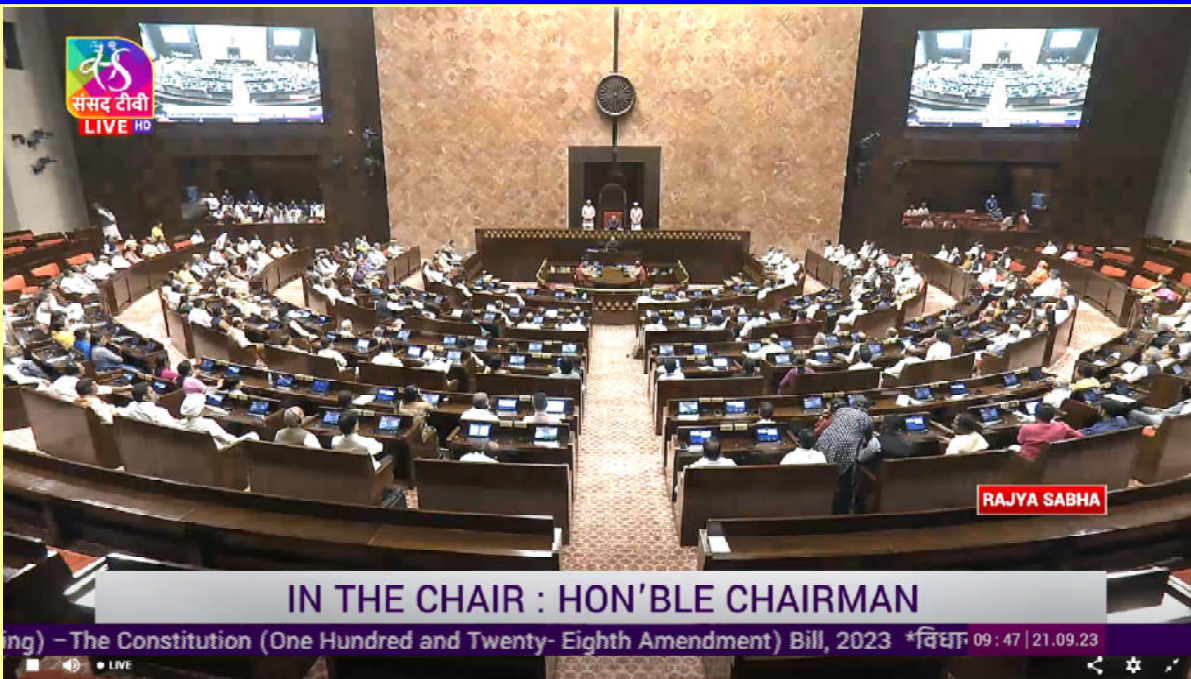

India scripts history as Rajya Sabha passes Nari Shakti Vandan Adhiniyam (Women's Reservation Bill) to reserve 33% of seats for women in Lok Sabha and State Assemblies

New Delhi, Sept. 21

The Rajya Sabha today passed the Nari Shakti Vandan Adhiniyam (Women's Reservation Bill) with 215 members voting in favour of the bill and no one against it. The Bill seeks to provide one-third reservation to women in Lok Sabha and State Assemblies. Union Law and Justice Minister, Shri Arjun Ram Meghwal moved the Constitution (One Hundred and Twenty-Eight Amendment) Bill in the House to further amend the Constitution of India in this regard. Yesterday, Lok Sabha had passed the Bill.

Moving the Bill in the House, Shri Meghwal said this legislation will promote women's empowerment in the country. He said, this is also an important step towards making India a developed nation in the Amrit Kaal. Shri Meghwal also appreciated



Prime Minister, Shri Narendra Modi for bringing welfare schemes like Ujjwala Yojana, Mudra Yojana, and more for the benefit of women. He said, a 33 percent reservation for women belonging to SCs and STs will also be provided within the existing quota, and for this census and delimitation are essential.

Participating in the discussion on the Women's Reservation Bill, Union Finance Minister, Smti Nirmala Sitharaman said that bringing this Bill shows the Government's commitment to the social and economic empowerment of women. She said, the Bill provides one-third of reservation in the Lok Sabha and all the Assemblies in the States and in the Delhi Assembly. She informed that there will also be a reservation for women belonging to SCs and STs in respect of the seats reserved in these categories.

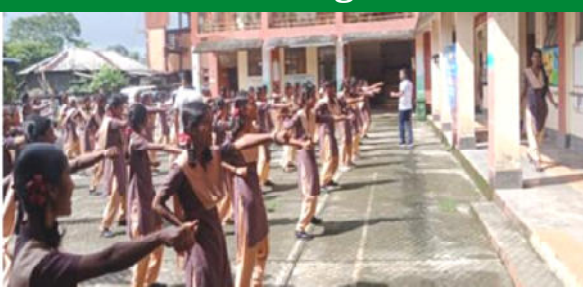

provides a cover of Rs. 5 lakhs per family per year for secondary and tertiary care hospitalization across public and private empanelled hospitals in India.

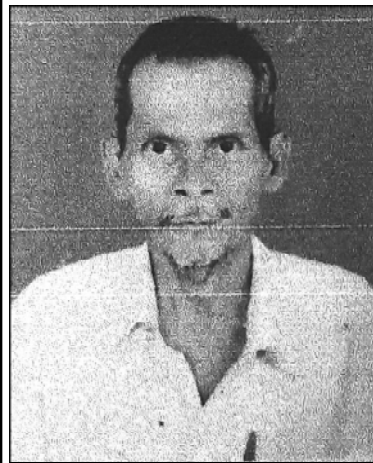
