'Mann Ki Baat' programme

PM urges everyone to take part in the annual 'Poshan Maah' to be observed next month to eradicate malnutrition

New Delhi, Aug. 28 Prime Minister, Shri Narendra Modi has stressed that efforts for social awareness play an important role in tackling malnutrition and urged everyone to join campaign to fight it. Addressing the nation through his 'Mann Ki Baat' programme in All India Radio today, Shri Modi gave the example of an interesting project being run in Bongaigaon of Assam. It is named Project 'Sampoorna'. The purpose of this project is to fight against malnutrition. Under this unique initiative, the mother of a healthy

child from an Anganwadi Center meets the mother of a malnourished child every week and discusses nutrition related information. With the help of this project, in this region, malnutrition has been eradicated in more than 90 percent children in the past one year.

Prime Minister said that under the 'Mera Bachha' campaign, song and music are being used to tackle malnutrition in Datia district of Madhya Pradesh. Under this, bhajan-kirtans are organized in the district, in which teachers are called

nutrition gurus. A Matka programme is also held, in which women bring a handful of grains to the Anganwadi Center and a Balhooj is organized on Saturdays.

The Prime Minister stated that September is dedicated to festivals as well as a big campaign related to nutrition. He said, Poshan Maah is celebrated every year from 1st to 30th of September.

Prime Minister

pointed out that better use of technology and also public participation has become an important part of Poshan Abhiyaan. From providing mobile devices to millions of Anganwadi workers in the country, a Poshan Tracker has also been launched to monitor the accessibility of Anganwadi services. In all the Aspirational Districts and the States of the North East, 14 to 18 year old girls have

also been brought under the purview of the POSHAN Abhiyaan.

The United Nations has passed a resolution declaring the year 2023 as the International Year of Millets. Shri Modi exuded pride that this proposal of India was accepted by more than 70 countries. He said that the popularity of millet is rising across the world.

The Prime Minister said that when Heads of State come to India, he endeavors to get dishes made from the millets of India in the banquets. He added that foreign dignitaries have relished them and also

try to collect a lot of information about these coarse grains. He said, millets have been a part of India's Agriculture, Culture, and Civilization since ancient times. Millets are mentioned in the Vedas, and also mentioned Purananuru and Tolkappiyam. Prime Minister emphasised that India is the largest producer of Millet in the world and therefore, the responsibility of making this initiative a success also rests on the shoulders of Indians. He said it has to be made into a mass movement, and

Guidelines for availing benefit under Pradhan Mantri Matru Vandana Yojana revised

Provides partial compensation for wage loss in terms of cash incentives

Port Blair, Aug. 28 The Pradhan Mantri Matru Vandana Yojana (PMMVY) - a maternity benefit programme is being implemented by the Ministry of Women and Child Development. It is a conditional cash transfer scheme for pregnant and lactating women of 19 years of age or above for the first live birth. The objective of PMMVY is to provide cash incentive for partial compensation for the wage loss so that the women can take adequate rest before and after delivery of the first child, and to improve health seeking behaviour



amongst the Pregnant Women & Lactating Mothers (PW&LM). The scheme also seeks to promote positive behavioural change towards girl child by providing additional cash incentive for the second child, if that is a girl child.

The benefit is available to a woman for the first two living children provided the second child is a girl. In case

second child, registration during pregnancy shall be mandatory. This would contribute to improve the Sex Ratio at birth and prevent female foeticide.

Further, all pregnant women and lactating mothers, in regular employment with the Central Government or the State Governments or PSUs or those who are in receipt of similar benefits under any law for the time being in force shall not be entitled to benefits under PMMVY.

Kisan Credit Card scheme providing timely credit support to farmers

Rs.23.13 crores disbursed by Banks under KCC scheme in A&N Islands

Port Blair, Aug. 28 Under the Kisan Credit Card scheme, different banks functioning in South Andaman has sanctioned loan to 8509 applicants since April 2021 onwards. The maximum number of beneficiaries was covered by the State Bank of India, A&N State Co-operative Bank and Canara Bank (e-Syndicate) till June, 2022.

The highest number of applications was received in the Agriculture Sector, of



which, loan was sanctioned to 7415 applicants amounting to Rs. 19.72 crore. Similarly, in the Animal Husbandry

Sector, loan was sanctioned to 520 applicants amounting to Rs. 1.42 crores while in Fisheries Sector, loan amount of Rs.

1.99 crores was sanctioned to 574 applicants. The total amount disbursed as loan in KCC scheme stood at Rs.23.13 crores. Despite the COVID-19 pandemic, the Banks ensured timely disbursement of the loan amount to the applicants, Lead Bank sources informed DT.

A & N Pollution Control Committee issues guidelines for Idol Makers & Puja Committees

Port Blair, Aug. 28

Andaman and Nicobar Idol Immersion Rules 2018 were published in the Andaman and Nicobar Gazette No. 23 dated 05-03-2018 in compliance of Hon'ble National Green Tribunal order dated 06-10-2017 in O.A 51/ 2016/EZ. The Rules framed covers the general guidelines idol making, ban on use of synthetic colors, height of super structures and idols.

In this connection, Chairman, A & N Pollution Control Committee, Shri Ankit Yadav, IAS has issued a Public Notice directing all the Idol Makers and Puja Committees to follow certain guidelines.

The guidelines are as follows:

> Idols should be made from natural materials as described in the holy scripts. Use of traditional clay for

idol making rather than baked clay, Plaster of Paris (POP) etc. shall be encouraged, allowed and promoted.

> There shall be a complete ban on the use of POP in idol making till it is established that the POP has no negative impact on the water quality and aquatic bio-diversity.

> Painting of idols should be discouraged. In case idols are to be painted, water soluble and non-toxic natural dyes are to be used.

> There shall be a complete ban on the use of synthetic colour for painting of idols that would require immersion as part of final ritual of the festival.

> The height of the super structure of the idol shall be less than 40 ft. and the idol also shall not exceed 20 ft in height.

> Materials used in

worship like flowers, vastras (clothes), decorative materials (made of paper and plastic) etc. should be removed before immersion of idols. Biodegradable materials should be collected separately for recycling or composting at designated sites whereas the non-biodegradable materials should be collected separately for disposal in sanitary landfills or as prescribed by the local Municipal Authority or local body. Clothes may be sent to local orphanage(s).

> Idol Immersion should be done between low tide line and high tide line (irrespective of its depth) in a identified places with permission of District Administration only.

> Single use plastic should not be used during celebration.

Partnership Firms/ Farmer Producers Organization (FPOs)/NGOs/ SHG's/ Co-operatives/ Pvt. Ltd. Companies who have established or propose to establish micro food processing unit.

The scheme is implemented through the District Resource Persons engaged for each district to provide handholding support to micro-food processing enterprises including assistance in preparation of Detailed Project Report, documentation and getting bank loan.

The modified eligibility criteria to avail the benefits are as under:

> Existing or New micro food processing enterprises for expansion/ upgradation of existing micro food processing enterprises or setting up of new micro food processing enterprises.
> Beneficiary contribution should be minimum 10% of the project cost.
> Applicant should be above 18 years of age.
> Applicant/ enterprise those who have availed bank loan under other Subsidy Linked Scheme of Govt. are also eligible for bank loan under this scheme. Applicants are also eligible for Interest subvention and Top-up convergence with other relevant Government Sponsored scheme.
> Applicants/ Entrepreneurs of existing units under stress and qualifying for restructuring by the banks are also eligible for up-gradation / expansion of the unit.
