encouraged to stand up for their safety and security in order to prevent crime against children.



Coronavirus Cases in India: देश में कोविड के बढ़ते (Covid Cases) मामलों से एक बार फिर चिंता बढ़ गई है। आईसीएमआर में महामारी विभाग के पूर्व हेड डॉ. रमन गंगाखेडकर ने कहा कि, अभी तक कोरोना का कोई नया

नई दिल्ली: देश में कोविड के बढ़ते (Covid Cases) मामलों से एक बार फिर कोरोना के नए वेरिएंट (Corona New Variant) और नई लहर की आशंका बढ़ गई है। ऐसे में कोविड अनुरूप व्यवहार जैसे मास्क लगाना और सोशल डिस्टेंसिंग का पालन करना जरूरी हो गया है। आईसीएमआर में महामारी विभाग के पूर्व हेड डॉ. रमन गंगाखेडकर ने लोगों से अपील की है कि वे वैक्सीन लें और कोरोना महामारी संबंधित अन्य नियमों का पालन करें। न्यूज एजेंसी एनआई से बात करते हुए डॉ. रमन गंगाखेडकर ने कहा कि, अभी तक कोरोना का कोई नया वेरिएंट सामने नहीं आया है। वे लोग जिनकी उम्र ज्यादा है, वे लोग जिन्होंने अब तक कोविड वैक्सीन नहीं ली है और वे लोग जो इस वायरस से संक्रमित हो चुके हैं, उन्हें फेस मास्क का इस्तेमाल करना चाहिए।

मुझे नहीं लगता है कि इस वायरस का मौजूदा संक्रमण चौथी कोरोना की चौथी लहर है। पूरी दुनिया में ओमिक्रॉन वेरिएंट के सब वेरिएंट 1.2 के कारण बड़ी संख्या में लोग प्रभावित हुए हैं। कोरोना के बढ़ते मामलों के बावजूद हम लोग मास्क का इस्तेमाल कर रहे हैं और गलतफहमी में हैं कि अब संक्रमण का कोई खतरा नहीं है।

कोरोना की 'ट टंसनम' ने बढ़ाई चिंता, जनवरी के बाद पहली बार ग्राफ तेजी से बढ़ा, जानें इससे जुड़ा खतरा

इससे पहले आईआईटी कानपुर के प्रोफेसर ने न्यूज एजेंसी पीटीआई से कहा था कि, सामाजिक गतिविधियां बढ़ने, मास्क नहीं पहनने और सावधानी नहीं रखने की वजह से कोरोना के मामलों में तेजी से वृद्धि हुई है। हालांकि प्रोफेसर अग्रवाल ने भी कहा है कि, फिलहाल कोरोना की चौथी लहर के कोई संकेत नहीं है।

इसके अलावा महामारी विशेषज्ञ और अन्य एक्सपर्ट्स ने लोगों से मास्क लगाने और सोशल डिस्टेंसिंग का पालन करने की अपील की है ताकि संक्रमण के संभावित खतरे से बचा जा सके। बता दें कि दिल्ली, हरियाणा, उत्तर प्रदेश और कर्नाटक समेत कई राज्यों में कोरोना के एक्टिव केस तेजी से बढ़े हैं, जिसकी वजह से हालात चिंताजनक हो गए हैं।

SOUTH ANDAMAN DISTRICT POLICE STAFF ARREST POCSO ACCUSED FROM RAJASTHAN

On the complaint of a minor victim girl, a case U/s 13/14 POCSO Act 2012 r.w.s 354(D)/509 IPC was registered in South Andaman District. The accused Sagar R/o Rajasthan had sent the morphed nude photo of the minor girl on Instagram. The minor victim girl had met the accused on social media platform and started conversing through the social media (Whatsapp and Instagram). The minor girl stopped talking to the boy when he messaged her through a fake

Instagram account. On this the accused boy got agitated and he morphed the photo of minor victim girl making it obscene and shared on social media. The investigation team with the help of cyber cell, CID unit immediately brought down the obscene content. The team located the accused in Rajasthan. Without any delay, a team consisting of SI Sudhir Kumar and SI B. Santosh was sent to Rajasthan to arrest the accused. The team showed exemplary

investigative skills and after receipt of the surrounding arrested the accused on 30/03/2022 with the help of Rajasthan Police. The accused was produced before special court POCSO and sent to Judicial Custody. Further, investigation is under progress.

The A&N Police hereby appeals to the general public to not share their personal details on social media and keep a check on privacy options on the platform. They should report any such incidences without any delay.

CONFISCATE 35 KGS OF VENISON

On 18/04/2022, a credible information was received that 02 persons were carrying venison near Coconut Plantation, Collinpur. Upon this information, a team comprising of ASI Muthukannan along with PC Sasi Kumar Das apprehended two persons who were carrying white coloured plastic bag. The Police team checked the bag and recovered suspected venison weighing about 35 kgs

(approximately) and a machete from their possession. The details of the persons are 1. Kamal Roy S/o Shri Kartick Roy (30) yrs R/o Collinpur and 2. Pritam Singh S/Shri. Kalu Singh (31) yrs R/o Manpur. Both the persons were detained and brought to PS Ograbraj. Later on, the detained persons alongwith the seized articles were handed over to Forest Department.

The South Andaman District Police is committed to eradicate all anti-social activities from the society. The entire operation was conducted under the supervision of SDPO Bambooflat Shri Saurabh Chandra, DANIPS. PRI members of Little Andaman plan major protest in front of CCS as LPG crisis deepens; CSS confirms loading of Cylinders Tomorrow



Port Blair, Apr 19: The PRI members of Little Andaman have submitted an intimation to the Tehsilder of Little Andaman regarding staging of protest in front of the CCS Ltd, Hut Bay on 21st April 2022 at 10.00 AM to demand the regular supply of LPG cylinders for Little Andaman and copies of the intimation have been sent to all senior officers of Andaman and Nicobar Administration.

Since a long time the PRI members and General Public of Little Andaman have been demanding regular supply of LPG cylinders to Little Andaman but it seems there is no end to their sufferings. Andaman Sheekha Daily spoke to the Secretary of CCS in this regard, who informed this press that CCS already has nearly 3500 LPG Cylinders for Little Andaman but due to unavailability

of dangerous cargo ships, CCS is unable to transport LPG Cylinders to Little Andaman. "Now with the support of Administration a private Cargo ship is ready to sail for Hutbay with 3500 LPG Cylinders, which will be loaded tomorrow. After loading the ship will immediately sail for Hut Bay," the Secretary assured.

Port Blair, Apr 18: Mr. Vishal Jolly, National Executive Committee Member BJP and Former State President of A&N BJP and Home Ministry Advisory Committee Member demanded to restore all convoys in Andaman Trunk Road operating between Jirkatang to Middle Strait and from Middle Strait to Jirkatang. The same was curtailed and restricted to a limited movement due to the COVID pandemic

since March 2020. Now the GoI including the UT Administration has revoked the Disaster Management Act which was enforced to impose restrictions and containment of COVID-19 in the country. Due to the imposition of the above restriction of movement of convoy the essential services have immensely affected and also badly affected the life and livelihood of the entire population living in the logistically

constrained district of North & Middle Andaman.

Considering the difficulties faced by the commuters especially the Islanders of North & Middle Andaman and visiting tourists, Mr. Jolly requested the Chief Secretary to restore all convoy trips between Jirkatang to Middle Strait and vice versa as pre-covid practice for the convenience and to provide seamless connectivity to commuters.

Rigorous Life Imprisonment for Sexual Offence upon Minor Girl

Shri. Jimut Bahan Biswas, Hon'ble Special Judge under POCSO Act, North & Middle Andaman, Mayabunder has convicted one accused person namely Sajal Das R/o Gandhi Nagar under PS Diglipur and sentenced to undergo rigorous imprisonment for life for the offence punishable under section 6 of POCSO Act, 2012 and also to pay fine of Rs.2,00,000/ (rupees two lakhs), out of which 90 percent amount is to be paid to the victim girl as compensation u/s. 357 of Cr.P.C, in default of payment which convict will have to undergo rigorous imprisonment for one year more.

A case under POCSO Act was registered in the Police Station, Diglipur vide FIR No. 78 of 2020, dated 08/08/2020 on the basis of fardbayan by the victim girl. The fact of the case is that on 07/06/2020 the accused and victim girl were watching mobile phone at the house of the accused and at that time the accused asked the victim to come and sleep with him at night and thereafter, they performed physical relationship on consent and such event the minor victim girl became pregnant.

For the rehabilitation of victim girl, an amount of Rs.5,00,000/-

(rupees five lakhs) has been awarded as compensation as per provision of 357A of Cr.P.C from Victim Compensation Fund. The entire case was investigated by SI Jishi George under the supervision of Mr. Vichitra Veer, IPS, Superintendent of Police (D), Mayabunder for which the Hon'ble Court has appreciated for energetic investigation conducted by the Investigation Officer. The entire prosecution case was conducted by Shri. Keshab Chandra Mondal, learned Special Public Prosecutor (POCSO Act), Mayabunder.

Since the last several years no helicopter has been scheduled for Shaheed Dweep, even when repeated demands have been raised in different platforms by the public and grassroot leaders.

"A lot of senior citizens, who can't travel by ferries, would prefer a journey to Port Blair for various medical, officials and legal work. Due to the absence of any helicopter service at present for Shaheed Dweep these people are not able to visit Port Blair," alleged a resident of Shaheed Dweep. Other than this, Helicopter service is also necessary for high value tourists and business owners, who pump money in Shaheed Dweep's local economy and hence absence of helicopter service for Shaheed Dweep has now become a hurdle for the growth of Shaheed Dweep. "Helicopter service is always time



saving and convenient for the public and when people of other Islands are getting this benefit why residents of Shaheed Dweep have been kept deprived from such service?" asked another resident of Shaheed Dweep. According to Islanders, a fully functional Helipad is present at Sheheed Dweep but as no helicopter is scheduled for Shaheed Dweep the Helipad is now in pathetic shape and in next few years the Helipad will become fully unsuitable for the landing of helicopters, even in case of emergency like VVIP visit and

Medical evacuation. One can see tall grasses on the helipad of Shaheed Dweep, which sends a wrong signal among the visiting tourists. Leaving the helipad of Shaheed Dweep at the mercy of elements, is nothing but a gross wastage of tax-payers' money. Residents of Shaheed Dweep are now demanding to schedule helicopter service for Shaheed Dweep for atleast twice a week and to give adequate publicity regarding this so that people of Shaheed Dweep and tourists can make use of such service.

Two new petrol outlets in Kadamtala and Baratang to bring huge relief for ATR commuters

Port Blair, Apr 20: Two Brand new Petroleum Retail Outlets in Kadamtala and Baratang will soon be ready to facilitate passengers commuting through ATR.

As per details, the A&N Administration is setting up Petroleum Retail Outlets and for this Andaman Nicobar Islands Integrated Development Corporation Ltd. (ANIIDCO) has taken up the initiative to construct two Petrol Pumps one each at Kanchangadh in Baratang and Uttara in Kadamtala.

The Administration had earlier allotted land to ANIIDCO for setting up the Petrol Pumps in these two places and the construction work for both the projects has been completed by

Andaman Public Works Department (APWD) which has been entrusted with these projects, it is learnt.

According to the information received, the work for the Petrol Pump at Uttara has been completed and the trial run has been initiated by ANIIDCO in association with Indian Oil Corporation. This Retail Outlet at Uttara will have a storage capacity of 40KL (20 K1 for Petrol and 20kl for Diesel) having 2 Dispensing Units with 4 nozzles. Similarly, the Petrol Pump at Kanchangadh, Baratang has also been completed and the APWD will hand over it to ANIIDCO soon after which the trial run of this Petrol Pump will also start. This Petroleum Retail Outlet will

also have a storage capacity of 40 Kilolitre for Petrol and 40 kilolitres for Diesel having 3 Dispensing Units with 6 nozzles. Reportedly the sanctioned project cost for construction of Petrol Pump at Baratang is Rs. 2.89 crores while the project cost at Kadamtala is Rs. 2.44 crores. Presently, the Andaman Nicobar Islands Integrated Development Corporation Ltd. (ANIIDCO) is maintaining 11 Petroleum Retail Outlet/ Depots covering the length and breadth of A&N Islands.

The addition of these two new Petroleum Retail Outlets at Baratang and Kadamtala, will fulfill the aspirations of the people residing there and the commuters passing through NH-4.

A&N Admin with GP Guptapara and Sippighat initiate Cleanliness and Beautification programme

Port Blair, Apr 18: Following the directions of the Chief Secretary, A&N Administration during the visit to Guptapara, Manglutan and Nayashahar area various actions are initiated by the Guptapara Panchayat with the interdepartmental coordination.
