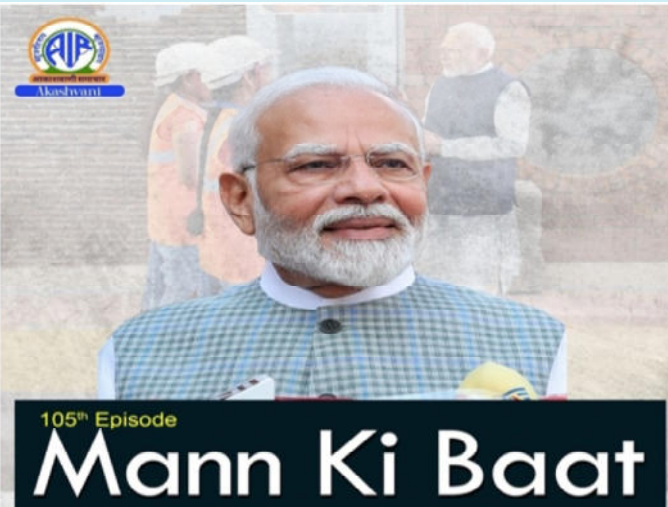

India proves its leadership by making African Union a full member of G20 forum: PM

New Delhi, Sept. 24

Prime Minister, Shri Narendra Modi today said that India has proved the mettle of her leadership during the recently held G20 Leaders' Summit by making the African Union a full member of the G20. Addressing the nation in his Mann Ki Baat programme on Akashvani, Shri Modi said, the India-Middle East-Europe Economic Corridor announced during the Summit is going to become the basis of world trade for hundreds of years to come. He exuded pride that history will always remember that this economic corridor was initiated on Indian soil. He compared it with the Silk Route which was a major medium of business and trade when India was very prosperous.

Prime Minister added that the venue of Delhi G20 - Bharat Mandapam - has turned out to be a celebrity in itself. He appreciated that people are taking selfies with it and posting them on social



media with pride. Prime Minister made a special mention of the way India's youth power associated itself with the G20. He spoke about the 'G20 University Connect Programme' which is going to be held in Delhi. Through this programme, lakhs of university students across the country will connect with each other. Many prestigious institutions like IITs, IIMs, NITs, and Medical Colleges will also participate in it. Prime Minister asked college students to watch this program to be held on 26th September and join it. He said, he looks forward to communicating with college students during the programme.

Shri Modi noted that the fascination towards India has

risen a lot in the last few years, especially since the G20 Summit. He said that more than one lakh delegates came to India for the G20. Saying that World Tourism Day is being observed on the 27th of this month, Shri Modi said, employment generation is a very big aspect of tourism. He further drove home the point that the Tourism sector generates maximum employment with minimum investment. He added that during G20, foreign delegates got acquainted with the diversity of the country and the different traditions, cuisines, and heritage. He said that the experiences that the delegates have carried back with them will further expand tourism.

Prime Minister expressed happiness that the number of world heritage sites in India is continuously rising. Shanti Niketan and the Hoysala

The Department of Fisheries conducted a workshop on 'Retail Fish Marketing' at Fisheries Training Centre, Marine Hill with the active participation of Women Fish Vendors of Dignabad area recently. The programme was organized with the objective of creating awareness among the Fish Vending Community on Food Safety compliance, importance of Weights and Measures for responsible fish trade and hygienic handling of fishes for better consumer acceptance. The participants were made aware on the usage of various preservation techniques and essential requirement of safety and

hygienic gears during fish sale. The nutritional and health aspects of fish consumption in fresh form were also discussed during the session. Shri Nagoor Meeran, Food Safety Officer emphasized the need for creating facilities and food safety requirements for new registration and renewal of existing vendor registrations. Shri Saurabh Murthy, Legal Metrological Officer explained the need for usage of proper weighing balance for seafood products and detailed about the penal provisions in place on un-authorized usage of Weights and Measures.
