

## Cabinet approves declaration of 15<sup>th</sup> November as Janjatiya Gaurav Divas

### Week long celebrations planned from Nov. 15 to 22 to commemorate glorious history of tribal people, culture & achievements

New Delhi, Nov. 10 (PIB)

The Union Cabinet, chaired by the Prime Minister, Shri Narendra Modi, today approved declaration of 15<sup>th</sup> November as Janjatiya Gaurav Divas dedicated to the memory of brave tribal freedom fighters so that coming generations could know about their sacrifices for the country. India's freedom struggle was strengthened by several movements by tribal

communities such as Santhals, Tamars, Kols, Bhils, Khasis and Mizos to name a few. The revolutionary movements and struggles organized by the tribal communities were marked by their immense courage and supreme sacrifice. Tribal movements in different regions of the country against the British colonial rule got linked with the national freedom struggle and inspired Indians all

over the country. However, the public at large is not much aware about these tribal heroes. Pursuant to the speech of Hon'ble Prime Minister on Independence Day of 2016, Government of India has sanctioned 10 tribal freedom fighter museums across the country.

The date is the birth anniversary of Sri Birsa Munda who is revered as Bhagwan by tribal communities across the

country. Birsa Munda fought bravely against the exploitative system of the British colonial system and spearheaded movement against British oppression giving a call for 'Ulgulan' (Revolution). The declaration acknowledges the glorious history and cultural heritage of tribal communities. The day will be celebrated every year and would

## National Achievement Survey - 2021 to be conducted on Nov. 12

### Survey to assess grade specific competencies achieved by students of Grades 3, 5, 8 & 10 in sampled schools in all three districts of A&N Islands

Port Blair, Nov. 10

The Government of India has been implementing a rolling programme of sample based National Achievement Survey (NAS) aimed at classes III, V, VIII and X with a cycle period of three years. NAS will be held on 12<sup>th</sup> November, 2021 across the country, which will help to assess the learning interruptions and new learnings during the COVID pandemic and help to take remedial

measures.

Accordingly, the National Achievement Survey-2021 will be conducted in Andaman and Nicobar Islands on Nov. 12 in Govt. Schools, Govt. Aided, Private recognized and Central Govt. Schools. The survey will assess the grade specific competencies achieved by students of Grades 3, 5, 8 and 10 in sampled schools and students in all the three districts of the Islands.

In this regard, all the

parents

and stakeholders have been requested to extend their cooperation by sending their wards to attend the National Achievement Survey 2021.

It is expected that nearly 1.23 lakh schools and 38 lakh students in 733 districts across 36 States and UTs will be covered in the NAS 2021. NAS will be conducted in Language, Mathematics & EVS for class 3 & 5; Language, Mathematics, Science & Social Science for class 8

and

Language, Mathematics, Science, Social Science and English for class 10. The Test would be conducted in 22 mediums of instruction covering Assamese, Bengali, English, Gujarati, Hindi, Kannada, Malayalam, Manipuri, Marathi, Mizo, Odiya, Punjabi, Tamil, Telugu, Urdu, Bodo, Garo, Khasi, Konkani, Nepali, Bhutia, and Lepcha. ## Ration card holders advised to get their Aadhaar number seeded with ration card data base by this December

Port Blair, Nov. 10

The Govt. of India has inter alia requested individual beneficiaries under NFSA to furnish proof of Aadhaar number or undergo Aadhaar authentication to receive subsidies under NFSA. The Department of Civil Supplies & Consumer Affairs has been repeatedly informing and requesting the ration card holders through press releases

and Fair Price Shop dealers from time to time to get their Aadhaar number seeded with the ration card data base. Many ration card beneficiaries have still not got their Aadhaar number seeded with the ration cards. Hence, it is once again requested to all the NFSA (PHH&AAY) card holders to get their as well as their family member's Aadhaar seeded in the ration card

database through their respective Circle Office of Civil Supplies & Consumer Affairs Department and its subordinate Supply Units functioning in outer Islands by December, 2021.

All the beneficiaries have been made aware that with implementation of 'One Nation One Ration Card' in this UT, no ration card holder will be able to

Showing zero tolerance towards illegal constructions and encroachments on Govt. land, the A&N Administration is adopting a strict measure and has appealed to the general public to report/inform/bring to the notice of the Administration regarding such activities.

Meanwhile, taking strict enforcement action against encroachers as directed by Deputy Commissioner (N&MA), Smti. Anjali Sehrawat, a team of Revenue Department Officials attached to Diglipur tehsil carried out an encroachment eviction drive at Dosh Bandhu Gram today under the supervision of Shri Ankit Yadav, Assistant Commissioner, Diglipur.

As per revenue



records, the land bearing survey no: 1/1 measuring area 44.82 ha is recorded in favour of Govt. Revenue Deptt. in form 'AM' of DB Gram as Grazing land. Out of

which, 0.30 ha land was encroached and used for banana, arecanut, coconut plantation. During eviction drive, all plantation and temporary thatched

bamboo hut were removed and 3000 Sq. mtr land was restored into government account. Similar encroachment eviction drive will be carried out

in other villages under North and Middle Andaman as well in the coming days, a press release from Assistant Commissioner (Diglipur) said.

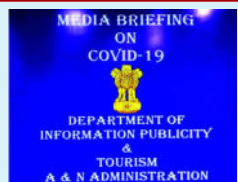

## Media briefed on COVID-19

### No positive case detected during test conducted on incoming flight & inter-island bound passengers: Director (IP&T)

Port Blair, Nov. 10

The Director (IP&T), Shri Alok Kumar addressing media persons on COVID-19 status in the conference hall of IP&T here today stated that during the RT-PCR test conducted on 540 passengers who arrived here yesterday, no positive case has been detected. Today, 11 flights with 1869 passengers arrived, out of which, 1279 were vaccinated with both doses while RT-PCR test



was conducted on 590 passengers and the reports are awaited. RAT was conducted on 352 passengers bound for North & Middle Andaman at Ferrargunj and no positive case has been detected. At Mohanpura Bus Terminus, test was conducted on 114

passengers and all were found negative. At helipad, RAT was conducted on 8 passengers and all were found negative. Today, till 3 pm, 646 beneficiaries were vaccinated, out of which, 605 were in the age group of 18-44.

The Director, ANIIMS, Dr. AK Mandal informed that presently, 2 COVID patients are undergoing treatment at GB Pant Hospital and no patient is on oxygen/ventilator.

## Union Cabinet approves restoration and continuation of MPLADS

The Union Cabinet on Wednesday approved restoration and continuation of Member of Parliament Local Area Development Scheme (MPLADS) which was discontinued in view of COVID-19 pandemic.

Briefing media in New Delhi today, Information and Broadcasting Minister, Shri Anurag Thakur said, the funds will be released at the rate of two crore rupees per MP for remaining period of Financial Year

## Ministry of Fisheries, Animal Husbandry & Dairying approves standardized designs for construction / procurement of deep sea fishing vessels under PMMSY

### Fisheries Deptt. urges interested beneficiaries to approach nearest Zonal Fisheries Office for availing subsidy

Port Blair, Nov. 10

The Ministry of Fisheries, Animal Husbandry and Dairying, Department of Fisheries, Govt. of India has communicated Standard Operating Procedures (SOP), modalities of implementation and approved three types of standardized designs for construction / procurement of deep sea fishing vessels developed by the Cochín Shipyard Limited (CSL) under Pradhan Mantri Matsya Sampada Yojana (PMMSY).

Under this scheme,

Govt. of India is providing subsidy assistance @ 40% for General category and 60% for Women and ST category with maximum ceiling of unit cost Rs. 120 lakhs.

The implementation of the scheme is through respective District Level Committees (DLC) of South Andaman, North and Middle Andaman and Nicobar District.

The approved models for construction / procurement of deep sea fishing vessels are C-BOSS 40:40m3 fish holding capacity of unit cost Rs. 120 lakhs; C-

BOSS 70:70 m3 fish holding capacity of unit cost Rs.135 lakhs with refrigeration facilities; C-BOSS 70:70 m3 fish holding capacity with unit cost of Rs.150 lakhs.

The Government assistance will be limited for the unit cost of Rs. 120 lakh as per the prevailing Operational Guidelines of PMMSY irrespective of the aforesaid models.

The detailed drawing and designs for above mentioned models are available with various Offices of Department of Fisheries. The beneficiary has to construct the deep sea

fishing vessels from any fishing vessel building yard empanelled by Andaman and Nicobar Administration and the empanelled yards should use any of the three standardized designs for building the deep sea fishing vessels. The Andaman and Nicobar Administration is in the process of floating Expression of Interest for empanelling the boat building yards and the list of building yards will be communicated after finalizing the qualifying yards.

## Vaccination drive in A&N Islands

**5,13,382 doses of vaccines administered to beneficiaries so far**  
**73.72 percent population inoculated**

Port Blair, Nov. 10

Vaccination drive is being smoothly conducted in A&N Islands. Due to the vigorous effort made by the Health Department, the number of cumulative beneficiaries vaccinated so far in A&N Islands has reached 5,13,382 doses thereby taking the percentage of

population vaccinated in isles to 73.72.

A total of 2041 people were vaccinated today in A&N Islands. 1566 beneficiaries were vaccinated in South Andaman District, out of which, 91 beneficiaries were in the age group of 18-44 years. Similarly, 308 beneficiaries were vaccinated in North & Middle Andaman

District, out of which, 11 beneficiaries were in the age group of 18-44. 167 beneficiaries were vaccinated in Nicobar District, out of which, 1 beneficiary was in the age group of 18-44. A total of 1,74,127 eligible people in the age group of 18 to 44 years have been vaccinated till date, a press release from DHS said.

## BESAN SUJI PANCAKE

| Ingredients                                 | Quantity                    |
|---|-----------------------------|
| Besan (gram flour)                          | - 1 cup                     |
| Suji/Rawa (semolina)                        | - 2 cups                    |
| Butter milk                                 | - Sufficient to make batter |
| Capsicum (or any other vegetable of choice) | 1                           |
| Onion                                       | - 1                         |
| Garlic                                      | - 4 cloves                  |
| Ginger                                      | - 1 inch piece              |
| Tomato                                      | - 1                         |
| Green chili                                 | - 1                         |
| Coriander leaves                            | - 2-3                       |
| Ghee/oil                                    | - For spreading on pan      |

Total quantity: 4 pieces

**Method of preparation**  
Mix gram flour and suji with butter milk and make a batter. Keep the mixture for 15 minutes. Cut all the vegetables in small pieces and make a paste of ginger and garlic. Mix the vegetables and ginger garlic paste in the batter. Heat the pan and spread 1 spoon oil over it, pour the batter on heated pan and spread it evenly. Once cooked from one side then reverse and cook properly from both the sides.

**Health benefits**  
This pancake is good for heart patients and diabetics. Vegetables and spices added in the recipe make it easy for digestion. It will also help in weight loss if taken in moderate quantity.


## SESAME CHUTNEY

Besan suji pancake may be eaten with sesame chutney prepared as per following recipe.

| Ingredients         | Quantity      |
|---------------------|---------------|
| Black sesame        | - 6 spoon     |
| Coriander leaves    | - 1 bowl      |
| Garlic              | - 6 cloves    |
| Black pepper powder | - 1 spoon     |
| Lemon juice         | - 5 spoon     |
| Cumin seeds         | - 1 spoon     |
| Peanut (optional)   | - 2 spoon     |
| Salt                | - As per need |
| Sugar               | - 1 spoon     |
| Water               | - As per need |

**Method of preparation**  
Roast the Sesame on low flame. Do not over heat or burn it, mix all the ingredients and grind it.

**Health benefits**
