vegetables have been soaring for the past many months. Sanjita, a resident of A/Bazar said that she visited market on Monday to she visited market on Monday to purchase vegetables and had to payRs 120 for a kg of potatoes and Rs 140 for a kg of onions. The price rise has affected the weaker section of people in the islands as vegetables for the daily diet of many people, particularly vegetarians. Meanwhile, sources haveinformed that due to lack of drive by the Civil Supplies dept on those involved in hoarding of

### Punjab crackdown

The Punjab government has renewed its crackdown on extremists to meet the threat of the "intensified" agitation by the Akali Dal (L). The Dal has worked out details of its proposed civil disobedience movement in the state. At a press conference in Amritsar, its chief. Sant Harchand Singh Longowal, said the district and circle units of the Dal had already been alerted. The Dal had threatened to launch the movement if its demands, including the release of Jamail Singh Bhindranwale by October 17 were not accepted. Puran Singh, a Nihang, was allegedly arrested from inside Gurdwara Darbar Sahib at Tarn Taran in Amritsar district two days ago. Two Khalistan protagonists have been rounded up in Patiala and one Akali worker in Sirhind, Gurdev Singh Khalsa, press secretary of the Patiala district Akali Jatha (L.), was arrested at Bassi Pathana on Saturday,

Akail Jatifa L. J., was arrested at basis Patifaira on Saturday.

The crisis created by the suspension of two ministers from the Andhra Congress-I by the APCC-I chief, K. Prabhakar Rao, is yet to be resolved. The future of the two ministers, C. Das and N. Chandrababu Naidu, remains uncertain. All the key figures in the drama have been called to Delhi by the party high command. Prabhakar Rao told newsmen that he was not aware or concerned about the ministers' visit to Delhi

Nearly 100 school children who were wounded in recent Teheran street demonstrations were taken from their hospital beds to the city's Erin prison last week and executed, the Paris office of the radical Muslim Mujahedin group said on Sunday. In a statement telephoned to Reuters in London, the Mujahedin added that the children's bodies, instead of being taken to the coroner's office to be prepared for Muslim rites as is usual, were buried in the "Infidel, cemetery".

# DGCI PANEL RECOMMENDS CO FOR USAGE ON KIDS AGED 2-18

Anexpert panel of India's Central Drug Authority has recommended emergency use of Bharat Biotech's Covaxin for children in the 2-18 years age group with certain conditions, sources said on Tuesday.

### WHO recommends booster **COVID-19** vaccine for *immunocompromised*

Organisation (WHO) recommended organisation (WHO) recommended people be giv en an additional dose of COVID-19 vaccine, due to their higherrisk of break through infections after standard im munisation, news agency Reuters reported. WHO vaccine director Kate O'Brien, referring to people with lower immunity due to other conditions, told a news briefing: "The recommendation is for a third vaccination, an additional vaccination in the primary series and again that is based on the evidence showing that the immunogenicity and evidence on breakthrough infections is highly disproportionately represented by those people."

Debate on boosters in India Several scientists from India had said the priority must be to ensure that more people are ed with at least their first jab rather than ensuring a booster dose Immunologist Saty ajit Rath said that less than 15 per cent of Indian adults have been vaccinated with two doses, and this clearly means that all Indians who are more vulnerable



"I therefore think that it is ehically premature to begin planning a third dose to a fortunate category of people at this stage, Rath, from New Delhi's National Institute of Immunology (NII)," he told PTI. "It is also pragmatically premature to do so, since we have no really do so, since we have no really clear idea of who is 'morevulnerable to infection'. We do know that some co-morbid categories are more vulnerable to serious illness, but two doses of the current vaccines currently protect quite well against that "he said.

### India calls for IPR waiver, dismantling of trade barriers in fight against COVID

Minister Pivush Gov al called fo the waiver of Intellectual Property the waiver of Intellectual Property Rights (IPR) in the World Trade Organization (WTO) and the dismantling of new trade barriers in the global fight against the COVID-19 pandemic. In October 2020, India and

In October 2020, India and South Africa had submitted the first proposal, suggesting a waiver for all WTO members on the implementation of certain provisions of the Trade-Related provisions of the Trade-Related Aspects of Intellectual Property Rights (TRIPs) Agreement in relation to the prevention, containment or treatment of COVID-19.

In May this year, a revised proposal was submitted by 62 cosponsors, including India, South

Africa and Indonesia.

The agreement on TRIPs came into effect in January 1995. It is a multilateral agreement on intellectual property (IP) rights such as copy right, industrial designs,

"Our response to the

pandemic needs to ensure equitable access to vaccines and other access to vaccines and other COVID-19 related health products by ensuring quick resolution of the supply-side constraints. ### **Retail inflation in Sept** falls to 4.35%, IIP grows 11.9% in August: Govt.

the country based on Consumer Price Index (CPI) fell bd 4.35 per centin the month of September as food prices dropped, the data released by the Ministry of Statistics & Programme Implementation (MoSPI) showed. As opposed to this, retail inflation had jumped to an eight-month high of 7.34 per cent in September 2020, primarily driven by higher food inflation.

Separately, the Index of Industrial Production (IIP) withessed a growth of 11.9 per cent in August, according to the government data.

In August, the CPI inflation ratehad eased to a bur-month low of 5.3 per cent due to moderation in food prices along with a high base effect. Moreover, the infation in food basket dropped to 0.68 per cent in September 2021, significantly down from 3.11 per

cent in the preceding month.

The Tata Group's acquisition of stake-owned Air India, an airline which JRD Tata had founded decades ago, will not only give new wings for the airline to soar higher, but is also going to force rival a irlines to redraw their plans. Air India has been loss making every year since it was merged with Indian Airlines in 2007-08. However, under the Tatas it could turn around

with much needed cost cuts, fresh fund infusion and a renewed sales and

"This is evident considering the network (7 of Vistara and 70 of Air India, without considering the overlap), wide body aircraft fleet (total 49, 2 of wide body aircraft fleet (total 19, 20) Nistara and 47 of Air India) and international market share of the combination. This entity can pose serious threat to the international long haul aspirations of IndiGo or the international cargo plans of SpiceJet," said Ansuman Deb, analyst at ICICI

The international market share of The international market share of Air India and Vistara combined up to July 2021 stood at 64 per cent, compared with Indigo's 29 per cent and Spicalets 7 per cent, according to ICICI Securities. Even in the domestic market, the Tataswill hold a strong 26 per cent market share with Air India. Vistara

market share with Air India, Vistara and Air Asia India combined. Over the last decade, demand for international travel from India has grown rapidly. However, given that Air India was the sole player with a wide international reach and it too was unable to utilise its network to the full capacity due to continuous losses. capacity due to continuous losses, foreign carriers like Emirates, Etihad and Singapore Airlines among others cashed in on the demand. Now, there is a potential to get some of this business back to India, and create more jobs in the country, with a strong player in the Tatas, says litender Bhargava, former executive director of Air India.



The Tatas' acquisition of AirIndia nes at a time billionaire investor Rakesh Jhunjhunwala is starting a new ultra-low cost airline Akasa and Jet ultra-low cost artine Akasa and Jet Airways, which was recently acquired by a consorium of Kalrock Capital and businessman Murari Lal Jalan, is also hoping to fly again in the next few months. It is clearly not going be easy for the newbies with a newformidable player in the Tatas.
