Travel in MV Dering a nightmarish experience

:: AE Correspondent :: Port Blair, Nov 28: Travelling in MV Dering, one of the oldest vessels of the DSS is really a nightmare for the passengers. The aging vessel has only seats for seating and passengers had to complete about 17-18 hours of journey by seating in their seats. This vessel has approachment four cabins and all seats which cannot be converted into sleeping seats to provide comfort to the passengers. As a result passengers have to travel seated all throughout the night. The Directorate of Shipping Services has come out with the sailing schedule of MV Dering from Port Blair to Diglipur via Mayabunder. While passengers are happy that the sailing schedule of a vessel is being announced in advance, they are equally worried because of the inconvenience the passengers had to face availing morning and after 4-5 hours of night and atdawn they can reach

It is really shameful that the Shipping department which is consuming the bulk of the annual budget of the UT of A&N Islands has no speed boats to operate in this route which can provide both comfort and facilities to the passengers. "It is high time, the Directorate of Shipping Services think about providing comfort to the passengers travelling in MV Dering by either converting the seats into folding seats so that passengers can spend their night by sleeping or deploying some other vessel having sleeping seat facilities", says some passengers.



Be punchy on munchy

Food regulator FSSAI should cut down on munchies. It's given the snack industry a long fouryear-period before front of packet labelling (FOPL) becomes mandatory. And its limits for permissible sugar, salt and fat content in processed foods are very high. Lifestyle diseases like diabetes, hypertension and cardiac ailments are already at alarming levels. Factor in economic costs of morbidities - loss of productivity and household savings. The industry perhaps worries that FOPL will open people's eyes to the reality of processed foods. But that's exactly the point. Processed food is not healthy.

Good practices can start right away without waiting four years. Citizens have a right to know what exactly they are eating and its consequences down the line. Such consumer awareness will force the industry to adhere to safer levels of sugar, salt and fat content. FSSAI is opting for star rating – five stars for the healthiest food and half a star for the unhealthiest. But the positive factors for a higher rating like presence of vegetables, fruits, nuts, millets, fibres, etc are no consolation if the sugar, salt or fat content are also high in the same product. Such a munchy getting a five-star rating will be farcical.

What would help consumers most is knowing what percentage of the recommended dietary allowance (RDA) for a day is met by what they consume. Knowing whether a bar of chocolate meets 50%, 100% or 150% of the RDA for sugar and fat would certainly help. But FSSAI keeps this optional. Further, RDA claims of the packaged food industry need rigorous laboratory testing. FSSAI's baseline reference value for food risk factors at 21 gms per 100 gms serving for sugar in solid foods is too high considering that WHO had recommended keeping daily sugar intake to below 25 gms ideally, way back in 2015.

Should Gol consider using taxation as an instrument to discourage junk foods and incentivise healthy food? Kerala had initiated a "fat tax" on burgers and pizzas in 2016 before the GST rollout in 2017. Products high in sugar, salt and fat can be taxed higher while those low in these parameters get taxed lower. FOPL and regular tax hikes on cigarettes have helped disencentivise smoking. FSSAI should put citizens first. The market will adapt despite the snack food industry's current opposition. After all, everyone has to eat.

COVID NASAL SPRAYS MAY ONE DAY PREVENT AND TREAT INFECTION

We have vaccines to boost our immune response to SARS-CoV-2, the virus that causes Covid. We have medicines you can take at home (and in hospital) to treat Covid. Now researchers are trialling something

They want to develop drugs that stop the virus getting into the body in the firstplace. That includes nasal sprays that stop the virus attaching to cells in the nose.

Other researchers are looking at the potential for nasal sprays to stop the virus replicating in the nose, or to make the nose a hostile place to enter the body.

Here's where the science is up to and what we can expect next



Viral blockade, as the name suggests, is a simple premise based on blocking SARS-CoV-2. In other words, if something gets in its way, the virus cannot attach to a cell and it can't infect you.

As SARS-CoV-2 is a respiratory virus, it makes sense to deliver this type of medicine where the virus mainly enters the body via the nose, in a nasal spray

There are various groups around the world working on this concept Some research is still being conducted in the lab. Some agents have progressed to preliminary human trials. None are yetavailable for widespread use.

Heparin is a common medicine that's been used for decades to thin

the blood. Studies in mice show that when heparin is delivered via the nose, it's safe and effective in preventing the virus binding to nose cells. Researchers believe heparin binds to the virus itself and stops the virus attaching to the cells it's trying to infect

A clinical trial is being conducted in Victoria in collaboration between multiple Melbourne-based research centres and the University of Oxford

audited

Covixyl-V (ethyl lauroyl arginine hydrochloride) is another nasal spray under development. It aims to prevent Covid by blocking or modifying the cell surface to prevent the virus from infecting.

This compound has been explored for use in various viral infections, and early studies in cells and small animals has shown it can prevent attachment of SARS-CoV-2 and reduce the overall viral load.

lota-carrageenan This molecule, which is extracted from seaweed, acts by blocking virus entry into airway cells. One study of about 400 health-

care workers suggests a nasal spray may reduce the incidence of Covid by up to 80 per cent IGM-6268

How could we stop the virus replicating?

Another tactic is to develop nasal sprays that stop the virus replicating in the nose.

Researchers are designing genetic fragments that bind to the viral RNA. These fragments known as locked nucleic acid antisense oligonucleotides (or LNA ASOs for short) puta proverbial spanner in the works and stop the virus from replicating.

A spray of these genetic fragments delivered into the nose reduced virus replication in the nose and prevented disease in small

How could we change the

A third strategy is to change the nose environment to make it less hospitable for the virus

That could be by using a nasal spray to change moisture levels (with saline), alter the pH (making the nose more acidic or alkaline), or adding a virus-killing agent (iodine). Saline can reduce the amount of SARS-CoV-2 in the nose by simply

washing away the virus. One study less SARS-CoV-2 attachment and has even found that saline nasal irrigation can lessen Covid disease severity. But we would need further research into saline sprays.

An Australian-led study has found that an iodine-based nasal spray reduced the viral load in the nose. Further clinical trials are planned. One study used a testspray containing ingredients including eucalyptus and clove oils, potassium chloride and glycerol. The aim was to kill the virus and change the acidity of the nose to prevent the virus attaching.

This novel formulation has been tested in the lab and in a clinical trial showing it to be safe and to reduce infection rate from about 34 per cent to 13 per cent when compared to placebo controls. Despite promising data so far on nasal sprays for Covid, one of the major barriers is keeping the sprays in the nose. To overcome this, most sprays need multiple applications a day, sometimes every few hours.

So based on what we know so nasal sprays will not singlehandedly beat Covid. But if they are shown to be safe and effective in clinical trials, and receive regulatory approval, they might be another tool to help prevent it.

movement, civil disobedience that has prompted thousands of frustrated Chinese citizens to take to the streets against the government's draconian zero-Covid measures. Despite the measures to curb the unrest, the demonstrations seem to be only spreading to other cities, in a direct challenge to Chinese president Xi Jinping's iron grip over his citizens.

But what triggered this situation in China, despite most of the world moving on from Covid to normalcy? Why brought China, which boasted the success of its zero-Covid policy last year, to

the breaking point? Many experts allude to the flaws in the zero-Covid including measures. lockdowns aimed at smothering outbreaks and a failed vaccination policy, for the current crisis. While China may have succeeded in controlling previous outbreaks by imposing lockdowns and restricting the movement of atrisk groups, its efforts were hampered by the state's failure to raise immunity

among the vulnerable population by allowing some amount of transmission. According to Yanzhong Huang, a

senior fellow for global health at the Council on Foreign Relations, China's focus was on containment. "More intensive-care beds and better vaccination coverage should

have started two-and-a-half years ago, but the single-minded focus on containment meant fewer resources focused on this," he told The Washington Post.

Huang added that even the effective mRNA boosters, which China currently lacks, will be of little help to "resolve the fundamental problem with China's goal of eliminating infection rather than mitigating symptoms."

The country's lockdown measures, costlier yet ineffective, to deal with new variants of the virus is no long appropriate. Experts believe the government could transmissibility is no longer appropriate. The whole world has abandoned this approach - nobody can stand the cost, it's simply not working," Jin Dongyan, a virologist at the University of Hong Kong,

The Chinese vaccination policy too is full offlaws. The country's zero-Covid policy has stopped a majority of its 1.4 billion people from being exposed to the virus. Though they have launched a more aggressive vaccine drive now, a huge chunk of the elderly community remains

vulnerable.

Ironically, for a country that claims to have developed the first Covid vaccine, China is yet to come up with a native mRNA vaccine. Thanks to the ruling Communist party's innate nationalism, it has refused to import or licence a foreign one. This has resulted in the country's vaccination programme ending up mostly ineffective.

This is besides the questions raised over the

efficacy of Chinese vaccines. Private pharma firm Sinovac and state-run Sinopharm which manufactures the vaccines in the country have reportedly not yet published the final-stage clinical trials, casting doubts over the success of the vaccines. - Source : Theweek


