Mr Biden will host the first-ever in-person Quad Leaders' Summit with Shri Modi, Japanese

Prime Minister, Mr. Yoshihide Suga and Australian Prime Minister, Mr. Scott Morrison.

Prime Minister, Shri Narendra Modi will also address the 76th session of the UN General Assembly in New York on September 25th.

Today, Prime Minister, Shri Narendra Modi held meeting with

SOPs for inter-district & intra-district movement of passengers issued by A & N Administration

Asymptomatic persons administered with both doses of COVID-19 vaccine 2 weeks ago and in possession of final Vaccination Certificate exempted from undergoing RAT for travelling to Islands in South Andaman/ North and Middle Andaman District
Symptomatic persons have to undergo RAT test for undertaking journey to these Islands
RT-PCR test for persons undertaking journey to Nicobar District/ tribal areas shall continue

Port Blair, Sept. 23

In pursuance of the Guidelines issued by the Ministry of Health and Family Welfare, Govt. of India dated 25.08.2021 for domestic travel by flight/train/ship/ bus inter-state travel, and with the approval of Competent Authority, Andaman and Nicobar Administration shall implement the following SOPs for inter-district and intra-district movement with effect from 25/09/2021.

As per the SOP, asymptomatic persons who have taken both doses of the COVID-19 vaccine administered 2

weeks ago and are in possession of the final Vaccination Certificate issued through the COWIN portal are exempted from undergoing Rapid Antigen Test for travelling to Islands in South Andaman/ North and Middle Andaman District. Such passengers shall also have to produce the ID card/document mentioned in the Vaccination Certificate for cross-verification. However, symptomatic persons have to undergo RAT test for undertaking journey to these Islands.

All other persons viz.

unvaccinated, partially vaccinated (those who have taken only 1st dose of COVID vaccine) and those who have taken both doses, but have not completed 15 days since the administration of 2nd dose, shall have to undergo Rapid Antigen Test, before moving in the convoy on ATR from Port Blair side.

Further, RTPCR test for persons undertaking journey to Islands in Nicobar District/ tribal areas shall continue till further orders.

Country still in midst of second wave of COVID-19 even though cases are declining: Govt.

A&N Islands among six States & UTs to have covered 100% of first doses of vaccine to their population

New Delhi, Sept. 23

The Union Government today said that the country is still in midst of second wave of COVID-19 even though the number of cases are declining. Briefing media in New Delhi this evening, Union Health Secretary, Shri Rajesh Bhushan said, in last 24 hours, over 31 thousand cases were reported and most of these cases were reported from Kerala and Maharashtra.

He said, however, absolute numbers have gone down. Shri Bhushan said, Kerala is the only state with over one lakh active COVID

cases and 62.73 per cent of total infections reported last week were from the State. He said, 33 districts are reporting over 10 per cent weekly COVID-19 positivity and 23 are recording between five to ten per cent.

The Secretary said, six States and Union Territories have covered 100 per cent of the first doses to their population. These are Lakshadweep, Chandigarh, Goa, Himachal Pradesh, Andaman and Nicobar Islands and Sikkim. He assured that the doses of

A&N Administration issues SOPs for passengers arriving from mainland to A&N Islands

- All asymptomatic passengers vaccinated with both doses of COVID-19 exempted from mandatory requirement of carrying a negative RT-PCR report to travel to Port Blair from Mainland. Such passengers will be exempted from undergoing additional RT-PCR test on arrival at Port Blair airport
- Unvaccinated, partially vaccinated and those taken both doses but have not completed 15 days since the administration of 2nd dose have to produce negative RT-PCR report

Port Blair, Sept. 23

In pursuance of Ministry of Civil Aviation's Letter dated 16/07/2021 read with Guidelines issued by the Ministry of Health and Family Welfare, Govt. of India dated 25.08.2021 for domestic travel by flight/train/ship etc., and with the approval of Competent Authority, the Andaman and Nicobar Administration, in supersession of its earlier order dated 23.12.2020, shall implement the following SOPs with effect from 25/09/2021.

All asymptomatic passengers who have been vaccinated with both doses of the COVID-19 vaccine and 15 days have lapsed since the administration of

second dose of the vaccine and are in possession of the final vaccination certificate issued through the COWIN portal are exempted from mandatory requirement of carrying a negative RT-PCR report to travel to Port Blair from Mainland and also such passengers will be exempted from undergoing additional RT-PCR test on arrival at Port Blair airport. Such passengers shall also have to produce the ID card/document mentioned in the Vaccination Certificate, for verification.

Passengers who are found symptomatic on arrival at Port Blair, irrespective of their vaccination status shall be subjected to RT-PCR /Rapid Antigen Test at the airport terminal to aid identification.

All other passengers viz. unvaccinated, partially vaccinated (those who have taken only 1st dose of COVID vaccine) and those who have taken both doses, but have not completed 15 days since the administration of 2nd dose, shall have to produce negative RT-PCR report to travel to Port Blair from mainland, as is the practice now. They will also undergo additional RT-PCR test on arrival at Port Blair.

Despite above exemption, it is mandated that all passengers, irrespective of status of vaccination, shall scrupulously follow COVID Appropriate Behaviour (wearing mask, maintaining social distancing etc.) at all times, an order to this effect issued by Commissioner-cum-Secretary (CA/Health) said.

presence of Dr. V. Candavelou, Commissioner-cum-Secretary (Health), A&N Administration and Senior Officers of Directorate of Health Services.

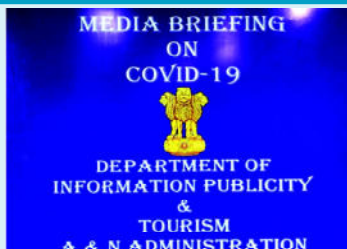

Port Blair, Sept. 23

The Secretary (IP&T), Shri Sunil Kumar Singh briefing media persons on COVID-19 in the conference hall of IP&T here this evening disclosed that during the RT-PCR test conducted on 1263 passengers who arrived here yesterday, one positive case has been detected. Today, 7 flights with 1003 passengers arrived and the RT-PCR test



found negative. Apart from this, 306 passengers travelling to & fro to Shaheed/ Swaraj Dweep were tested at Phoenix Bay Jetty and all were found negative. At Mohanpura Bus Terminus, test was conducted on 205 passengers and all were found negative. Similarly, at helipad, 9 passengers were tested and all were found negative.

Vaccination drive in A&N Islands 4,32,006 doses of vaccines administered to beneficiaries so far




Port Blair, Sept. 23

The vaccination drive is continuing smoothly in A&N Islands. As per data available, 4,32,006 doses of vaccines have been administered to beneficiaries in Isles so far. Meanwhile, a total of 2176 people were vaccinated today in A&N Islands. 1461 beneficiaries were vaccinated in South Andaman District, out of which, 231 beneficiaries were in the age group of 18-44 years. Similarly, 466 beneficiaries were vaccinated in North & Middle Andaman



District, out of which, 22 beneficiaries were in the age group of 18-44. 249 beneficiaries were vaccinated in Nicobar District, out of which, 4 beneficiaries were in the age group of 18-44.

A total of 1,69,037 eligible people in the age group of 18 to 44 years have been vaccinated till date, a press release from DHS said.

There is an increasing global demand for traditional and rare fruits, which increases the gastronomic diversity as they provide new flavors, aromas, colors, and attractive appearance for consumers. One such fruit of wide acceptance by the consumers is the Pitaya or dragon fruit (*Hylocereus* sp). It is naturally distributed in dry tropical climates, which produces a rare, attractive, and exquisite fruit. The most valuable and commonly used edible part of dragon fruit is the fruit pulp which is eaten raw as a fresh fruit. Dragon fruit is reported to possess medicinal properties and is considered as a health fruit. The fruits are hypoglycemic, diuretic, wound disinfectant, tumor dissolution and dysentery care. The red fleshed variety of dragon fruit is rich in antioxidants. It prevents colon cancer and diabetes. Neutralizes toxic substances like heavy metals, reduce cholesterol and high blood pressure. It controls high sugar level. The fruits are rich in Vitamin C, phosphorus and calcium which helps to develop strong bones, teeth and skin. The oligosaccharides from the fruits have pre biotic characteristics, resistance to acid conditions in the stomach and partial resistance to human amylase and they also promote lactobacillus. Pitaya seed oil is a potential source of natural antioxidants and contains phenolics. The pitaya seeds are rich in essential fatty acids with an exceptional level of linoleic acid. Dragon fruits are consumed as fresh fruits or could be chilled, either sliced or scooped with a spoon. It is widely used in fruit salads in restaurants. There are a number of processed products that could be prepared from dragon fruit like juices, wine, sherbets, jam, syrup, ice cream, yogurt, jelly, preserve, candy and pastries. The red and pink pulp of dragon fruit can be used as a food colouring agent and as a raw material for colouring industry.

Benefit: Dragon fruit could be an asset to small holders and entrepreneurs of medium and large-scale plantations. It is a fast return perennial fruit crop and is an ideal crop of future in Bay Islands.
