## PM addresses Rozgar Mela

# Distributes about 51,000 appointment letters to newly inducted recruits

## Devotion of the recruits to service will enable the country to accomplish its goals: PM

New Delhi, Sept. 26 (PIB)

The Prime Minister, Shri Narendra Modi addressed the Rozgar Mela and distributed about 51,000 appointment letters to newly inducted recruits via video conferencing today. The recruits, selected from across the country will be joining the Government in various Ministries/ Departments including Department of Posts, Indian Audit & Accounts Department, Department of Atomic Energy, Department of Revenue, Department of Higher Education, Ministry of Defence, Ministry of Health & Family Welfare among others. The Rozgar Mela took place at 46 locations across the country.

Addressing the gathering, the Prime Minister congratulated those who received their appointment letters today. He remarked that they are here due to their hard work and dedication and they have been selected from a pool of millions of candidates. Noting the festivities of Ganesh Utsav across the country, the Prime Minister said that it is the 'Shri Ganesh' of a new life for the appointees during this auspicious occasion. "Lord Ganesh is the God of accomplishments", the Prime Minister said, as he expressed confidence that the devotion of the



recruits towards service will enable the country to accomplish its goals.

The Prime Minister said that the country is bearing witness to historic achievements. He mentioned the Narishakti Vandan Adhinyam which has empowered half of the population. "Women reservation issue which was stuck for 30

years, has passed by both the houses with record votes. This decision took place in the first session of the new Parliament, in a way, it is a new beginning for the nation in the new Parliament", Prime Minister emphasized.

Acknowledging the significant presence of women among the new recruits, the Prime

Minister said that daughters of the country are making a name in every sector. "I feel immense pride in the achievement of the Narishakti and it is the policy of the Government to keep opening new avenues for their growth", he said. The Prime Minister noted that the presence of women in any sector has always led to positive changes in every sector.

Referring to the soaring aspirations of the New India, the Prime Minister said that the dreams of this New India are lofty. "India has taken the resolve to become Viksit Bharat by 2047", the Prime Minister remarked. He underlined that in the next few years, the nation will become the third-largest economy in the world where the Government employees will have a lot to contribute in the coming times. He emphasized that they follow the approach of 'Citizens First. Noting that today's recruits grew up with technology, the Prime Minister stressed making use of it in their field of work and improving the efficiency of governance.

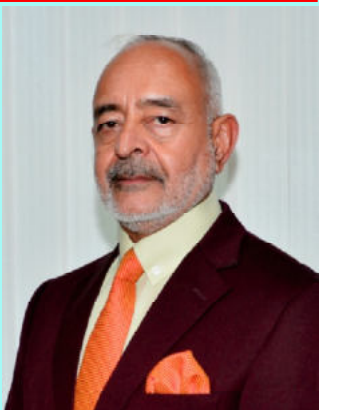

Digilocker, eKYC, gas booking, bill payments, DBT and Digiyaatra. "Technology has stopped corruption, improved credibility, reduced complexity, increased comfort," said the Prime Minister, urging the new recruits to work further in this direction.

During this one year period, the recruitment process was reviewed by the Chief Secretary, A&N Administration several times. "I myself, along with the Administration, held review meetings in this context on 13<sup>th</sup> October, 2022, 6<sup>th</sup> December, 2022, 24<sup>th</sup> February, 2023 and 12<sup>th</sup> May, 2023. As a result of these efforts, today, this recruitment process has been successfully implemented", the Hon'ble Lt. Governor said. The progress of the recruitment was communicated through issuance of press releases and other social media platforms, the Lt. Governor added.

Through this Rozgar Mela, the A&N Administration has reached an important milestone in realizing the Hon'ble Prime Minister's vision of employment generation. He said, since, there are no industries here in A&N Islands, only small-scale industry is available, hence, Government job has become the most prominent source of employment/income for the Islanders. He said, over the years, about four thousand five hundred posts have fallen vacant in the Administration and there was also the need to fulfill the dreams and aspirations of the unemployed youth by filling up all these vacancies through recruitment. Keeping this in mind, the A&N Administration embarked on a mission mode to fill up all these vacant posts and took on the herculean task to conduct recruitment drives to fill



up vacancies in all Departments, which were successfully conducted through concerted and coordinated efforts from all Departments. For the smooth conduct of the recruitment process, the Chief Secretary expressed his sincere thanks and gratitude to the Hon'ble Lt. Governor, who conducted review meeting from time to time and guided the entire process, the result of which, he said, is what has been witnessed today in the entire country, as Andaman and Nicobar Islands alone distributed 876 Appointment Letters to the candidates today. The Chief Secretary informed that in the coming three months, many more candidates will also be given Appointment Letters during the Rozgar Mela and the credit for which goes to the Hon'ble Lt. Governor for speeding up the process.

The Chief Secretary said, in the first phase, to fill 565 posts, the higher secondary exam (LGC, Stenographer, Tally Clerk, Patwari, etc) was held on Nov. 20, 2022, in which 38,396 candidates were registered while 33,292 candidates appeared for the exam. Similarly, in the second phase, the common recruitment matric level exam to fill 2520 posts was held on July 9, 2023, in which, 48702 candidates registered, while 40982 candidates appeared in the exam. In the third phase, the common higher secondary exam to fill 479 posts was held on July 23, 2023, in which, 21882 candidates registered while 18,583 candidates appeared for the exam. Apart from this, the Transport Deptt., the Electricity Deptt., APWD, Education Deptt. and Police Deptt. has conducted recruitment to fill up 458 vacant posts, and the process of declaring the result are in progress.

The Chief Secretary further informed that the recruitment exams were held in all three districts, for which, the Administration took extra care in conducting these exams in free, fair and transparent manner with the cooperation of personnel from Police, Forest, Education, Transport, Postal Departments etc. and senior officers were engaged for the smooth conduct of the exams.

Earlier, in his welcome address, the Commissioner-cum-Secretary (Home/Education), Shri Nikhil Kumar, IAS, said, "today marks an important day for A&N Islands as in line with the vision of PM Modi's 'Viksit Bharat', great journey has been made to achieve this vision with the Rozgar Mela today. Availability of quality employment is considered one of the major economic and social indicators of any society, he said, and in this direction, the Government of India, under the guidance of the Hon'ble Prime Minister, is realizing the effort of providing Government jobs to more than 10 lakh people. For the accomplishment of this resolution, under the able leadership of the Hon'ble Lt. Governor, with continuous review meetings and unwavering commitment, in the last one year, the process of employment recruitment for more than 4000 posts in the Andaman & Nicobar Islands is now in the final stages of completion. ## Orientation-cum- Sensitization Program on Sexual Harassment of Women at Workplace organized by Social Welfare Department

The Directorate of Social Welfare has been organizing Orientation-cum- Sensitization Program on Sexual Harassment of Women at Workplace (Prevention, Prohibition and Redressal) Act 2013 for all employees of different Departments, Educational Institutions, NGOs, Banks and Sports Authorities of A&N Islands with effect from 20.9.2023 to 28.9.2023.

The Orientation-cum- Sensitization Program was organized for 23 Govt. Departments and 6 Educational Institutions (Tagore College, JNRM, Andaman Law College, DBRAIT, ANCOL & DIET) at respective office conference hall and conference hall of Industries and Tagore Auditorium. The recent program was held for Forest Department at Van Sadan on 21.9.2023, where in Shri Ravi Horo, IFS, Conservator of Forest, Head Quarter, PCCF Office, was the chief guest. While delivering the key note address,



he stressed that equal opportunities should be available to both men & women and they should be considered equal human and given opportunities. Further to support their personal security, dignity in workplace, the Sexual Harassment of Women at Workplace (Prevention, Prohibition and Redressal) Act 2013 has been implemented and Heads of Departments should ensure proper implementations by giving wide publicity & awareness among male and female employees.

The technical session was addressed by Smt. Santhi Murugesan, Central Administrator, One Stop Centre under the Directorate of Social Welfare, who dwelt at length on

Vishaka guidelines, which was in force before the enactment of present Sexual Harassment of Women at Workplace (Prevention, Prohibition and Redressal) Act 2013, which intended to protect women at workplace. During the session, Constitution of Internal Complaint Committee including Presiding Officer and external member's eligibility criteria were explained.
