# Farmers' Corner- A Knowledge Hub Novel Systems for Cultivation of Burmese Coriander in Urban Areas

Burmese coriander or culantro is a popular herb cultivated and utilized extensively in the Islands. This herb is known for its refreshing cilantro-like aroma. Strong aroma, long shelf life and better adaptability make it a suitable crop for cultivation in the islands. Produce fetches high prices in the markets around Port Blair. To promote its cultivation in urban areas, novel technologies viz. 'CIARI- ProDhaniya' and 'CIARI-

ProDhaniya Multi' have been developed by ICAR-CIARI. Former method is suitable for cultivation of Burmese coriander for home scale production, whereas the latter is for large scale production. Developed technologies involve growing the herb in pro-trays filled with suitable substrate. In traditional cultivation, these plants are spaced 15-20 cm apart thereby requiring more space to cultivate. However, in pro-trays, planting cells are closely spaced but roots of each plant get separate space to grow. Hence, fifty plants could be accommodated in less than two square feet size. In CIARI-ProDhaniya Multi, pro-trays are arranged in racks thereby utilizing the vertical space. Considering the limited spaces available in the urban areas, one can easily maintain a few racks on the rooftops, balconies and backyards to grow this prized herb. Both methods are semi-intensive; require less maintenance and less investment. Depending upon the growing conditions and management practices followed, each pro-tray could produce about 500 g of fresh produce. Hence, one can easily harvest the desirable quantity of herb from their urban gardens.

Benefit: Through this compact method of cultivation, within limited space, Burmese coriander could be produced for home and commercial purposes in urban areas.

Lockdown/restricted movement shall ... (Contd. from page 1) liable for action under DM Act.

No movement of men and material without valid movement pass/e-pass shall be allowed after 10 pm. Movement shall be allowed after 10 pm for medical emergency cases. Persons engaged for essential activities for movement of goods on Andaman Trunk Road, loading and unloading of essential cargo after 10 pm shall be allowed on production of valid movement permit issued by the Office of District Magistrate. Travel of persons who intend to proceed to their destinations at mainland after 10 pm shall be allowed on production of valid travel documents. However, the person (one person) who intend to pick/drop after 10 pm, should apply for e-pass well in advance with supporting documents and the same shall be issued by the Office of District Magistrate on case to case basis.

Movement of officers/officials involved in providing essential services such as District Administration, Police, CISF, Health Services, ICMR, PBMC, Electricity, Shipping Services, Home Guards, Civil Defence, Fire and emergency services, Defence personnel on duty after 10 pm shall be permitted on production of valid Identity Cards issued by their concerned Departments. Movement of Officers/Officials, involved in providing services such as Forest, Water Supply & Sanitation in Rural Areas, Disaster Management, Port and related services, Telecommunication shall be allowed after 10 pm on production of movement passes already issued by the Office of District Magistrate.

Movement of personnel involved in providing Broadcasting, all print and electronic media persons after 10 pm shall be allowed on production of valid movement passes issued by the Office of District Magistrate. Movement of personnel involved in providing essential/emergency services shall be allowed after 10 pm on production of e-passes to be issued by the Office of District Magistrate. It shall be the sole responsibility of the owner/In-Charge of the shop/business establishment to ensure its compliance and also if any person attached with such organisation is found misusing the e-passes or using the same for purposes other than it is meant for, the owner/in-charge shall be held responsible and he/she shall be liable to be fined to the tune of Rs.25,000/- and shall also be liable for action under DM Act. All POL outlets shall be opened from 6 am to 10 pm.

Movement of private medical personnel such as Doctors, nursing staff, paramedics etc. attached with diagnostic centres and clinics, veterinary clinics shall be allowed after 10 pm on production of e-passes issued by the Office of District Magistrate. Movement of persons from containment zones shall be strictly restricted and shall only be permitted on case to case basis upon approval from the Office of District Magistrate.

Port services will continue to operate as usual and both essential and non-essential cargo can be moved in and out of port, as per requirement for loading/unloading/clearing of cargo and the same shall be permitted till 10 pm only. e-Passes for operation of cargo movement after 10 pm needs to be obtained, which shall be strictly permitted on case to case basis by the Office of the District Magistrate.

Construction activities shall be permitted till 10 pm. Construction activities of national importance and strategic projects beyond 10 pm shall be permitted with prior permission of District Magistrate and e-Passes needs to be obtained, which shall be strictly permitted on case to case basis by the Office of the District Magistrate.

Movement of persons involved with Hotels/Restaurants and Mess for home delivery of food shall be allowed till 10 pm. Dine-in shall be permitted between 6 am to 10 pm only with strict adherence of COVID appropriate behaviourslike wearing of mask, social distancing, cough etiquettes etc. shall have to be scrupulously observed. Provision of thermal scanning and use of hand wash and sanitizers will be mandatory. However, take away/parcel service and home delivery should be encouraged. It shall be the sole responsibility of the owner/In-Charge of the shop/business establishment to ensure its compliance and he/she shall be held responsible for any violation and shall be liable to be fined to the tune of Rs.50,000/- in addition to sealing of the shop/establishment for a period of 14 days by the Executive Magistrate and shall also be liable for action under DM Act.

Public Transport/Buses shall be allowed to ply with strict adherence to the SOPs issued in this regard by the Transport department. Sale and service of liquor at licensed premises shall be permitted till 10 pm. SOPs and orders regarding the timings for sale and service of liquor at all licensed establishments (C, CI, B1, B2, B3 and B4 category) issued by the Deputy Commissioner (Excise), South Andaman should be strictly adhered to

All Parks/ Playgrounds/ Stadiums/Gyms and yoga institutes shall be permitted till 10 pm with strict adherence of COVID appropriate behaviours like wearing of mask, social distancing, cough etiquettes etc. shall have to be scrupulously observed. Any person violating the above directions shall be liable for fine to the tune of Rs.1,000/-, whereas the organisation shall be fined to the tune of Rs.25,000/-.

All Religious places/places of worship are allowed to open till 10 pm with strict adherence of COVID appropriate behaviours like wearing of mask, social distancing, cough etiquettes etc. shall have to be scrupulously observed. Provision of thermal scanning and use of hand wash and sanitizers will be mandatory. The Management Committee of the religious places shall be responsible to ensure strict compliance of the COVID appropriate behaviours and any violations in this regard shall be liable for fine to the tune of Rs.25,000/- payable by the Committee. Religious places/places of worship in containment zones shall remain closed. Only those outside containment zones will be allowed to open up. No tribal passes will be issued for southern group of islands till further orders except for official purposes/national importance and strategic projects.

Social gatherings shall be allowed with strict adherence of COVID appropriate behaviours like wearing of mask, social distancing, cough etiquettes etc. shall have to be scrupulously observed. Provision of thermal scanning and use of hand wash and sanitizers will be mandatory. The parties concerned and management committee of the Hall/Hotel shall be responsible to ensure strict compliance of the COVID appropriate behaviours and any violations in this regard shall be liable for fine to the tune of Rs.50,000/-.

Theatres shall be permitted to function with strict adherence of COVID appropriate behaviours like wearing of mask, social distancing, cough etiquettes etc. shall have to be scrupulously observed. Provision of thermal scanning and use of hand wash and sanitizers will be mandatory. The owner of the theatre shall be liable for fine to the tune of Rs.50,000/-, in case of any violations. Academic congregations shall be allowed with strict adherence of COVID appropriate behaviours like wearing of mask, social distancing, cough etiquettes etc. shall have to be scrupulously observed. Provision of thermal scanning and use of hand wash and sanitizers will be mandatory. The Owner/Proprietor of the academic institutions/coaching centre shall be responsible to ensure strict compliance of the COVID appropriate behaviours and any violations in this regard shall be liable for fine to the tune of Rs.50,000/-. SOPs in this regard shall be issued by concerned department.

Indoor sports activities shall be allowed with no spectators and strict adherence of COVID appropriate behaviours like wearing of mask, social distancing, cough etiquettes etc. shall have to be scrupulously observed. Provision of thermal scanning and use of hand wash and sanitizers will be mandatory. The management of the indoor facility shall be responsible to ensure strict compliance and any violations of the directions shall be liable for fine to the tune of Rs.25,000/-. SOPs in this regard shall be issued by concerned Department.

e-pass for emergency movement during restricted timings may be submitted online on https://epass.andaman.gov.in. The applicants/organizations submitting applications for e-pass should invariably submit valid and clear supporting documents, failing which the application will be summarily rejected.

In view of the emergent circumstances, this order is being issued ex-parte and is addressed to the public in general. Further, the Superintendent of Police/Sub-Divisional Magistrate/Executive Magistrates and all authorities concerned shall ensure strict compliance of this order and shall adequately inform and sensitize the field functionaries to note that these restrictions fundamentally relate to movement of people, but not to that of essential services.

Any disobedience of the above orders shall invite penal action u/s 188 of Indian Penal Code, 1860 and the relevant provisions of the Disaster Management Act, 2005 against the violator (s) and fine shall also be imposed as per Order issued by this office from time to time. This order has come into effect from 26 th September, 2021 and shall remain in force till further orders.

Each State Association is allowed to nominate two boys and two girls from each district for this programme spread over 6 days. In case, players from any district fails to fill its quota, the vacancies so caused will be filled from other Districts as per the merit. 


