Restriction on timing of visiting beaches reverted to pre-COVID-19 timings

Tourists/ public should follow COVID-19 Appropriate Behaviour

Port Blair, Nov. 18

In view of the steady decline in cases of COVID-19 in Andaman & Nicobar Islands, the SOPs issued earlier dt. 03.08.2021 has been amended with immediate effect in South Andaman and N&M Andaman Districts. As per the amended SOP, the 50% carrying capacity of tourists ferrying boat has been removed and now, the boat can operate with full capacity. Similarly, restriction on timing of visiting beaches has been reverted to pre-COVID-19

timings.

However, even after the above changes, the tourists/public should continue to follow COVID-19 Appropriate Behaviour as issued by the A&N Administration and Govt. of India from time to time.

Any other orders or advisories issued by Govt. of India, A&N Administration or any other Competent Authority will also have to be followed, a press release from Directorate of IP&T said.

Vaccination drive in A&N Islands

5,29,919 doses of vaccines administered to beneficiaries so far

3551 people vaccinated in a single day

Port Blair, Nov. 18

Vaccination drive to vaccinate maximum number of eligible beneficiaries of 18 above age group in the entire Island Territory is continuing smoothly. Due to the vigorous effort made by the Health Department, the number of cumulative doses of vaccines administered to beneficiaries so far in A&N Islands has reached 5,29,919.

A total of 3551 people were vaccinated today in A&N Islands. 3032

beneficiaries were vaccinated in South Andaman District, out of which, 92 beneficiaries were in the age group of 18-44 years. Similarly, 485 beneficiaries were vaccinated in North & Middle Andaman District, out of which, 6 beneficiaries were in the age group of 18-44. 34 beneficiaries were vaccinated in Nicobar District. A total of 1,74,791 eligible people in the age group of 18 to 44 years have been vaccinated till date, a press release from DHS said.

In view of the decrease in COVID-19 cases, the existing SOPs issued by Directorate of IP&T, A&N Administration in respect of National Memorial Cellular Jail including its Museums and Light and Sound Show has been revised.

Accordingly, the timing of Museums in Cellular Jail will be from 9 am to 12.30 pm & 1 pm

to 4 pm. The 1st show of Sound & Light will be held from 5.20 pm to 6.15 pm (Hindi all days) while the 2nd show will be held from 6.30 pm to 7.25 pm (Hindi all days) followed by the 3rd show from 7.35 pm to 8.30 pm (English on Monday, Wednesday & Friday) and (Hindi on Tuesday, Thursday, Saturday & Sunday).

As per the revised SOP, there will be no cap

on the number of visitors. However, the visitors have to follow COVID Appropriate Behaviours. Any other Orders or Advisories issued by the Govt. of India, A&N Administration or any other Competent Authority will also have to be followed, a press release from Director (IP&T/Art & Culture) said.

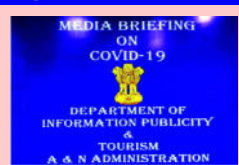


Media briefed on COVID-19

Farmers' Corner- A Knowledge Hub

Andaman local pig

Andaman local pig, also known as Andaman desi pig, is an indigenous pig germplasm of Andaman and Nicobar Islands and is distributed in different islands of Andaman group of islands. They are reared by the local farmers since time immemorial. As per latest census, total population of this breed is 8700 with 1450 number of breedable males and 2130 number of breedable females. They are sturdy and medium in size and black (mostly) or brownish in colour. Neck and back portion hairs are very thick as well as long whereas hairs on the sides and flank regions are shorter and thinner relatively. The most commonly observed feature is slightly downward arch/curvature of the back (low back). They attain body weight of 60-75 kg for male and 55-65 kg for female at 1 year of age under field condition. Height ranges from 65 to 89 cm. Average adult body lengths for male and female are 115.80 ± 2.05 cm and 104.60 ± 1.28 cm respectively. Snout is short to medium with slight concave type. Ears are short and erected upwards (no hanging ears). Litter size at farrowing ranges from 6-13. They are fast runners and evolved to thrive under low-input management system of Andaman group of islands. Molecular study indicated high genetic diversity of the breed which is indicative of strong ability of the breed to adapt to environmental changes and withstand impending climate change. ICAR-Central Island Agricultural Research Institute, Port Blair and Department of Animal Husbandry and Veterinary Services, A&N Administration maintain and propagate the pure germplasm of Andaman local pig.

Benefit: This pig breed is very much adapted to the local microenvironment of Andaman and has the ability to withstand impending climate change.

Out of the total vaccination, more than 75 crore 99 lakh vaccine doses have been given as first dose while over 39 crore 15 lakh doses have been administered as second dose. Health Ministry said that more than 65 lakh vaccine doses were



administered till 7 PM today. As part of the National wide Vaccination Drive, the Centre has been supporting the States and Union Territories by providing them COVID vaccines free of cost.

Partial lunar eclipse to take place today

New Delhi, Nov. 18

The partial lunar eclipse that will take place on tomorrow (Nov. 19) will be the longest since the one that occurred in the 15th century. The one to take place this month will span over six hours. The eclipse will begin between 6.02 and 12.30 UTC (11.30 am to 5.33 pm IST). This occurrence takes place when the Sun, Earth and



Moon will come into alignment forming a partial lunar eclipse.

The partial lunar eclipse won't be visible in most parts of the country, except Arunachal Pradesh and

Assam. Some parts of the US, Northern Europe, East Asia, Australia, and the Pacific Ocean region will be able to experience the event.

The National Aeronautics and Space Administration (NASA) had earlier mentioned that this century will experience a total of 228 lunar eclipses - with a maximum of three lunar eclipses per year.
