Hon'ble Prime Minister to launch PM Vishwakarma Scheme to connect artisans with domestic and global value chains today

New Delhi, Sept. 16

Hon'ble Prime Minister, Shri Narendra Modi will launch the PM Vishwakarma Scheme on the occasion of Vishwakarma Jayanti tomorrow (Sept.17) at the India International Convention and Expo Centre in New Delhi. The aim of the scheme is to not only support the artisans and craftspeople of rural and urban areas across the country financially but also to keep the age-old tradition, culture, and diverse heritage alive and flourishing through local products, art and crafts.

It has been the sustained focus of the Hon'ble Prime Minister to give support to the people engaged in traditional crafts. The prime focus of the scheme which covers 18 traditional crafts is to improve the quality as well as the reach of products and services and to ensure that they are integrated with the domestic and global value chains. It aims to strengthen and nurture the Guru-Shishya parampara or family-based practice of traditional skills by Vishwakarmas working with their hands and tools.

The scheme will be fully funded by the Centre with an outlay of 13 thousand crore rupees and under it, the Vishwakarma will be registered free of charge through Common Service Centres using the biometric-based PM Vishwakarma portal. Earlier, the Hon'ble Prime Minister had mentioned the scheme and its importance in his Mann Ki Baat through Akashvani. (Source:india.gov.in)

DC (SA) holds meeting regarding arrangements pertaining to Ganesh Chaturthi celebration

Issues necessary directions to concerned Departments for smooth conduct of the festival

A meeting was held in the District Office under the chairmanship of Smti Veditha Reddy, IAS, Deputy Commissioner (SA) with officials of Line Departments regarding arrangements being made for the ensuing Ganesh Chaturthi celebrations. Officials from line Departments comprising of A&N Police, Port Management Board, Police Marine Force, APWD, Health Services, Electricity Department and Tourism attended the meeting.

The DC (SA) briefed the officials and informed that the District Office had recently held a meeting with various Committees organizing the Ganesh Puja in and around South Andaman and have issued instructions and guidelines to them to be followed strictly for the smooth conduct of the

Puja celebrations. She stated that the line Departments should also take necessary steps for smooth conduct of the celebrations starting from inspection of the Puja Pandals with regard to the arrangements being made by the Committee to meet any eventuality with respect to fire, crowd management, traffic congestion and any unlawful activities in and around the pandals. She also issued directions to the concerned Departments to conduct surprise checks in this regard.

She further informed that adequate arrangements are required to be made for the immersion of the Idols and as per precedence to avoid congestion in traffic movement and accordingly, two locations are being allocated for immersion of the idols i.e. Chatham and Jodakalan.

The concerned Departments were issued directions to erect reinforcement at the designated places of immersion of idols on the both sides of the bridges to avoid any untoward incident like toppling of individuals into sea while immersion of idols, provide genset and install focus lights to have good visibility in and around the area, deployment of lifeguards and boats around the vicinity of the designated immersion place, provision of cranes at both the places for assistance in the immersion of idols. She further directed that Communication Room should be set up at both places with adequate communication equipment and also to provide ambulances with adequate paramedics to meet any eventuality, a press release from DC (SA) said.

A&N Pollution Control Committee issues guidelines for idol immersion

Puja Committees asked to adhere to the guidelines

Port Blair, Sept. 16

Andaman and Nicobar Idol Immersion Rules 2018 were published in the Andaman and Nicobar Gazette No. 23 dated 05-03-2018 in compliance of Hon'ble National Green Tribunal order dated 06-10-2017 in O.A 51/2016/EZ. The Rules framed covers the general guidelines idol making, ban on use of synthetic colors, height of super structures and idols. In this connection, the A&N Pollution Control Committee, Deptt. of Science & Technology, A&N Administration has directed all the Idol makers and Puja Committees to follow the guidelines for idol immersion as mentioned below:

> Idols should be made from natural materials as described in the holy scripts. Use of traditional clay for idol making rather than baked clay, Plaster of Paris (POP) etc. shall be encouraged, allowed and promoted.

> There shall be a complete ban on the use of POP in idol making till it is established that the POP has no negative impact on the water quality and aquatic biodiversity.

> Painting of idols should be discouraged. In case idols are to be painted, water soluble and non-toxic natural dyes are to be used.

> There shall be a complete ban on the use of synthetic colour for painting of idols that would require immersion as part of final ritual of the festival.

> The height of the super structure of the idol shall be less than 40 ft. and the idol also shall not exceed 20ft in height.

> Materials used in worship like flowers, vastras (clothes), decorative materials (made of paper and plastic) etc. should be removed before immersion of idols. Biodegradable materials should be collected separately for recycling or composting at designated sites whereas the non-biodegradable materials should be collected separately for disposal in sanitary landfills or as prescribed by the local Municipal Authority or local body. Clothes may be sent to local orphanage(s).

> Idol Immersion should be done between low tide line and high tide line (irrespective of its depth) in identified places with permission of District Administration only.

> Single use plastic should not be used during celebration. A&N Pollution Control Committee has appealed to the citizens to make this Puja celebration 'Plastic Free', a press release received here said.

ICG conducts international coastal cleanup drive

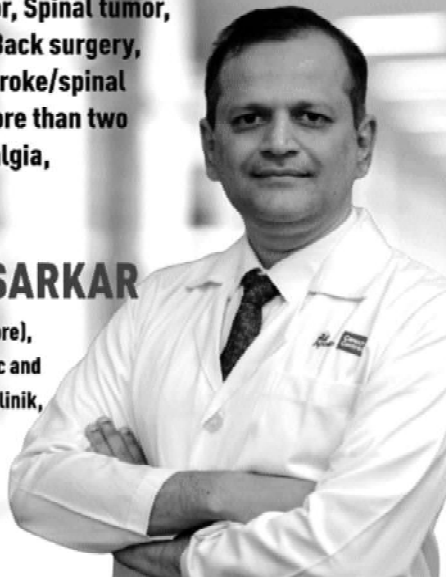
