Criminal action initiated against missing fertilizers at Agriculture Sub-Depot at Ferrargunj

Case registered to unravel conspiracy & nexus between concerned officials of Department & private persons

Port Blair, Jan. 14

In line with campaign and steps taken for no-tolerance to corruption and irregular practices in the Government Departments by the A&N Administration under the guidance of the Chief Secretary, A&N Administration, Agriculture Department has initiated action to curb such activities in the Department.

In this context, a Committee constituted under the Joint Director (Agri.) HQs detected a huge discrepancy on

12.01.2022 between the quantities of DAP(Di-ammonium Phosphate) and MOP (Muriate of Potash) fertilizers listed in the stock register and found in the physical stock at the Department's Sub-depot at Ferrargunj. The missing fertilizers details are as under:-

Apparently, the above discrepancy occurred due to pilferage and misappropriation in connivance and collusion of the concerned officials manning the Sub-Depot as no case of theft has neither been reported to the superior officers of the Department nor the Police.

Considering the seriousness of the issue of pilferage of fertilizers meant for small and marginal farmers by probable diversion and sale in the black market, a case has been lodged by the Department at P.S. Orgrabraj to unravel the conspiracy and nexus between the concerned officials of the Department and private persons involved in the said illegal act and to take action against the culprits.

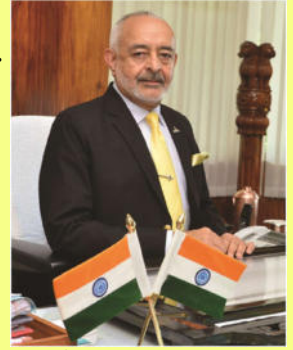
Further, the Department has also initiated disciplinary proceedings against the delinquent officials. The Department has thus taken swift action to send a stern message to Govt. servants involved in such acts of misconduct and financial irregularities, a press release received from Directorate of Agriculture said.

Providing adequate and timely credit support to farmers

Rs.32.06 crores disbursed by Banks under Kisan Credit Card scheme in A&N Islands so far

Port Blair, Jan. 14

Under the Kisan Credit Card scheme, different banks functioning in South Andaman has sanctioned loan to 9044 applicants since April 2020 onwards. The maximum number of beneficiaries were covered by the State Bank of India, A&N State Co-operative Bank and Canara Bank (e-Syndicate) in the financial year 2020-21. The highest number of applications were received in the Agriculture Sector, of which, loans were sanctioned to 8036 applicants amounting to Rs.

27.84 crore.

Similarly, in the Animal Husbandry Sector, loans were sanctioned to 341 applicants amounting to Rs. 1.74 crores while in Fisheries Sector, loan amount of Rs. 3.02 crores were sanctioned to 667 applicants.

The total amount disbursed as loan in KCC scheme stood at Rs.32.06 crores in A&N Islands. Despite the COVID-19 pandemic, the Banks ensured timely disbursement of the loan amount to the applicants, Lead Bank Sources informed here today.

The Kisan Credit Card scheme aims at providing adequate

and timely credit support from the banking system under a single window with flexible and simplified procedure to the farmers for their allied farm activities which includes to meet the short term credit requirements for cultivation of crops; post-harvest expenses; produce marketing loan; consumption requirements of farmer household; working capital for maintenance of farm assets and activities allied to agriculture; investment credit requirement for agriculture and allied activities.

In a special drive conducted on the auspicious occasion of Pongal/ Makar Sankranti, random testing were carried



out in the bazaar areas of Mayabunder, Mohanpur and Billiground, especially targeting the shopkeepers, to check for any instances of transmission or



outbreak of the virus among them. All the samples from Mayabunder were tested negative. Only 3 out of 100 samples collected were tested

RAT positive in other areas and suitable action for their isolation and treatment has been undertaken. Apart from this, tracking and tracing teams have also been activated so that all cases are timely and

efficiently managed in the District. Surveillance teams and Control Rooms are monitoring the situation so that ILI/ SARI cases are detected promptly.

Commerce Minister urges Global Venture Capital Funds to focus on Startups from Tier 2 and 3 cities

New Delhi, Jan. 14 (PIB)

Union Minister of Commerce & Industry, Consumer Affairs, Food & Public Distribution and Textiles, Shri Piyush Goyal has called upon the Global Venture Capital (VC) Funds to focus more on Startups from Tier 2 and 3 cities. Chairing the 4th Roundtable with Global Venture Capital Funds, organised by the Department for Promotion of Industry and Internal Trade (DPIIT), Ministry of Commerce and Industry, Shri Goyal invited the VCs to explore new sectors for investing, promote and protect the intellectual

property created by the young Indian entrepreneurs, provide expertise to scale-up and explore greater capital infusion including risk capital. The Government has already taken a number of steps to support the Startups and would do so in the future also, he added. It was pointed out in the meeting that India is home to over 61,000 recognised Startups spread across 55 industries, with 45% of them emerging from Tier 2 and 3 cities and 45% of Startups having at least one Woman Director, a testimony of diversity, spread and inclusivity of the

Indian Startup ecosystem. It was also highlighted that specifically for Startup ecosystem, 49 regulatory reforms have been undertaken by the Government to enhance Ease Of Doing Business, Ease Of Raising Capital and Reduce Compliance Burden. The Roundtable was held through video conference as part of the Startup India Innovation Week. Over 75 VC fund investors from across the United States, Japan, Korea, Singapore, and some Global Funds domiciled in India participated in the deliberations.

NITI Aayog's Atal Innovation Mission declares results of 'ATL Space Challenge 2021'

New Delhi, Jan. 14

NITI Aayog's Atal Innovation Mission (AIM) has declared the results of the 'ATL Space Challenge 2021', after successful completion and over whelming participation from young innovators. The Challenge was launched in collaboration with Indian Space Research Organisation (ISRO) and Central Board of Secondary Education (CBSE). The event coincides with the birth anniversary of Swami Vivekananda, also celebrated as the National Youth Day. The challenge was designed for all the school students, mentors and teachers across the country

who not only are associated with schools having Atal Tinkering Labs (ATL) but for all the non ATL schools as well. The ATL Space Challenge witnessed over 2500 submissions from both ATL and Non-ATL students across the country from which 75 top innovators were selected and announced yesterday. Speaking during the virtual event for announcing winners, Principal Scientific Adviser to Government of India, Prof. K. DGGI officials bust network involving fake invoices worth more than Rs 4,500 crore; 1 held

New Delhi, Jan. 14 (PIB)

Recently a case was booked by Directorate General of Goods and Services Tax Intelligence (DGGI) against some fake firms, which were found non existing at their principal place of business. To trace the real persons behind these fake firms, the physical address from where GST returns were actually filed was ascertained. Then search was conducted on 06.01.2022 at that premises in Delhi. During search, it was found that proprietor is engaged in providing services of 'Cloud Storage' on his servers to various customers for maintaining their financial accounts.

On scrutiny of one of the suspicious server, details of certain firms were found in tally data. It was informed by the proprietor that this tally data is being maintained by one syndicate based in Kolkata. The address details of these persons were obtained from Proprietor and then searches were conducted at various premises in Kolkata on 10.01.2022.

During search huge amount of incriminating documents including mobiles phones, various cheque books, stamps of various firms and SIM cards have been recovered. On analysis of electronic devices, documents, mobiles and e-mail of these persons, it has been found that these persons are remotely maintaining data on the server found at the premises in Delhi.

Scrutiny of Tally data has shown that there are 636 firms being operated by this syndicate. The mastermind of syndicate has accepted that they have issued only invoices in these firms and not supplied any goods against them. They have issued invoices involving taxable value of approx. Rs. 4,521 crore having ITC implication of approx. 741 crore.

During the course of investigation, GST amounting to Rs. 4.52 crore has been got deposited by reversal of ITC available in the ITC ledger of these firms. Further, till now approx. Rs. 7 crore lying in various bank accounts of these firms has been frozen. The mastermind behind the whole racket has been arrested on 13.01.2022. Further investigation in the case is under progress.

NEET-UG Medical Counselling to begin on Jan. 19

New Delhi, Jan. 14

Union Health Minister, Dr Mansukh Mandaviya has announced that counselling for National Eligibility cum Entrance Test - Under Graduate, NEET -UG by Medical Counselling Committee will start from 19th January, 2022.

Over 2,64,000 new COVID cases reported in India

Over 155 cr. doses of COVID-19 vaccines administered so far

New Delhi, Jan. 14

Government has said that a total of five thousand 753 cases of Omicron variant of COVID-19 have been reported so far in the country. This is an increase of 4.83 per cent since yesterday. Union Health Ministry today said that over 155 crore 39 lakh doses of COVID vaccines have been administered in the country under the n a t i o n w i d e vaccination drive. The Ministry said, more than 73 lakh eight thousand COVID vaccine doses were administered in the last 24 hours to the beneficiaries.

More than one lakh nine thousand COVID patients have recovered during the last 24 hours and the national recovery rate stands at 95.20 per cent. More than three crore 48 lakh patients have recovered from COVID-19 in the country so far. The country reported over two lakh 64 thousand new COVID cases in last 24 hours. Currently, India's active caseload is over 12 lakh 72 thousand. The Ministry said, more than 69 crore 90 lakh COVID-19 tests have been conducted so far. (Source: india.gov.in)

South Africa defeat India in 3rd Test, clinch series 2-1

Cape Town, Jan. 14

South Africa defeated India in the third and final Test of the series at the Newlands in Cape Town today to seal the series 2-1. The hosts chased a 212-run target with seven wickets to spare as Keegan Petersen top-scored with 82 for the side, and was ably supported by Rassie van der Dussen, Captain Dean Elgar and Temba Bavuma. Dean Elgar's men made a remarkable

comeback in the series after losing the first Test in Centurion, beating India by same margin in the second match in Johannesburg as well. India have never won a Test series in South Africa so far. 9. The testing procedure is as follows:-
(a) **Written Test.** The written test will consist of subjects in General English, General Knowledge, Simple Maths and relevant trade questions based on the qualification prescribed for the post applied. Written test will be of multiple choice questions. The maximum marks for the written test will be 80 marks and one hour duration. Candidates must obtain 50% marks to qualify and the candidates who qualify the written test are to be shortlisted for the trade test. In case of SC candidates, the qualifying marks shall be 45%.
(b) **Trade/Skill Test.** The candidates who qualify the written test will be called for trade/skill test. The trade/skill test will be qualifying in nature and shall have no bearing on the overall merit. Selection will be based on marks/merit obtained in written test only.

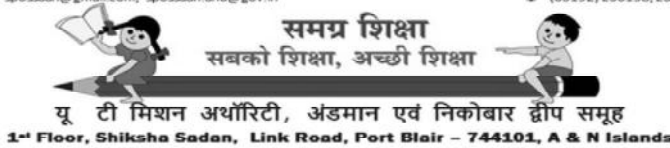

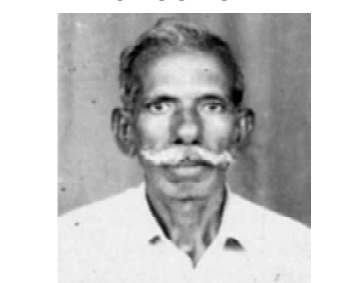
