

Winter session of Parliament begins; Both Houses of Parliament passes Farm Laws Repeal Bill, 2021

New Delhi, Nov. 29

The Parliament has passed the Farm Laws Repeal Bill, 2021, with the Lok Sabha and the Rajya Sabha approving it today. On the first day of the Winter Session, the bill seeking to withdraw the three farm laws was moved in Lok Sabha by Agriculture Minister, Shri Narendra Singh Tomar. The Bill was passed



without discussion as Speaker, Shri Om Birla said, a debate is not possible in a noisy scene.

Later, the Bill was also introduced in the Upper House by Minister, Shri Narendra Singh Tomar in the post-lunch session and was passed. (Source: india.gov.in)

The Department of Civil Supplies & Consumer Affairs has been repeatedly informing and requesting the ration card holders through media and Fair Price

Shop dealers from time to time to get their Aadhaar number seeded with the ration card data base. Many ration card beneficiaries have still not got their Aadhaar number seeded with the ration cards.

Hence, it is once again requested to all the NFSA (PHH & AAY) card holders to get their and their family member's Aadhaar seeded in the ration card database

through their respective Circle Office of Civil Supplies & Consumer Affairs Department and its subordinate Supply Units in Inter-Islands by 31st December, 2021.

All the beneficiaries are made aware that with implementation of 'One Nation One Ration Card' in this UT, no ration card holder will be able to draw their PDS items without Aadhaar

5,51,167 doses of vaccines administered to beneficiaries in Isles so far

The safety of the citizens is the foremost priority of the Administration, especially during this pandemic time. To shield its citizens from the corona virus, the vaccination of eligible beneficiaries is being initiated by the Administration in different parts of the Islands. As per data available, a total of

5,51,167 doses of vaccines have been administered to beneficiaries so far in A&N Islands, out of the target beneficiaries of 2, 81, 603 (approx.). A total of 2046 people were vaccinated today. 1683 beneficiaries were vaccinated in South Andaman District, out of which, 100 beneficiaries were in the age group of 18-44 years. Similarly,

Clarification on revised guidelines issued by MoRTH for merger of three wheeler & LMV driving license

3 wheeler class of Driving Licence while renewal will be mentioned as LMV

Port Blair, Nov. 29

The Transport Department has been receiving requests from the Autorickshaw Union/ Drivers on automatic conversion of three wheeler driving license to LMV class of driving license at the time of renewal or any other transaction. They have requested the

Administration for issuing a clarification on the matter so that the autorickshaw drivers do not face difficulty during traffic enforcement activities.

Consequent to this, the general public have been informed that as per the earlier provisions in the M V Act 1988 and CMVR 1989, for driving three

wheeler and four wheeler classes of vehicles, the drivers must possess separate authorization in the driving license to drive these classes of vehicles.

The Ministry of Road Transport & Highways vide Notification dated 28th May, 2021 had issued an order to specify types of Motor Vehicles on the

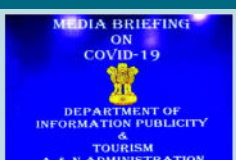

Formation of low pressure area over South Andaman Sea

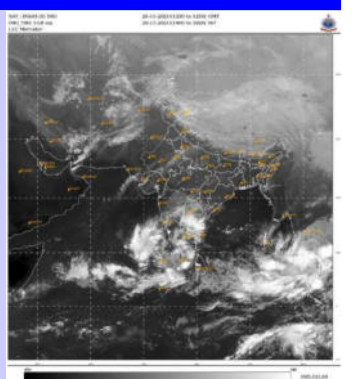
Heavy rain likely to occur in Isles; Fishermen advised not to venture into sea till Dec. 2

Port Blair, Nov. 29

Heavy to very heavy rain (07-20 cm) with thunderstorm, lightning & gusty wind (speed 40-50 kmph) is likely to occur at one or two places over A&N Islands tomorrow (Nov. 30). Similarly, on Dec. 1, heavy to very heavy rain (07-20 cm) with thundersquall (wind speed 50-60 kmph) is likely to occur at one or two places over A&N Islands. On Dec. 2, heavy rain (07-11 cm) with thunderstorm & gusty wind (speed 40-50 kmph) is likely to occur at one or two places over A&N Islands.




Meanwhile, in anticipation of formation of a low pressure area over South Andaman Sea around 30th November, 2021, wind speed is likely to exceed 45 kmph over Andaman Sea & neighbourhood. Fishermen have been advised not to venture into the sea till Dec. 2.

Farmers' Corner- A Knowledge Hub

Mud crab fattening

Holding and rearing large newly molted (known as water crab) mud crabs to 10 to 45 days until they become hard is termed as fattening. Soft shelled crab of size above 80mm carapace width and weight above 550 grams are used for the fattening technique. Mud crab fattening an emerging industry in Andaman and Nicobar Islands and attracts youth since it is a short term high profitable venture. The pond-based fattening and floating box culture based fattening were practiced in the Islands. The open pond based culture practices are highly influenced by adverse weather conditions. Further, the farmers without fish ponds were also facing issues in taking up the technology. In order to sustainably utilize the available land and to have a controlled environment for fattening purposes, ICAR- CIARI, Marine research laboratory developed an indoor vertical circulatory crab fattening unit with a capacity of 100 crabs. In this technique the water of salinity 15 to 22ppt passes through the each crab boxes arranged in vertical racks through gravity and drain water from the system collected and purified with the help of sand filter and pump in to the overhead tank. The crabs are fed with 5-10% of the body weight with shrimp/ clam meat or trash fishes and fattening period generally ranges from 25 to 50 days.

Benefit:

- > Reuse of water:- Once the overhead tank is filled with a water of salinity 15 to 22 ppt, it will recirculate within the system
- > Easy assessment of crabs
- > Short term high profitable venture

Govt. takes several supply-side measures to curb the inflationary pressures: FM

New Delhi, Nov. 29 Finance Minister ,Smti Nirmala Sitharaman informed the Lok Sabha that the Government has taken several supply-side measures to curb the inflationary pressures. Replying to a starred question, she said that the Centre has reduced Central Excise Duty on Petrol and Diesel by five and ten rupees respectively to which many State Governments have responded by reducing the value-added tax to further sober Petrol and Diesel prices. She also said, India has also agreed to release five million barrels of crude oil from its strategic petroleum reserves, in parallel and in consultation with other major global energy consumers. Similarly, Finance Minister listed several measures including a Five-Year Memorandum of Understanding with Myanmar, Malawi and Mozambique for annual import of 2.5 Lakh Metric Tonnes of Urad and 3.5 lakh Metric Tonnes of Tur. She also informed that a National Mission on Edible Oils - Oil Palm has also been approved to encourage domestic production and availability of Palm oil. (Source: india.gov.in)

basis of driving license issued. As per the said order, the vehicles under the category L5-M (Three Wheeler-Passenger), L5-N (Three Wheeler - Goods) comes under Light Motor Vehicle (LMV) category of vehicles.

Transport Department under A & N Administration had migrated from SARATHI 2.0 software to SARATHI 4.0 version for issue/renewal of driving licenses. The provisions of Notification dated 28.05.2021 has been incorporated in the said software.

Now, as per the above referred notification, existing 3 Wheeler class of Driving Licence while renewal will be mentioned as LMV and all Driving Licence holders possessing LMV class of driving license would be eligible for driving all categories of Three Wheelers and LMV Classes of vehicles, a press release from Directorate of Transport said.

Schools of the UT and whose parental income does not exceed Rs.1.5 Lakh per annum from all sources are eligible to appear in NMMSS Examination.

The students of Kendriya Vidyalayas, Jawahar Navodaya Vidyalayas and Residential Schools run by State Government and Private unaided Schools are not eligible for scholarship under the National Means-cum-Merit Scholarship Scheme (NMMSS).

For both the examinations students have to produce mark statements of the qualifying examinations (i.e. mark statement of class -IX for NTSE & mark statement of class -VII for NMMSS examination). To appear in the NMMSS Examination students should produce parental income certificates issued from Revenue Authority not below the rank of Tehsildar concerned with their application forms. Category Certificate are also to be produced by the candidates who come under reserved categories.

Application forms can be obtained from the Office of the Principal, State Institute of Education, Port Blair/All Zonal Education Officers of Education Department. Application forms can also be downloaded from the website of Education Department <https://education.andaman.gov.in/tops/login.aspx>.

Application forms duly filled in all respect along-with supportive documents should be submitted in the Office of the Principal, SIE/ Nodal Officer, NTSE & NMMSS on or before 11th December, 2021. Application submitted after the due date will not be entertained. which is located in PDO and it may be a retailer shop, kirana or even tea stalls. The PDOs are primarily aimed at removing the digital divide for internet access for rural population.

The following recharge plans are offered for the users of these Public Wifi, wherein 1 GB data will be available at Rs. 9 on 1 day validity. 3 GB data for 3 days will be available at Rs. 19. Similarly, 7 GB data for 7 days at Rs 39, 15 GB data for 15 days at Rs. 59 and 30 GB data for 30 days at Rs 69. In addition to the above, BSNL A&N has started providing high-speed Broadband on radio under the brand Bharat Air Fibre, which will help to provide faster and reliable Internet services in the rural areas. Bharat Air Fibre has speed at par with high-speed fibre FTTH and all FTTH plans are applicable for Air Fiber. This being completely wireless technology is easy to deploy, more reliable, needs less maintenance and will provide connectivity in non-feasible areas and villages which can't be connected through FTTH. Bharat Air Fibre works on the unlicensed spectrum through radio equipment installed on existing BSNL towers. Presently, the services are available in few locations at North & Middle Andaman (Shibpur, Milangram, Radhanagar, Kishorinagar, Shyamnagar, Ramnagar, Kalighat, Madhupur, Kalara, Laxmipur, Ariel Bay, Billiground, Swadeshnagar and Mohanpur and in South Andaman area (Tushnabad, Mannarghat & Chidiyatapu). Rachin Ravindra did a brilliant job holding fort for his side on debut. The umpires and players have agreed that the light isn't good enough to carry on and thus both teams have settled for a draw. Earlier, partnership between Shreyas Iyer and Wriddhiman Saha helped India to take hold of the match yesterday at Green Park Stadium. India declared their second innings at 234 for 7 towards the end of the day's play, setting the target of 284 for visitors. Wriddhiman Saha at 61 and Axar Patel at 28 remained unbeaten. It was a brilliant Test match on a really testing pitch for batters and bowlers.
