income generation for the island fishers and achieving the objective of promoting seaweed farming as announced by the Hon'ble Prime Minister of India.

In his inaugural address, Dr. S. Kannan, Director CSIR-CSMCRI expressed his appreciation on the initiative of A & N Administration in taking forward seaweed farming in A & N Islands and expressed his satisfaction on the progress made by CSMCRI in the implementation of the Pilot-cumdemonstration project for promoting seaweed farming in the Islands under 'Pradhan Mantri Matsya Sampada Yojana'.

Dr. M Ganeshan, Principal Scientist, CSMCRI made a detailed presentation on the progress of pilot project in the islands and informed that 29 rafts have been installed at Hathitapu and Dandus Point area for seed bank facility with three species of seaweeds. The project would be implemented for a period of two years to identify suitable site, species and establishment of seed bank facilities besides imparting training to the local fishers. It also envisages Environmental Impact Studies of sea weed cultivation in the Islands.

Sharing their views and suggestion, representatives of seaweed enterprises underlined the need for establishment of seed bank facility to ensure continuous availability of seeds before opening commercial cultivation in the islands. They also requested to focus on commercially viable species, training for the interested fishers and identification of suitable locations for the project. Representatives from CMFRI and NIOT also highlighted the activities undertaken by them in the field of seaweed farming.

Earlier, Dr. Utpal K. Sar, Director of Fisheries, A & N Administration welcomed the gathering, a press release from Directorate of Fisheries said.

As per health data, the new active case in the last 24 hours is 3 while the total number of active cases during the 2nd wave (since 01.03.2021) is 5 in the entire Islands. Out of the total, 7553 confirmed cases of COVID since March 2020, 7419 patients have been cured/discharged so far.

Meanwhile, the vaccination drive is also progressing smoothly. So far, the cumulative beneficiaries vaccinated with 1st dose stands at 231047 while 99878 have been vaccinated with 2nd dose.
