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Lok Sabha passes Women's Reservation Bill Bill seeks to provide 33% reservation to women in Lok Sabha and State Legislative Assemblies

New Delhi, Sept. 20

Lok Sabha has given its nod to the Constitution (One Hundred and Twenty-Eighth Amendment) Bill seeking to provide one-third reservation to reserve one-third of the total number of seats in Lok Sabha and State legislative assemblies for women. The bill is called Nari Shakti Vandan Adhiniyam. The Bill was passed after a division of vote in which 454 MPs voted in favor of the Bill while two MPs were against it. The Bill was introduced yesterday on the first day of proceedings of the Lok Sabha in the new Parliament Building.

Replying to the discussion over the Bill, Union Law and Justice Minister, Shri Arjun Ram Meghwal said, the bill will provide greater representation to women in policymaking. Earlier, moving the Bill, Shri Meghwal said, it is a step towards women's empowerment and it will enhance their dignity by ensuring equality of opportunities. He said the present



Government has taken several steps towards removing social and economic inequalities in the country by implementing several schemes

ensuring equality for women.

Speaking on the Bill, Union Home Minister, Shri Amit Shah said, women-led development

will start with the passage of the Women Reservation Bill. He said, this Bill would ensure women's participation in the policy-making which was pending for years. He said that since the formation of this Government under the leadership of Prime Minister, Shri Narendra Modi, security, dignity, and participation of women have been the focus area of the Government. Giving the example of Jan Dhan account, he said, 70 percent of account holders are women. He said, 11 crore 72 lakh toilets were made across the country which ensured the empowerment of women. Shri Shah said, three crore houses were built for women and 12 crore houses have been connected with tap water connections. He said, three crore women have benefitted under the Pradhan Mantri Matru Vandana Yojana. He said, census and delimitation will be held after the 2024 Lok Sabha Election. (Source: india.gov.in)

Welcoming the chief guest and others present on the occasion, Dr. C. Sivaperuman, Officer In- Charge, ANRC/ZSI, Port Blair said, World Ozone Day, observed every year on September 16, is also known as the International Day for the Preservation of the Ozone Layer. The date was designated by the United Nations General Assembly in 1994, commemorating the date in 1987 when nations signed the Montreal Protocol on Substances that Deplete the Ozone Layer. He said, on this special day, mass awareness is created to draw attention of everyone towards the usefulness of ozone layer and how it protects us from UV rays.

The function concluded with the vote of thanks proposed by Research Consultant, Dr. Swarnakala.

Earlier during the day, Prof. Gurmeet Singh, Vice Chancellor, Pondicherry University, Puducherry inaugurated the one-day seminar as the chief guest. Dr. Ramakrishna & Dr. Kailash Chandra, Former Directors, ZSI, Dr. P.S. Easa, Former Director, Kerala Forest Research Institute, Thrissur were the guests of honour.

In his inaugural address, Prof. Gurmeet Singh, talked about the global threat that is the Changing Ozone Layer and mentioned the duties of the citizens to protect it from further depletion. He stated that every individual has a role to play in protecting the environment. Diglipur Police solves hit and run blind case

Acting swiftly on the complaint of hit and run blind case at Madhupur Road, Diglipur the Police team of Diglipur arrested one accused within 24 hours. On Sept.17, 2023, a complaint was received at PS Diglipur from one Shri Subrata Halder, resident of Subashgram, Diglipur that on 17/09/23, at around 0815 pm, one of his friend namely Ashim Das, who is a resident of Jalpaiguni, West Bengal were walking from the left side of the main road suddenly an auto rickshaw came in high speed from Laxmipur side and hit Ashim Das, due to which, he fell on the road and got hit on his head and sustained head injury and became unconscious.
