New Delhi, May 31 (PIB)

Prime Minister Shri Narendra Modi addressed 'Garib Kalyan Sammelan' in Shimla, Himachal Pradesh today. This novel public programme marking the completion of eight years of the government led by the Prime Minister was organized across the country at State Capitals, District Headquarters, and Krishi Vigyan Kendras. The Sammelan conceptualizes elected public representatives across the country directly interacting with the public to get feedback about the various welfare programmes being run by the Government.

The Prime Minister also released the 11th installment of financial benefits under the Pradhan Mantri Kisan Samman Nidhi (PM-KISAN) scheme. This will enable the transfer of an amount of around Rs. 21,000 crore to more than 10 crore beneficiary farmer families. Shri Tashi Tundup said that he did not face any problem in availing the benefits of schemes like PMAY, Toilets, Gas Connections, and farming-related benefits.

Smt Lalita Devi Ji from Bihar is a beneficiary of PMAY, Ujjwala, Swachh Bharat, and Jal Jeevan Mission. She informed the PM, how schemes led to

her ease of living and dignified life. The Prime Minister said that with a house many things like education and marriage of the children will fall in place.

Continuing the untiring efforts of the Administration to manage the power situation in the Islands, senior officers of Revenue and Power Departments conducted inspections at major energy guzzling establishments which are suspected to have electricity thefts. The task forces inspected 9 hotels, crushers and commercial establishments in Aberdeen Bazaar, Marine Hill, Sippighat and Teylorabad on May 31, 2022, wherein electricity theft was reported at 05 Commercial establishments including



some famous hotels.

It is pertinent to mention that more than 200 electricity theft cases by establishments including some big commercial establishments have been reported in last 10 days. Still, one or two establishments are creating rumours and misleading the general public.

It is to be noted that big commercial

that, electricity theft will be dealt sternly as it is a serious crime with massive financial implications.

Further, people have been requested to use power judiciously and not to be misled by rumour mongers. Digital India Internship Scheme by MeitY-2022; interested candidates to apply by June 5

Port Blair, May 31

The Ministry of Electronics and Information Technology (MeitY) has launched the Internship scheme 2022 having 60 seats in various areas, duration of which is two months, starting from June 20, 2022. The last date for applying for the same is June 5, 2022. The previous application from MeitY is from NIC which has only 20 seats.

For the larger benefit of the student community and with a view to enrich the management/implementation of its various

schemes/programmes, the Ministry of Electronics and Information Technology has decided to notify "Internship Guidelines", to provide a framework for engagement of Interns for a limited period.

Indian students from recognized universities in India who have secured at least 60% marks in the last held degree or certificate examination and pursuing B.E./B.Tech, M.E./M.Tech/ MCA, MSc (Electronics)/ MSc(CS)/ MSc(IT), DoEACC 'B' level shall be eligible.

Launch of special campaign 'Rashtriya Netra Jyoti Abhiyaan' today; primary screening of people for cataract to be done

Port Blair, May 31

Blindness and visual impairment due to cataract is one of the major public health challenges in the country, especially among the people aged 50 years or more. The National Blindness and Visual Impairment Survey Report (2015-2018) shows that among people age 50 years or above, 1.99% faced blindness and 1.96% faced Severe Visual Impairment (SVI), in the survey period, 50% of people in both eyes. It is also estimated that every year

approximately 20% of such people progress to blindness or SVI.

To address this issue in a comprehensive manner, the Govt of India has decided to launch a special campaign 'Rashtriya Netra Jyoti Abhiyaan' starting in the month of June 2022, with the target to completely covering the backlog of cataract surgeries causing Blindness and SVI, among the people aged 50 years or above.

Contributions of finest teachers to be recognized by GoI; nominations invited for award

Port Blair, May 31

The Department of School Education & Literacy, Ministry of Education, GoI will celebrate the unique contribution of some of the finest teachers in the country and to honor those teachers who through their commitment and industry have not only improved the quality of school education but also enriched the lives of their students.

All school teachers and Heads of Schools working in recognized primary/middle/high/

higher secondary schools run by State Govt./UT Administration, local bodies, aided by State Govt./UT Administration, central government schools, schools run by Ministry of Defence and Eklavya Model Residential Schools (EMRS) run by Ministry of Tribal Affairs and school affiliated to CBSE or CISCE are eligible for consideration for the award.

Normally retired teachers are not eligible for the award but those who have served a part of this calendar year are eligible.

However, educational administrators, inspectors of education, staff of training institutes, teachers /headmaster indulged in tuitions, contractual teachers and Shiksha Mitras are not eligible for the said award.

Registrations for the self-nomination by teachers can be done on the online web portal <http://nationalawardstoteachers.education.gov.in> which is open from 01.06.2022 and last date for the same is 20.06.2022, a press release from Directorate of Education said.

the farmers as more than 10 crore farmers have received the money in their bank accounts through the PM Kisan scheme. He expressed satisfaction that he released benefits under the PM CARES for Children Scheme on the occasion of the completion of 8 years of the Government. He expressed happiness for releasing the financial benefits under the Pradhan Mantri Kisan Samman Nidhi (PM-KISAN) scheme nationwide from Shimla. He thanked the people for giving him the opportunity to serve 130 crore citizens.

The Prime Minister also conveyed his satisfaction on marking 8 years by taking up the responsibility of the children who lost both their parents to the Corona pandemic through PM CARES for Children yesterday. He said that the suggestion to be in Himachal for this occasion was accepted by him with promptness as the State has been his Karmbhoomi. The Prime Minister said that he always sees himself as a member of the family of 130 crore citizens and not as a Prime Minister. Only when he signs a file does he take the responsibility of the Prime Minister. As soon as that moment gets over, he said "I no longer remain Prime Minister and become the member of your family and Pradhan Sevak of the 130 countrymen. If I am able to do anything for the country, it is only because of the blessings and good wishes of 130 crore countrymen." An emotional Prime Minister said, "Getting connected with the hopes and aspirations of my family of 130 crore citizens, this family is all I have, you people are everything in my life and this life too is for you." The Prime Minister said as the government is completing its eight years, he repeated his resolve again that he will do whatever he can, for the welfare of everyone, for the honour of every Indian, for the security of every Indian, and for the prosperity of every Indian for them to get a life of happiness and peace.

The Prime Minister lamented that before 2014, the earlier government had considered corruption as an essential part of the system, then instead of fighting corruption, the government had succumbed to it, then the country was watching that the money for schemes was looted before reaching the needy. He added that today due to the trinity of Jan Dhan-Aadhaar and Mobile (JAM), the money is reaching the beneficiary directly in their Jan Dhan bank accounts. Earlier there was a compulsion to suffer smoke in the kitchen, today there is a facility to get LPG cylinders from the Ujjwala scheme. Earlier there was the shame of open defecation now poor have the dignity of toilets. Earlier there was helplessness to raise money for treatment, today every poor has the support of Ayushman Bharat. Earlier there was a fear of triple talaq, now there is the courage to fight for one's rights.

The Prime Minister noted that the welfare schemes, good governance, and welfare of the poor (Seva Sushasan aur Gareeb Kalyan) have changed the meaning of government for the people. Now the government is working for the people. Be it PM housing schemes, scholarships, or pension schemes, with the help of technology, the scope of corruption has been minimized. He said that the Government is trying to give a permanent solution to the problems which were earlier assumed to be permanent. He said Direct Benefit Transfer put an end to the injustice of pilferage and leakage by removing 9 crore fake names from the benefit rolls.

The Prime Minister said when the daily struggle of the poor has reduced when he is empowered, then he gets involved with new energy to remove his poverty. With this thinking, our government started empowering the poor from day one. We tried to reduce every single worry in his life, he added. "I can say with pride that almost every family of the country is benefitting from one or the other scheme", he said.

Noting the contribution of every family of Himachal to the armed forces the Prime Minister said it is this government that implemented One Rank One Pension after waiting for four decades and gave arrears to the ex-servicemen. Every family of Himachal has benefited a lot. Vote bank politics has happened in our country for decades and has done a lot of damage to the country. He said we are working to build a new India, not a vote bank.

The Prime Minister said we have taken the initiative to make 100% benefit reach 100% of the beneficiaries. He said the Government has taken a pledge for reaching the saturation of the beneficiaries. 100% empowerment means ending discrimination, eliminating recommendations, and ending appeasement. 100% empowerment means that every poor gets full benefits from government schemes.

Commenting on the growing stature of the country, the Prime Minister said today, India does not extend a hand of friendship in compulsion but extends a helping hand. Even during the Corona period, we have sent medicines, and vaccines to more than 150 countries, he added.

The Prime Minister stressed the need to work for the bright future of the coming generations, for the bright India of the 21st century. An India whose identity is not deprivation but modernity. No goal is impossible in front of our capability. He added that today India is one of the fastest-growing economies in the world. Record foreign investment is happening in India today, today India is also creating records in exports. "All should come forward and play our part in the journey of progress of our country", he concluded.

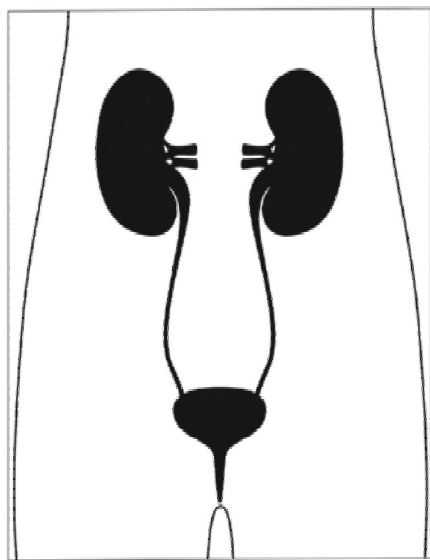
COVID-19 status in A&N Islands

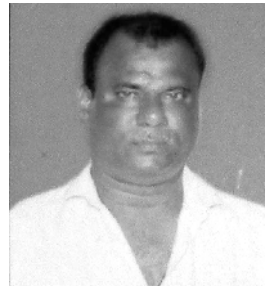
