pain cane etc)
4. Foam insulation product
5. Air Conditioners & refrigerators both domestic and commercial.

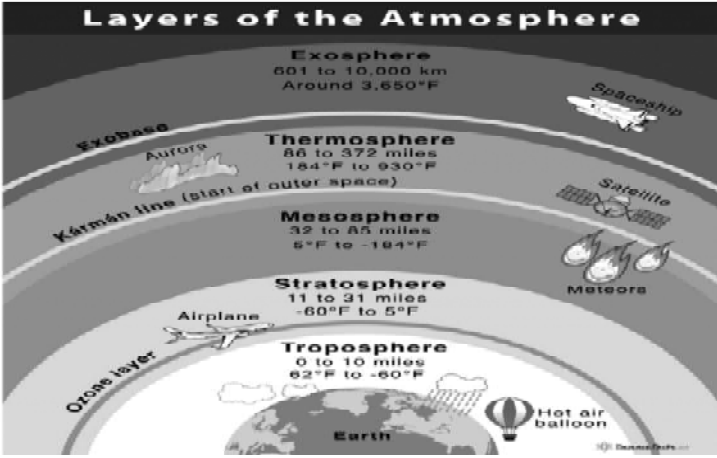
#### Alternatives to the ozone-depleting products

1. Ozone-friendly Inhaler

2. Non-ozone depleting Fire Extinguisher
3. Eco-Aerosol sprays
4. Ban on use of HCFC in foam Industries
5. Air conditioners & refrigerators both domestic and commercial

On interception of the said pickup van, a total of 31 pieces of illegal Hand sawn padauk timber measuring 1.0147 m<sup>3</sup> Cbm (approx) was recovered and seized under the cover of seizure memo and the 2 persons namely Sanjan Kumar, 27, S/o Late George Khosh, Pvt. Driver, R/o Aniket and Sandeep Xalxo, 30, S/o Late Fabianus Xalxo, Pvt worker, R/o Mathura, Ward No. 2 were detained. On interrogation, the offenders disclosed that they had brought the illegal hand sawn padauk timber from Mile Tilak. A team comprising of SI Samiran Mridha, the then incharge of PS Ograbraj and others was formed and a joint raid was conducted during which 08 more pieces of hand sawn padauk timber measuring 0.0900 Cbm approx (quantity) were recovered from the surrounding premises of house of one person namely Prabal Tirkey, 40, S/o Late Avinash Tirkey, DRM at Forest, R/o Mile Tilak. Further, sawn timbers of padauk were seized under the cover of seizure memo and the accused persons were detained.

During the operation, a total of 1.1047 Cbm of illegal hand sawn padauk timber was seized. Later, all the seized illegal hand sawn padauk timber along with the persons were handed over to Forest Official for further necessary action from their end.
