The A&N Islands has achieved 100% COVID vaccine coverage target with the administering of both doses of COVID vaccine to eligible beneficiaries in the age group of 18 and above. With this, A&N Islands has become the first State/UT to achieve the milestone using only Covishield. In a series of tweet in the official twitter handle of the A&N Administration under #COVIDVaccine #TheAndamanStory, it stated that "A&N achieved 100% COVID vaccine coverage making it 1st State/ UT to achieve the feat using only Covishield. UT Administration o v e r c a m e



insurmountable odds for this extraordinary feat in one of the remotest part of world." "Vaccination in Andaman & Nicobar Islands kick started along with National Vaccination by Hon'ble Prime Minister on

16.01.2021. Health Care Staff and Frontline Workers were first to receive the vaccine. Vaccination in A&N Islands was extremely challenging as the UT is spread over 836 Islands spread over 800 km from North to South

## Atal Pension Yojana: A boon for unorganized sector

**Subscribers entitled for fixed minimum pension; 4364 persons enrolled under the scheme in A&N Islands so far**

Port Blair, Dec. 19

The Atal Pension Yojana (APY) is a pension scheme for the workers in the unorganized sector. As per the scheme, people can make contributions in their Atal Pension Yojana account till the age of 60 years and get a monthly pension. The APY focuses on all citizens in the unorganized sector, who join the National Pension System (NPS) administered by the Pension Fund Regulatory and Development Authority (PFRDA). As per the data provided by Lead Bank, Port Blair, altogether, 4364 persons have been enrolled under the universal social security scheme 'Atal Pension Yojana' in A&N Islands so far.

Under APY, the subscribers would receive fixed minimum pension of Rs. 1000 per month, Rs. 2000 per

month, Rs. 3000 per month, Rs. 4000 per month, Rs. 5000 per month, at the age of 60 years, depending on their contributions, which itself would be based on the age of joining the APY. The minimum age of joining APY is 18 years and maximum age is 40 years. The age of exit and start of pension would be 60 years. Therefore, minimum period of contribution by any subscriber under APY would be 20 years or

more. The benefit of fixed minimum pension would be guaranteed by the Government.

APY is open to all bank account holders with auto debit facility to accounts, leading to reduction in contribution collection charges. The subscribers should keep the required balance in their savings bank accounts on the stipulated due dates to avoid any late payment

# Installation of Effluent treatment Plant & Sewage Treatment Plant for industrial units mandatory as per Hon'ble Supreme Court direction

## Opportunity of hearing to be given to all stakeholders on Dec. 22

Port Blair, Dec. 19

The Hon'ble Supreme Court of India, New Delhi in its Order dated 22.02.2017 in W.P(C) No. 375 of 2012 in Paryavaran Suraksha Samiti & Anr vs Union of India & Ors has directed that "all industrial units, which require "consent to operate", by way of a common advertisement, requiring them to make their primary effluent treatment plants fully operational, within three months from today. On the expiry of the notice period of

three months, the concerned State Pollution Control Board(s) are mandated to carry out inspections, to verify, whether or not, each industrial unit requiring "consent to operate", has a functional primary effluent treatment plant. Such of the industrial units, which have not been able to make their primary effluent treatment plant fully operational, within the notice period, shall be restrained from any further industrial activity."

The Hon'ble Court has further directed that "this direction may be implemented by requiring the concerned electricity supply and distribution agency, to disconnect the electricity connection of the defaulting industry. We therefore hereby further direct, that in case the concerned State Pollution Control Boards make a recommendation to the concerned electrical supply and distribution agency/company, to disconnect electricity supply to an industry,

for the reason that its primary effluent treatment plant is not functional, it shall honour such recommendation, and shall disconnect the electricity supply to such defaulting industrial concern, forthwith. Such an industrial concern, which has been disabled from carrying on its industrial activities, as has been indicated in the foregoing paragraph, is granted liberty to make its primary effluent treatment plant

functional to the required capacity, and thereupon, seek a fresh "consent to operate" from the concerned Pollution Control Board. Only after the receipt of such fresh "consent to operate", the industrial activities of the disabled industry, can be permitted to be resumed. In carrying out the above exercise, we consider it just and appropriate to require, the Pollution Control Boards to carry out inspections, by

prioritizing inspections of severely and critically polluted industries, so that visible results emerge at the earliest."

Now therefore, in pursuance of order issued by the Hon'ble NGT Eastern Zone order dated 07-12-2021 in Appeal No 06/2017/EZ with appeal No. 09/2017/EZ in the matter of Andaman Chamber of Commerce and Industry & Ors Vs the Andaman and Nicobar Administration and Ors with Hotel Sentinel & Ors Vs the Andaman and Nicobar Administration and Ors, all the Hotels, Automobile Service Centers and other industrial units who have not installed STP/ETP (New/Old) or do not have Consent to Operate(CTO) may come and give explanation in person for non-compliance of Hon'ble Supreme Court order dated 22.02.2017 in W.P. (C) 375/2012. No excuse or alibi shall be entertained unless they comply with the direction of the Hon'ble Supreme Court.

The industrial units requiring "Consent to Operate" and all others requiring to setup Effluent Treatment Plant and Sewage Treatment Plant in Andaman and Nicobar Islands are therefore called upon to take all measures necessary to ensure that the Effluent treatment Plants(ETP) and Sewage Treatment Plant(STP) installed in their premises are made fully operational and the effluents/sewage discharged from them meet the standards prescribed in the Environment (Protection) Act 1986 in faithful compliance of the direction issued by Hon'ble Supreme Court. In the event of the failure on the part of the industrial units and others to make their primary Effluent Treatment Plants (ETP) and Sewage Treatment Plant (STP) fully operational, the Andaman and Nicobar Pollution Control Committee (ANPCC) shall be constrained to restrain the defaulters from carrying out their industrial/other activity.

An opportunity of hearing will be given to all stakeholders on 22-12-2021 except the 75 No. units mentioned in the list (published on page 2 of this issue) to appear before Secretary (S&T) cum Chairman, ANPCC in the presence of concerned Deputy Commissioners of Andaman and Nicobar Islands to give explanation in person for non-compliance of Hon'ble Supreme Court order dated 22.02.2017 in W.P. (C) 375/2012. Hearing will be given on first come first serve basis, a press release from Member Secretary, ANPCC said.

## DRDO conducts flight demonstration of Controlled Aerial Delivery System

New Delhi, Dec. 19 A series of activities organised towards celebrating Azadi Ka Amrit Mahotsav, commemorating 75 years of Independence. The CADS-500 is used for precise delivery of payload upto 500 kgs at predetermined location by making use of manoeuvrable capabilities of Ram Air Parachute. It uses Global Positioning System for the coordinates, altitude and heading sensors for the heading information during its flight. The CADS, with its onboard electronics unit, autonomously steers its flight path using waypoint navigation towards target location by operating controls. System performance was demonstrated yesterday at Drop Zone at Malpura in Agra from an altitude of 5000m. (Source: india.gov.in)

## Kidambi Srikanth bags historic silver in BWF World Championships in Spain



Madrid, Dec. 19 Kidambi Srikanth bagged a historic silver medal after losing to Loh Kean Yew of Singapore 15-21, 20-22 in the Men's singles final of BWF World Championships at Huelva in Spain this evening. Srikanth is the first Indian to finish runners-up.

Former World Number one, Srikanth yesterday etched his name in the history books after becoming the first Indian men's badminton player to reach the singles final of a World Championships. In a historic all-Indian semifinal, Srikanth defeated compatriot Lakshya Sen 17-21, 21-14, 21-17 last night in a thrilling contest that lasted an hour and nine minutes. Lakshya finished with the bronze medal.

This is the first time that India got two medals in the men's singles in the same edition of the Badminton World championships.

penalty. Due dates for monthly contribution payment is arrived based on the deposit of first contribution amount. In case of repeated defaults for specified period, the account is liable for foreclosure and the GoI co-contributions, if any shall be forfeited. Also any false declaration about his/her eligibility for benefits under this scheme for whatsoever reason, the entire Govt. contribution shall be forfeited along with the penal interest.

For enrolment, Aadhaar would be the primary KYC document for identification of beneficiaries, spouse and nominees to avoid pension rights and entitlement related disputes in the long-term.

## PUBLIC NOTICE

WHEREAS the Hon'ble Supreme Court of India, New Delhi in its Order dated 22.02.2017 in W.P.(C) No. 375 of 2012 in Paryavaran Suraksha Samiti & Anr vs Union Of India & Ors has directed that "all industrial units, which require "consent to operate", by way of a common advertisement, requiring them to make their primary effluent treatment plants fully operational, within three months from today. On the expiry of the notice period of three months, the concerned State Pollution Control Board(s) are mandated to carry out inspections, to verify, whether or not, each industrial unit requiring "consent to operate", has a functional primary effluent treatment plant. Such of the industrial units, which have not been able to make their primary effluent treatment plant fully operational, within the notice period, shall be restrained from any further industrial activity."

AND WHEREAS the Hon'ble Court has further directed that "this direction may be implemented by requiring the concerned electricity supply and distribution agency, to disconnect the electricity connection of the defaulting industry. We therefore hereby further direct, that in case the concerned State Pollution Control Boards make a recommendation to the concerned electrical supply and distribution agency/company, to disconnect electricity supply to an industry, for the reason that its primary effluent treatment plant is not functional, it shall honour such recommendation, and shall disconnect the electricity supply to such defaulting industrial concern, forthwith. Such an industrial concern, which has been disabled from carrying on its industrial activities, as has been indicated in the foregoing paragraph, is granted liberty to make its primary effluent treatment plant functional to the required capacity, and thereupon, seek a fresh "consent to operate" from the concerned Pollution Control Board. Only after the receipt of such fresh "consent to operate", the industrial activities of the disabled industry, can be permitted to be resumed. In carrying out the above exercise, we consider it just and appropriate to require, the Pollution Control Boards to carry out inspections, by prioritizing inspections of severely and critically polluted industries, so that visible results emerge at the earliest."

NOW THEREFORE, in pursuance of order issued by the Hon'ble NGT Eastern Zone order dated 07-12-2021 in Appeal No 06/2017/EZ with appeal No. 09/2017/EZ in the matter of Andaman Chamber of Commerce and Industry & Ors Vs the Andaman and Nicobar Administration and Ors with Hotel Sentinel & Ors Vs the Andaman and Nicobar Administration and Ors, all the Hotels, Automobile Service Centers and other industrial units who have not installed STP/ETP (New/Old) or do not have Consent to Operate(CTO) may come and give explanation in person for non-compliance of Hon'ble Supreme Court order dated 22.02.2017 in W.P. (C) 375/2012. No excuse or alibi shall be entertained unless they comply with the direction of the Hon'ble Supreme Court.

The industrial units requiring "Consent to Operate" and all others requiring to setup Effluent Treatment Plant and Sewage Treatment Plant in Andaman and Nicobar Islands are therefore called upon to take all measures necessary to ensure that the Effluent treatment Plants(ETP) and Sewage Treatment Plant(STP) installed in their premises are made fully operational and the effluents/sewage discharged from them meet the standards prescribed in the Environment (Protection) Act 1986 in faithful compliance of the direction issued by Hon'ble Supreme Court. In the event of the failure on the part of the industrial units and others to make their primary Effluent treatment Plants and Sewage Treatment Plant fully operational, the Andaman and Nicobar Pollution Control Committee(ANPCC) shall be constrained to restrain the defaulters from carrying out their industrial/other activity.

An opportunity of hearing will be given to all stakeholders on 22-12-2021 except the 75 No. units mentioned in the list, to appear before Secretary(S&T) cum Chairman, ANPCC in presence of concerned Deputy Commissioners of Andaman and Nicobar Islands to give explanation in person for non-compliance of Hon'ble Supreme Court order dated 22.02.2017 in W.P. (C) 375/2012. Hearing will be given on first come first serve basis.
