Ensuring nutritional security in Isles

Chief Secretary directs Agriculture Department to procure suitable vegetable seeds for promoting 'Homestead Vegetable Gardens'

Agriculture Department procuring 50,000 mini kits of vegetable seeds for distribution to households

Port Blair, Dec. 6

During the visit of Hon'ble Union Minister for Home and Cooperation, Shri Amit Shah, to the Islands in October 2021, it was decided that Homestead Vegetable Gardens can play an important role in fulfilling dietary and nutritional needs by providing households with direct access to vegetables that can be harvested, prepared and consumed by household members, often on a daily basis, for attaining self-sufficiency in vegetable production in the Islands.

Accordingly, the Chief Secretary, A & N Administration, Shri Jitendra Narain has instructed the Agriculture Department to procure suitable vegetable seeds for the Islands and distribute the mini kits to the households, farmers, homesteads etc to enhance the vegetable production in the Islands to achieve self-sufficiency thereby ensuring nutritional security of the Island populace.

For achieving the above objective, the Agriculture Department is procuring and planning to distribute 4 types of open pollinated vegetable seeds per mini kits so that the beneficiaries can preserve the seeds for growing in the coming season.

Accordingly, 50,000 vegetable seeds mini kits have been procured from the Office of the National Seeds Corporation, Chennai and the same are expected to reach Port Blair shortly for distribution to the households in the Islands as decided during the Hon'ble Union Home Minister's visit, a press release from Agriculture Department said.

Two positive cases detected during test conducted on inter-island passengers: Director (IP&T)

Port Blair, Dec. 6

The Director (IP&T), Shri Alok Kumar while giving information on COVID-19 status stated that during the RT-PCR test conducted on 313 passengers who arrived here yesterday, no positive case has been detected. Today, 12 flights with 2121 passengers arrived, out of which, 1772 were vaccinated with both doses

while RT-PCR test was conducted on 346 passengers (includes 9 international travellers) and the reports are awaited. During RAT conducted on 239 passengers bound for North & Middle Andaman at Ferrargunj, no positive case has been detected. At Mohanpura Bus Terminus, test was conducted on 32

MP introduces Private Member's Bill in Lok Sabha to provide 100 Percent Job Reservation for Islanders

Port Blair, Dec. 6

Shri Kuldeep Rai Sharma, Member of Parliament, Andaman and Nicobar Islands introduced a Private Member's Bill titled 'Reservation of Posts in Government Establishments of Andaman & Nicobar Islands Bill, 2019' on Dec. 3, 2021 in Lok Sabha, to provide reservation of job in Government establishments in A & N Islands for residents of the Islands to improve their standard of living through employment.

The Bill proposes to reserve hundred percent jobs for local candidates who have resided in the Union Territory of Andaman & Nicobar Islands for at least 10 years & holds a valid domicile certificate before the commencement of this act. The bill intends to provide legislative backing to residence based reservations for locals of A&N Islands who have resided in the islands for at least 10 years.

This bill seeks to provide adequate



opportunities to locals of A&N Islands who don't have sufficient representation in Government establishments. This bill will encourage the residents of the Islands to apply for recruitment in Government posts and it will facilitate the development of the islands as reservation for locals will aid in increasing the standard of living of the local candidates, a press release from MP Office said.

Farmers' Corner- A Knowledge Hub

Fertilizer from fish waste

Tuna processing units in Lakshadweep generate huge quantities of processing waste, which is conventionally thrown into the lagoon, where it causes occasional eutrophication. In an attempt to utilize this nitrogen rich processing waste in agriculture instead of polluting the water body, a fishfertilizer was produced using the composting bacterial consortia developed by Kerala Agricultural University. Waste from the Masmin production industry comprised mainly of the head of the fish, its vertebral column and offal. The head being a bigger mass was longitudinally split before adding to the composting pit. The bacterial consortium was established on to coco-peat from the pure culture. First a foundation layer of this coco-peat mixture was laid in the pit above which the split heads of tuna were arranged in layers with intermittent layers of coco-peat. The mixed offal was dripped in between the heads and a total of 5 layers were laid. It was finally covered with another layer of coco-peat and then with dry saw dust to prevent flies from laying eggs and to facilitate the breathing of compost. The pit was covered using a tarpaulin to prevent direct sunlight and rain. The setting was left undisturbed for 56 days, during which the hard mass was converted into a powdery mixture with some bones left undigested. A ground mixture of the same was analyzed and the composition was found to be Nitrogen - 10.23%, Phosphorus - 3.96 %, Potassium - 0.61%, Calcium - 6.78%, Magnesium - 0.35%, Sodium - 1.65%, Carbon - 38.12. The produce was successful in producing healthy foliage in Chilly and Brinjal.

Benefit: The product is a solution to the poor fertility of the calcareous soil in Lakshadweep and an alternative to the age-old practice of discarding tuna processing waste at sea.

passengers and no positive case has been detected. At Phoenix Bay Jetty, 53 passengers were tested with RAT and all were found negative. Two positive cases have been detected during test conducted on Hut Bay passengers. At helipad, RAT was conducted on 4 passengers and all were found negative. Today, till 3 pm, 437 eligible beneficiaries were vaccinated, out of which, 409 were of 18 plus age group.

Vaccination drive in A&N Islands

5,64,076 doses of vaccines administered to beneficiaries so far

Port Blair, Dec. 6

The safety of the citizens is the foremost priority of the Administration, especially during this pandemic time. To shield its citizens from the corona virus, the vaccination of eligible beneficiaries is being initiated by the Administration in different parts of the Islands.

Meanwhile, the vaccination drive is continuing smoothly in A&N Islands. As per data available, a total of 5,64,076 doses of vaccines have been administered to beneficiaries so far in A&N Islands, out of the target beneficiaries of 2,86,600 (approx.).

A total of 2742 people were vaccinated today. 2065 beneficiaries were vaccinated in South Andaman District, out of which, 105 beneficiaries were in the age group of 18-44 years. Similarly, 598 beneficiaries were vaccinated in North & Middle Andaman District, out of which, 11 beneficiaries were in the age group of 18-44. 79 beneficiaries were vaccinated in Nicobar District, out of which, 5 beneficiaries were in the age group of 18-44. A total of 1,76,296 eligible people in the age group of 18 to 44 years have been vaccinated till date.



India beat New Zealand by 372 runs in second test

Dethrones New Zealand to reclaim top spot in ICC Test Rankings

Mumbai, Dec. 6

India beat New Zealand by 372 runs in the second test at Mumbai to win the two-match series 1-0. India mopped up the New Zealand lower order within 40 minutes of play on day four at the Wankhede Stadium. Chasing a mammoth 540, the Black Caps were bowled out for 167 in 56.3 overs.

With this Virat Kohli and his men dethroned New Zealand in the latest ICC Test championships rankings and climbed to the top spot.

India now has 124 rating points, while New Zealand lost three points and remains with 121 points. The victory in Mumbai also meant that India registered their 14th consecutive series win at home. Kohli became the first player with 50 international wins in each format of the game.

They are followed by Australia (108), England (107), Pakistan (92), South Africa (88), Sri Lanka (83), West Indies (75), Bangladesh (49) and Zimbabwe (31).



ZSI to organize workshop on coastal and marine biodiversity of island ecosystems

About 21 participants have enrolled to attend the workshop to be held on Dec.7 & 8, under the Training of Personnel of other Services. This workshop will provide a unique opportunity to expose and learn about the marine faunal wealth of the island ecosystems and its importance, a press release from ZSI said.
