Sub: Advertisement for Engagement of Resource Persons, JNRM, Port Blair - Reg.

Jawaharlal Nehru Rajkeeya Mahavidyalaya (JNRM), Port Blair (NAAC accreditation with "A" Grade) proposes to prepare a panel of 101 Resource persons to utilize their services as Guest Faculty in the following subjects to teach UG/PG courses as and when required basis for the Academic session 2022-2023. They are as follows:

BBA (Tourism), Bengali, Botany, Chemistry, Commerce, Computer Applications, English, Environment studies, Economics, Geography, Hindi, History, Home science, Mathematics, Physical education, Physics, Political Science, Public Administration, Tamil, Telugu and Zoology.

The Resource person shall be paid honorarium of Rs. 1000/- (Rupees Cne thousand only) per lecture subject to a maximum of Rs. 25,000/- (Rupees Twenty Five thousand only) or as per the instruction received from the Competent Authority as the case may be.

Educational and other qualifications required for appointment of Resource Person:

A Masters degree with 55% marks (or an equivalent grade in a point- scale wherever the grading system is followed) in a concerned/relevant/allied subject from an Indian University.

Must have cleared the National Eligibility Test (NET) conducted by the UGC or the CSIR, or a similar test accredited by the UGC, like SLET/SET or who are or have been awarded a Ph. D. Degree in accordance with the University Grants Commission (Minimum Standards and Procedure for Award of M.Phil./Ph.D. Degree) Regulations, 2009 or 2016 and their amendments from time to time as the case may be exempted from NET/SLET/SET

Provided, the candidates registered for the Ph.D. programme prior to July 11, 2009, shall be governed by the provisions of the then existing Ordinances/Bye-laws/Regulations of the Institution awarding the degree and such Ph.D. candidates shall be exempted from the requirement of NET/SLET/SET for recruitment and appointment of Assistant Frof Sear or equivalent positions in Universities/Colleges/Institutions subject to the fulfillment of the following conditions:-

a) The Ph.D. degree of the candidate has been awarded in a regular mode;

b) The Ph.D. thesis has been evaluated by at least two external examiners;

c) An open Ph.D. viva voce of the candidate has been conducted;

d) The Candidate has presented two research papers from nis/her Ph.D. work, out of which at

e) The candidate has presented at least two papers based on his/her Ph.D work in conferences/seminars sponsored/funded/supported by the LGC / ICSSR/ CSIR or any

The fulfillment of these conditions (a) to (e) is to be certified by the Registrar or the Dean (Academic Affairs) of the University concerned.

OR

B. The Ph.D degree from a foreign university/institution.

RELAXATION CLAUSE:

1. NET/SLET/SET shall also not be required for such Masters Programmes in disciplines for which NET/SLET/SET is not conducted by the UGC CSIR or significant test accredited by the UGC, like SLET/SET.

- 2. A relaxation of 5% marks may be provided at Graduate and Master's level for the Scheduled Caste/ Scheduled Tribe/Differently-abled (Physically and visually differently-abled)/Other Backward Class (OBC) (Non-creamy layer) categories for the purpose of eligibility and for assessing good academic record during direct recruitment to teaching positions. The eligibility marks of 55% marks (or an equivalent grade in a point scale wherever grading system is followed) and the relaxation of 5% marks to the categories mentioned above are permissible, based on only the qualifying marks without including any grace mark procedures.
- 3. A relaxation of 5% may be provided, from 55% to 50% of the marks to the Ph.D. Degree holders, who have obtained their Master's Degree prior to 19 September, 1991.
- 4. Relevant grade which is regarded as equivalent of 55% marks wherever the grading system is followed by a recognized university shall also be considered eligible.

GENERAL INFORMATION:

- 1. Candidates with Ph. D. Degree awarded in accordance with the University Grants Commission (Minimum Standards and Procedure for Award of Ph.D. Degree) Regulations, 2009 or 2016 are required to submit a certificate from the concerned University to the effect that their Ph.D degree is compliant of 'UGC (Minimum standards and procedure for awards of M.Phil/Ph.D degree) Regulation 2009'.
- 2. Candidates registered for the Ph.D programme prior to July 11, 2009, shall submit a certificate in accordance with the University Grants Commission on minimum qualifications for appointment of teachers and other academic staff in universities and colleges and measures for the maintenance of standards in higher education.
- 3. The prescribed qualifications and experience are minimum and the mere fact that a candidate possesses the same will not entitle him/her for being selected. The Academic score as specified in Appendix II (Table 3B) of UGC Regulation 2018 shall be considered for preparation of merit list and the selection shall be based only on the Academic Scoring and no interview.
- 4. It is the responsibility of the candidate to assess his own eligibility for the post for which he/she is applying in accordance with the prescribed qualification, experience, etc. Suppression of factual information, supply of fake document, providing false or misleading information or any other undesirable action by the candidate shall lead to cancellation of his/her candidature.
- The panel of selected candidates will be valid for one academic year from the date of approval of competent authority.
- 6. Incomplete Applications will not be consider at all.

7. The JNRM, Port Blair reserves the right:

- i. To withdraw the advertisement either partly or wholly at any time without assigning any reason to this effect.
- ii. To fill or not to fill up some or all the posts advertised for any reasons whatsoever.
- iii. To draw up reserve panel/ waiting list(s), which will be valid for one year from the date of approval of the competent authority and may be used for engagement on as and when required basis.
- iv. To consider applications received after last date.
- v. To decide criteria/procedure for short listing of the candidas's.
