Admiral D K Joshi, PVSM, AVSM, YSM, NM, VSM (Retd.) Hon'ble Lt. Governor, A&N Islands and Vice-Chairman, Islands Development Agency as the chief guest flagged off these buses at a brief function held at Flag Point here today. The Chief Secretary, A&N Administration, Shri Keshav Chandra, IAS, DGP, A&N Police, Shri Devesh Chandra Srivastva, IPS, PCCF, Dr. T.S. Ashok Kumar, IAS, Commissioner - cum-Secretary, Transport, Shri ASPs Ravi Prakash, IAS, Secretary, Transport, Shri Vishwendra, Adhyaksh, ZPSA, Shri Sanjay Kumar Singh,



Chairperson, PBMC, Smt. S. Selvi, PBMC Councillors, senior officers of the Administration and general public were present on the occasion. In his address, the Chief Secretary said, it is a momentous occasion

logo and preparing video clip.

The Chief Secretary further remarked that ZPSA covers vast area and there is need to deal with the requirements and the aspirations of the people in rural areas effectively and on priority basis. The CS desired that the rural area should be frequently visited by the officials and PRIs to know their issues for its speedy redressal. He stated that the Administration is making all out efforts to improve sectors such as water, electricity, road and health. He said, to tide over the water supply in dry season, the Administration is planning to increase the storage capacity through creation of new ponds/ check weirs in different areas through PWD, Rural Development Department and PBMC. Bore wells are also being dug by the Administration not only in South Andaman but also in North & Middle Andaman too, the Chief Secretary said. Apart from the initiative from the Administration, the general public can also contribute towards water storage by constructing rainwater harvesting structures at their respective buildings. He urged the PRI members to educate people on this count and ensure that the rainwater harvesting structures are constructed in their buildings without fail. Regarding electricity, he said, the deficiency of 10 MW of power is being experienced in South Andaman and efforts are on to tied over this shortage. It is expected that by next month, the total demand of the power in South Andaman will be met and regular power supply can be maintained.

In the road sector, the Chief Secretary said that the black topping of roads will start as soon as the weather condition improves. The tender procedures for the roads which needs black topping will be completed in time, so that work can be started in fair weather and maximum roads will be covered with the available fund.

In the Health Sector, the Chief Secretary said health infrastructure facility is good in the Health Institutions in different Islands. He further informed that the Tertiary Unit GB Pant Hospital will be further strengthened and services of specialist doctors will be made available. The Chief Secretary said that for the first time, many critical surgeries which were possible only in mainland have now done in GB Pant Hospital. This, he said, is a great achievement as people are getting this surgery done at their door step without going to mainland.

Earlier, in his welcome speech, the Adhyaksh, Zilla Parishad, South Andaman, Shri Sanjay Kumar Singh expressed his gratitude to the Chief Secretary, A&N Administration for sparing his valuable time for the launch of official logo of Zilla Parishad, South Andaman. With this, he said, the long felt need of a logo for ZPSA has been fulfilled. He also emphasized his commitment towards the inclusive welfare and development of rural areas with the objective to improve the social & economic conditions of the rural people and make them self-reliant.

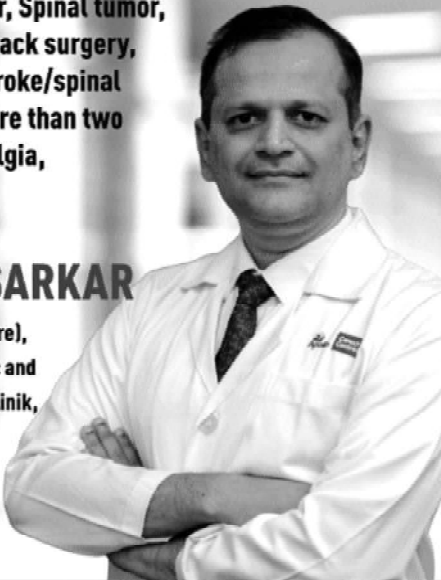
