New Delhi, June 30 (PIB)

He also digitally transferred assistance to beneficiaries of PMEGP for 2022-23; announced results of the MSME Idea Hackathon, 2022; distributed National MSME Awards, 2022; and issued Digital Equity Certificates to 75 MSMEs in the Self Reliant India (SRI) Fund. Union Ministers, Shri Narayan Rane and Shri Bhanu Pratap Singh Varma, MSME stakeholders from all over the country, and Diplomats from



linked with the quality and promotion of MSME.

The Prime Minister remarked that when we say MSME, it expands in technical language to Micro Small and Medium Enterprises. But these Micro, Small and Medium Enterprises are a huge pillar of India's growth journey. The MSME sector accounts for almost one-third of India's economy. Strengthening the MSME sector is strengthening the entire society, making everyone recipient of the benefits of development. That is why this sector is one of the highest priorities of the Government, he said.

To strengthen the MSME sector, in the last eight years, the Prime Minister said, the Government has increased the budget allocation for this by more than 650%. "For us, MSME

Registration of migrant workers on arrival at Airport/Wharf being done smoothly

6100 workers registered by Labour Department till date

Shops & Establishments functioning in Isles urged to renew their Registration Certificate on annual basis

Port Blair, June 30

The registration of migrant workers at Airport/Wharf is progressing smoothly and till date, a total of 6100 workers have been registered by the Labour Department. Recently, a registration camp under PMSYM was also conducted at Dr BR Ambedkar Auditorium for registration of workers engaged under loading and unloading sector wherein around 100 workers were registered.

Meanwhile, the Labour Department has initiated several measures with an aim to dispose of Labour related grievance on priority basis. About 10 cases under Employees Compensation Act were settled wherein a total of Rs. 75,37,157/- was released from the employers to the workmen. Similarly, a total of 27 cases were settled under Non-Payment of Wages and a total



amount of Rs.16,06,088/- was released from the employers to the workmen during the period February to June 2022.

For the first time in 10 years, prosecution case was initiated against defaulting employer under Labour Laws and penalty as laid down was imposed against a prominent Textile Showroom for violation of Labour Laws.

Establishments functioning in the Islands have been urged to renew their Registration Certificate on annual basis.

Andhra Pradesh, Gujarat, Haryana, Karnataka, Punjab, Tamil Nadu and Telangana are the Top Achievers based on implementation of Business Reforms

Action Plan. Himachal Pradesh, Madhya Pradesh, Maharashtra, Odisha, Uttarakhand and Uttar Pradesh figure under the Achievers category. While Assam, Chhattisgarh, Goa, Jharkhand, Kerala, Rajasthan and West Bengal have been placed in the Aspirers category, Andaman & Nicobar Islands, Bihar, Chandigarh, Daman & Diu, Dadra & Nagar Haveli, Delhi, Jammu & Kashmir, Manipur, Meghalaya, Nagaland, Puducherry and Tripura have been clubbed under the Emerging Business Ecosystems category.

Smti. Nirmala Sitharaman, Hon'ble Minister of Finance and Corporate Affairs, announced the assessment of States/UTs under Business Reforms Action Plan (BRAP) 2020, the 5th edition of the BRAP exercise in New Delhi today. The announcements were made in the august presence of Shri Piyush Goyal, Hon'ble



Minister of Commerce & Industry, Consumer Affairs, Food & Public Distribution and Textiles, Shri Anurag Jain, Secretary, DPIIT and Senior Government officials of State and UT Administration.

Speaking after release of assessment report, Smti. Sitharaman said that the nature of reforms had undergone change since 1991. "The reforms now taking place are responsive reforms. Unlike the reforms of 1991, which were given to us for implementation, there is no compulsion now. The objective is to see what will bring out improvement in systems and ensure better lives for us. An element of nudge has been brought into every layer of the Government. Nudging cannot be by the Government only and the industry has a big role to play there", the Finance Minister said. The Finance Minister appreciated the changes brought in the assessment

framework of implementation under the Business Reforms Action Plan over years.

Speaking at the event, Shri Piyush Goyal, Hon'ble Minister for Commerce & Industry said that the assessment has evolved from evidence-based to 100% feedback in multilingual format. He said that the purpose of this BRAP exercise is to infuse a culture of learning from each other's best practices and improve upon the business climate in each State/UT with a unified objective for India to emerge as a most favoured Investment Destination across the globe.

It is commendable to note the endeavour of the States/UTs in implementing the reforms and with that spirit, DPIIT has assessed and grouped States/UTs into broad category-wise segmentation to recognize and identify the exemplary reform measures undertaken by the States/UTs to improve business environment.

Souvenir Shop inaugurated at Betapur Govt. Saw Mill

Rangat, June 30

A Souvenir Shop with varied collection of wood based artifacts was inaugurated in the premises of Govt. Saw Mill, Betapur yesterday by Shri Satyaprakash Singh, Divisional Forest Officer, Middle Andaman in the presence of Sub Divisional Magistrate, Rangat, PRI Members, Local Officers, staff and workers of Govt. Saw Mill, Betapur. The shop is open for general public/tourists to purchase any woodworks of their choice.

The Middle Andaman Forest Division on the backdrop of adding value to the waste generated during conversion of logs, came up with an idea of creating a souvenir shop under Sansad Adarsh Gram Yojana with the theme 'An approach



towards waste wood management'.

This would provide a conducive environment for the local artisans to showcase their skills and to be self reliant in long run. As per the initiative of GOI towards 'Aatma Nirbhar Abhiyan' the local youth were roped in for manufacturing artifacts. Accordingly, the youth interested in making handicrafts/artifacts were selected and imparted short time training in collaboration with the Industries Department to hone their skills. Creating a souvenir shop in these remote areas is

first of its kind in the District of North & Middle Andaman, which adds to the list of tourist facilities created within the district. Moreover, in the long run, the local youth would be benefited/self reliant by showcasing their products for sale in the dedicated space of this souvenir shop.

Manufacturing of Souvenirs has indeed helped in adding value to the waste wood, thereby justifying the concept of 'Scrap to Souvenir', a press release from DFO, Middle Andaman Forest Division said.

COVID-19 status in A&N Islands

Port Blair, June 30

During the RT-PCR test conducted on 177 incoming flight passengers, who arrived here yesterday, ten positive cases have been detected. Today, 12 flights with 1864 passengers arrived, out of which, 1632 passengers were

vaccinated with both doses while RT-PCR test was conducted on 180 passengers and the reports are awaited.

During RAT conducted on 34 passengers bound for North & Middle Andaman at Ferrargunj, no positive case has been detected. At Phoenix

Bay Jetty, 32 passengers were tested with RAT, no positive case has been detected. RAT was conducted on 49 passengers at Mohanpura Bus Terminus and no positive case has been detected, a press release from Directorate of IP&T said.

means - Maximum Support to Micro Small and Medium Enterprises", the Prime Minister stressed.

The Prime Minister remarked that MSME is critical for employment generation. During the pandemic, the Government decided to save the small enterprises and give them new strength. Under the Emergency Credit Line Guarantee Scheme, the Central Government has ensured Rs 3.5 lakh crore for MSMEs, he said.

The Prime Minister pointed out that in GeM, MSME has got a very strong platform to provide goods and services to the Government. He asked every MSME to get registered on the GeM portal.

Similarly, prohibiting global tenders for projects worth less than 200 crore will also help the MSME.

The Prime Minister said that the Government is taking measures to help MSME in increasing exports. The Indian Mission abroad has been told to work on this. The Prime Minister said that the Missions are being evaluated on three parameters i.e. trade, technology and tourism.

The Prime Minister said that difficulty in getting loans without guarantees was a major obstacle for the vulnerable sections of the society to pursue the path of entrepreneurship. After 2014, it was decided to enlarge the ambit of entrepreneurship through Sabka Sath, Sabka Vikas, Sabka Vishwas and Sabka Prayas.

Mudra Yojana, he said, has a huge role to play in making entrepreneurship easy for every Indian. This scheme of bank loans without guarantee has created a large section of women entrepreneurs, Dalit, backward, tribal entrepreneurs in the country. So far, about Rs 19 lakh crore has been given as a loan under this scheme.

Among the borrowers, there are about 7 crore such entrepreneurs, who have started an enterprise for the first time, who have become new entrepreneurs, he added. He also noted that on Udyam Portal too, more than 18 percent of those registered are women entrepreneurs. 24,477 beneficiaries in the age group of 12 to 14 years administered both doses of vaccine till date

The vaccination drive is continuing smoothly in A&N Islands. As per data available, a total of 6,83,708 doses of vaccine have been administered to beneficiaries in the age group of 18 and above so far. Similarly, 23,583 beneficiaries have been vaccinated in the age group of 15 to 18 years. 24,477, beneficiaries in the age group of 12 -14 years have been administered both doses of vaccine till date, out of which 13,301 beneficiaries have been vaccinated with first dose while 11176 have been administered second dose. The number of beneficiaries administered precautionary dose of vaccine so far stood at 27,459, a press release from DHS said.

India's COVID-19 vaccination coverage crosses 197.61 crore

New Delhi, June 30

Over 197 crore 61 lakh vaccine doses have been administered so far under Nationwide Vaccination Drive. The Health Ministry said, over 14 lakh 17 thousand doses were administered yesterday.

The recovery rate is currently at 98.55 per cent. 13 thousand eight hundred 27 people recovered in the last 24 hours. Total number of recoveries have reached four crore 28 lakh 22 thousand 493. Over 18 thousand eight hundred new cases were recorded in the last 24 hours. India's Active caseload currently stands at one lakh four thousand five hundred 55. Active cases stand at 0.24 per cent. Daily positivity rate is at 4.16 per cent and Weekly positivity rate is at 3.72 per cent. 39 deaths were reported in the last 24 hours. Over 86 crore 23 lakh tests have been conducted so far. 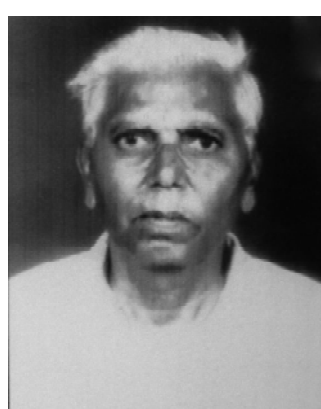

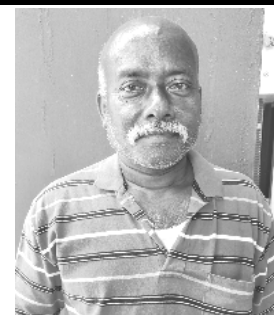
