

# Smt. Droupadi Murmu takes oath as India's 15<sup>th</sup> President; Reiterates her resolve to work towards inclusive growth of country

New Delhi, July 25

Smt. Droupadi Murmu was sworn in as 15th President of India today. She was administered oath by Chief Justice of India N. V. Ramana at the Central Hall of Parliament. Speaking on this occasion, President Smt. Droupadi Murmu said, this is the beauty of Indian democracy that a poor lady from a far-flung area has become the President. She said, reaching the Presidential post is not her personal achievement, it is the achievement of every poor in India. She added that her nomination is evidence that the poor in India can not only dream but also fulfill those dreams. Smt. Murmu reiterated her resolve of working towards upliftment of marginalized, and empowerment of women and young for the inclusive growth of the country.

Saying that in the past few years, a new energy has been infused in the country due to the decisions taken and policies formulated for women empowerment, Smt. Murmu added that she wants all sisters and daughters to be empowered more and more so that they continue to increase their contribution in every field of nation building.

Smt. Murmu highlighted the spirit of new India and the emergence of the country as a global leader. The President said, in 75 years as a Parliamentary democracy, India has carried forward the resolve of progress through participation and consensus. She said, with full of diversities, the country is engaged in the making of 'Ek Bharat-Shreshtha Bharat', by adopting many languages, religions, sects, food habits, lifestyles, and customs. She added, that the Amritkaal, which commences with the 75th year of independence, is a period of new resolutions for India. She said, in these 25 years, the path to attain the goals of Amritkal will proceed on two tracks-'Sabka Prayas aur Sabka Kartavya'. Smt. Murmu said, the new



development journey towards the bright future of India has to be undertaken by the collective efforts, following the path of duty.

Smt. Murmu greeted the nation on the eve of Kargil Vijay Diwas saying that this day is the symbol of courage of country's armed forces. She also remembered the contribution of freedom fighters and stressed the need to speed up efforts to meet the expectations that India's freedom fighters had with the citizens of independent India. Appreciating the efforts of the country during the COVID pandemic, she said, administering 200 crore vaccine doses to the people of the country is a big achievement. The patience, courage, and cooperation shown by the people of the country in this entire battle is a symbol of India's growing strength and sensitivity as a society. The President added

that India not only took care of itself in these difficult situations but also helped the world. She said, in the atmosphere created by the Corona pandemic, today the world is looking at India with new confidence. Smt. Murmu asserted that the international community has high hopes for India for ensuring global economic stability, ease of supply chain and peace.

Earlier in the morning, Smt. Murmu paid tribute at Rajghat in the national capital ahead of her swearing-in. After that, outgoing President Shri Ram Nath Kovind and his wife Smt. Savita extended greetings to Smt. Murmu at Rashtrapati Bhavan. They then reached the Central Hall in a ceremonial procession.

After the conclusion of the ceremony, the President left for Rashtrapati Bhavan where an Inter-Services Guard of Honour was given to her in the Forecourt, and courtesies were extended to the outgoing President Shri Ram Nath Kovind.

Rajya Sabha Chairman Shri M. Venkaiah Naidu, Prime Minister, Shri Narendra Modi, Lok Sabha Speaker, Shri Om Birla, Union Ministers, Governors, Chief Ministers, Heads of Diplomatic Missions, Members of Parliament, and Principal Civil and Military Officers of the Government of India were present in the Swearing-in Ceremony.

President Smt. Droupadi Murmu is the first tribal person and the second woman to hold the position. The 64-year-old is the youngest President of the country. She is also the first President of India who is born after Independence. Smt. Murmu joined politics in 1997 and was elected Councillor in Rairangpur Notified Area Council of Odisha. She served twice as an MLA from Rairangpur Assembly Constituency from 2000 to 2009 and once as a Minister for Commerce, Transport, Fisheries, and Animal Resources Development in Odisha Government. On 18th May 2015, Smt. Murmu took oath as Governor of Jharkhand and stayed in the post till 12th July last year. She was the first woman Governor of the State and the first female tribal leader to serve as a Governor in any Indian State. (Source: india.gov.in)

With the objective of further developing tourism and infrastructure in the A&N Islands, the A&N Administration, under the dynamic leadership of the Hon'ble Lt Governor, A&N Islands & Vice Chairman, Islands Development Agency, Admiral DK Joshi, PVSM, AVSM, YSM, NM, VSM (Retd.), mooted a proposal with the Home Ministry, Govt of India recently for taking over the control of the historic Netaji Subhas Chandra Bose Island (NSCB Island). The proposal was extensively supported by the Hon'ble Home Minister, Shri Amit Shah and Hon'ble Defence Minister, Shri Rajnath Singh. The idea was conceived, proposed & implemented by the Chief Secretary, A&N Administration, Shri Jitendra Narain.

The efforts made by the A&N Administration on this count fructified with the Home Ministry accepting the proposal and the Administration taking over the administrative control of the NSCB Island today. This could be possible due to the support of the Hon'ble Home Minister,

Shri Amit Shah, rigorous efforts made by the Hon'ble Lt. Governor, A&N Islands & Vice Chairman, Islands Development Agency, Admiral DK Joshi, PVSM, AVSM, YSM, NM, VSM (Retd.) and initiatives of the Chief Secretary, A&N Administration, Shri Jitendra Narain.

It is to be mentioned that the Prime Minister, Shri Narendra Modi renamed this Island as 'Netaji Subhas



Chandra Bose Island' during his visit to the A&N Islands in December 2018. Erstwhile, it was known as Ross Island. In October 2021, the Union Home Minister, Shri Amit Shah during his visit to A&N Islands stated that in near future, this Island will be developed and a grand memorial of Netaji will be built on this Island.

The taking over of NSCB Island by the A&N Administration will also pave the way for increased tourism activities benefitting tourists, tourism stakeholders & Islanders.

An official ceremony marking the taking over was held today at Netaji Subhas Chandra Bose Island in which the Dy. Commissioner, South Andaman Shri Suneel Anchipaka symbolically took over the administrative control of the NSCB Island in the presence of the Secretary, IP&T, Shri Hari Kallikkat, SP SA, Shri Kalaivanan. R, ADM, Shri Ankit Yadav and SDM Shri Dilkhush Meena.

It may be recalled that Netaji Subhas Chandra Bose Island had been the Administrative headquarter of British rule in the Islands till the Japanese occupied it in March 1942. Netaji Subhas Chandra Bose also stayed on the Island during his visit to Andaman and Nicobar Islands in December 1943, a press release from the Secretary, IP&T said.

As per data available, a total of 6,91,968 doses of vaccine have been administered to beneficiaries in the age group of 18 and above so far. Similarly, 23,894 beneficiaries have been vaccinated in the age group of 15 to 18 years. 26,328 beneficiaries in the age group of 12 to 14 years have been administered both doses of vaccine. The number of beneficiaries administered both doses of vaccine stood at 202.17 crore.

A total of 3187 eligible beneficiaries were vaccinated in A&N Islands today. 2064 beneficiaries were vaccinated in South Andaman District, out of which, 18 beneficiaries in the age group of 12 to 14 years, 9 beneficiaries were in the age group of 15 to 18 years and the number of beneficiaries administered both doses of vaccine stood at 2011.

In North & Middle Andaman District, 88 beneficiaries were

## India beat West Indies by 2 wickets in Second ODI to take 2-0 lead in three-match series

India defeated West Indies by 2 wickets in the Second ODI at Queen's Park Oval in Port of Spain last night to take a 2-0 lead in the three-match series. Chasing a victory target of 312 runs, India scored 312 runs for 8 wickets in 49.4 overs. For visitors, Axar Patel unbeaten at 64 was the top scorer and Shreyas

Iyer also made 63 runs. Earlier, the hosts won the toss and elected to bat. Batting first, West Indies scored 311 runs for the loss of 6 wickets in the stipulated 50 overs. Opener Shai Hope scored 115 runs while Skipper Nicholas Pooran made 74. West Indies batter Shai Hope has become the tenth batter to score a

century in his 100th ODI. He is also the fourth West Indies batter to do so. For India, Shardul Thakur was the pick of the bowlers with figures of 3 for 54. The third and final ODI will be played on Wednesday at Queen's Park Oval in Port of Spain. The match will start at 7 PM Indian time.

## India administers over 202.17 crore COVID vaccine doses

New Delhi, July 25

More than 202 crore 17 lakh COVID vaccine doses have been administered in the country so far. The Health Ministry said, more than 16 lakh 82 thousand vaccine doses were administered in the last 24 hours. During the same period, 16 thousand 866 new COVID cases were

reported in the country. India's active caseload currently stands at over one lakh fifty thousand and it is at 0.34 percent. The recovery rate is currently at 98.46 percent. A total of over 18 thousand people recovered in the last 24 hours and with this, the total number of recoveries touched over four crore

32 lakh. The Ministry said, the Weekly Positivity Rate stands at 4.49 percent and the Daily Positivity Rate is at 7.03 percent. A total of 87 crore 27 lakh COVID tests have been conducted in the country so far. In the last 24 hours, more than two lakh 39 thousand tests were conducted. (Source: india.gov.in)

demand of Cow milk in the market while endeavouring to provide dairy products to Islanders at affordable prices. With an aim to enhance the citizen-friendly services in the city, the Chief Secretary has mobilized the Corporation to expand its milk supply network. He asked the Corporation officials to enhance the procurement price of raw milk from the farmers from Rs. 40 to Rs. 50 per litre in the interest of farmers. This hike in the procurement price has encouraged several farmers to start/increase their milk supply.

During the year 2020-21, the Corporation procured 615612 litres of raw milk from our farmers. With new pricing, an increase of around 35% has been registered in the procurement of raw milk in the year 2021-22 over the earlier year. On aggregate basis, this initiative has led to an increased income for Milk producing farmers from earlier Rs. 2,76,56,524/- per year to Rs. 4,23,35,342/- per year. These efforts will help the Administration in its endeavor to achieve Hon'ble Prime Minister's vision of doubling farmers' income.

The Chief Secretary has been stressing on improved nutritional security among the Islanders and improving knowledge services and support to the farmers. During the Board meeting, the Chief Secretary reviewed the efforts of the Corporation. He directed the Corporation to utilize its CSR funding to bolster the nutritional security among the children. Accordingly, the Corporation has made arrangement for the supply of approximately 1500 litres of toned milk packed in 200 ml pouches to 333 Anganwadi Kendras in South Andaman on daily basis. 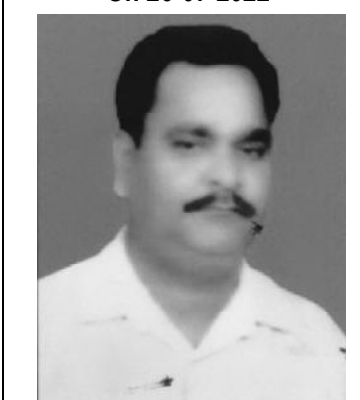
