Union Health Ministry issues revised guidelines for home isolation of mild and asymptomatic COVID-19 cases

New Delhi, Jan. 6

The Union Health Ministry has issued revised guidelines for home isolation of mild and asymptomatic COVID-19 cases. As per the guidelines, the COVID patients must isolate themselves from other household members, stay in the identified room and away from other people in home, especially elderly and those with co-morbid conditions. Self-monitoring of blood oxygen saturation with a pulse oximeter for the patient is advised. The patient and care giver must seek immediate medical attention if serious signs or symptoms develop. These could include unresolved high-grade fever of more than 100° F for more than three days, difficulty in breathing, dip in oxygen saturation, persistent pain in the chest and severe fatigue and myalgia. The caregiver should wear a triple layer medical mask and the hand hygiene must be ensured following contact with ill

person or his immediate environment. The guidelines says that the patients must be in communication with a treating Medical Officer and promptly report in case of any deterioration during home isolation. They will follow symptomatic management for fever, running nose and cough.

The Ministry said, for home isolation, the patients should be clinically assigned as mild or asymptomatic case by the treating Medical Officer and they should have the requisite facility at their residence for self-isolation. The elderly patients aged more than 60 years and those with co-morbid conditions including Hypertension, Diabetes, Heart disease, Chronic lung and Kidney disease and Cerebrovascular disease will only be allowed home isolation after proper evaluation by the treating medical officers. Patients suffering from immune compromised status including HIV,

transplant recipients, cancer therapy are not recommended for home isolation. The guidelines further says that the patients under home isolation will stand discharged and end isolation after at least seven days have passed from testing positive and no fever for three successive days. There is no need for retesting after the home isolation period is over.

The Health Ministry added that District and sub-District Control Rooms will be made operational and their telephone numbers should be well publicized in public so that people under home-isolation may contact the Control Rooms for seamless transfer of patients through ambulance from home to the dedicated hospital. These Control Rooms will also make outbound calls to the patients under home isolation to monitor their status. The District Administration will also monitor all cases under home isolation on a daily basis. (Source: india.gov.in)

Team India play their first World Cup fixture against Pakistan on March 6th, 2022 at the Bay Oval, Tauranga. After the game against Pakistan, India will square off against New Zealand (March 10), West Indies (March 12), England (March 16), Australia (March 19), Bangladesh (March 22), and South Africa (March 27) in the group stage. The squad will also feature in the 5-match ODI series against New Zealand starting

Poonam Yadav. Standby Players are Sabbhineni Meghana, Ekta Bisht and Simran Dil Bahadur.

India Women's squad for one-off T20I against New Zealand are Harmanpreet Kaur (Captain), Smriti Mandhana (Vice-Captain), Shafali Verma, Yastika Bhatia, Deepti Sharma, Richa Ghosh (wicket-keeper), Sneha Rana, Pooja Vastrakar, Meghna Singh, Renuka Singh Thakur, Taniya Bhatia (wicket-keeper), Rajeshwari Gayakwad, Poonam Yadav, Ekta Bisht, S. Meghna, Simran Dil Bahadur. The match is scheduled to be played on 9th February, 2022.

India vs South Africa 2nd Test: Elgar leads SA to victory, series level at 1-1

Johannesburg, Jan. 6

South Africa defeated India by seven wickets in the second Test to level the three-match series 1-1 on Thursday. After two sessions were lost to incessant rain, South Africa, chasing 240, came out needing 122 runs for a memorable win with eight wickets in hand. Skipper Dean Elgar led from the front with an unbeaten 96 off 188 balls to take his team home in 67.4 overs. The other crucial contributions came from Aiden Markram (31), Rassie van der Dussen



(40), Keegan Peterson (28) and Temba Bavuma (23 not out off 45). India's bowlers could not extract enough from the surface with Mohammad Shami getting the only wicket to fall on the day. The third and

final Test begins in Cape Town from January 11. Brief Scores: India- 202 and 266. South Africa- 202 and 243/3 in 67.4 overs. (Dean Elgar 96 not out Rassie van der Dussen 40; Mohammad Shami 1/55).

Madam,

Under the instructions of my client named above, in addition to replying the legal notice sent by you to my client, I am to write to you as follows:

1. Contents of para 1 of your notice dated 30.03.2021 is not disputed.
2. Contents of para 2 of your notice is not accepted as you never expressed to my client about your alleged financial need. It is a fact that you offered to sell the land in question to my client for a sale consideration of Rs. 28 lakhs and my client accepted the same. It is further stated to you that on 12.04.2018 a sale agreement was entered between you and my client whereby you agreed to sell land bearing Survey No. 354/5 measuring 0.5460 hecta, classified as paddy land situated at Namunaghar village, under Ferrargunj Tehsil, South Andaman for a total sale consideration of Rs. 28,00,000/-. My client paid an advance of Rs. 2,00,000/- to you vide cheque dated 19.04.2018. On your subsequent demands, my client paid altogether Rs. 11 lakhs to you including the advance amount. Rs. 2 lakhs was paid on 19.04.2018, Rs. 2 lakhs on 10.09.2018, Rs. 1 lakh on 24.01.2019, Rs. 1 lakh on 24.01.2019, Rs. 2,50,000/- on 08.03.2019 and Rs. 2,50,000/- on 29.03.2019. Though it was mentioned in the agreement that balance consideration amount of Rs. 26,00,000/- shall be paid at the time of registration of sale deed, on your demand my client paid Rs. 9 lakhs more vide different cheques of different dates in addition to Rs. 2 lakhs. Subsequently you handed over documents required for registration of sale deed to my client, sale deed was duly prepared and submitted to the Sub-Registrar Office for Registration. However due to the policy of the Andaman & Nicobar Administration the same could not be registered. You are aware of the fact that the Andaman & Nicobar Administration refused to register any sale deed submitted in the beginning of the said year on the ground that the Andaman & Nicobar Administration is processing to frame the circle rates and enhance the stamp duty and registration of stamp duty. For this reason the said sale deed, which was submitted by my client by spending money for the stamp duty, could not be registered. There was no fault on part of my client. It was a circumstances beyond the reach of my client and therefore my client cannot be held responsible for the delay so occurred. 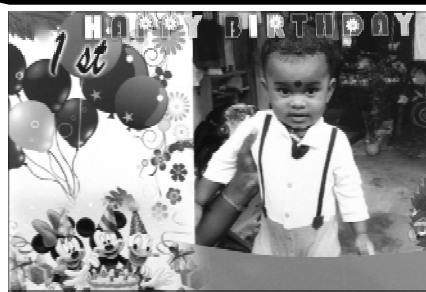

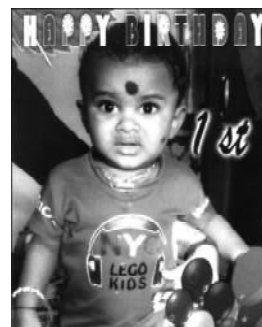
