# Policy matters on Narcotics Drugs & Psychotropic Substances discussed

## Steps initiated by A&N Administration to combat drug trafficking in Isles highlighted

Port Blair, May 9

A meeting of Apex Committee at the Central Govt. Level under the Chairmanship of Union Home Secretary, Shri Ajay Kumar Bhalla was held on May 5 to monitor drug trafficking situation in the country including A&N Islands. The Chief Secretary, A&N Administration, Shri Jitendra Narain and senior officers of A&N Administration attended the meeting.

During the meeting, various issues of coordination between the Central Govt. and States/UTs regarding the policy matters on Narcotics Drugs & Psychotropic Substances were discussed.

In the meeting, the Home Secretary stated that a dedicated Anti-Narcotics Task Force (ANTF) headed by an ADGP/IGP



with sufficient manpower capable of handling the drugs trafficking and abuse scenario in States and A & N Islands needs to be established. Advanced screening scanners at Airport & Seaport will be installed for detection of suspicious cargo and identification of drugs.

It was also informed that list of habitual drug peddlers is being maintained at PS CCS and the staffs are being regularly briefed to keep vigil over the drug peddlers and their activities.

For effective Narcotics tracking, 3 sniffer dogs have been deployed at Airport & Seaport on as and

when required basis.

Apart from this, a Narcotics App is being developed by NIC whereby anybody can report any suspicious activity/ person regarding drugs to the police. The App has categories to report about illegal activities viz. Shipment Coming/Going of Drugs; Storage of Drugs; Usages of Drugs; Selling of Drugs; Promoting Drugs and anything related to drugs.

Meanwhile, in detection cases of drugs, suitable rewards proposals for informers & Govt. Servants will be moved.

To check drugs trafficking, staff is being deputed for maintaining surveillance in vulnerable areas like around hotels, airport, seaport, educational institutions, tuition centers, courier service

## Vaccination drive in A&N Islands

### 11952 beneficiaries in the age group of 12 to 14 yrs vaccinated so far

The vaccination drive is continuing smoothly in A&N Islands. As per data available, a total of 6,77,614 doses of vaccine have been administered to beneficiaries in the age group of 18 and above so far. Similarly, 23,454 beneficiaries have been vaccinated in the age group of 15 to 18 yrs and 11,952 beneficiaries have been vaccinated in the age group of 12 to 14 yrs. The number of beneficiaries

### Facilitating proof of marriages: Long pending demand to get marriages registered at respective places fulfilled

### Benefits applicable to Hindus, Buddhists, Jains & Sikhs

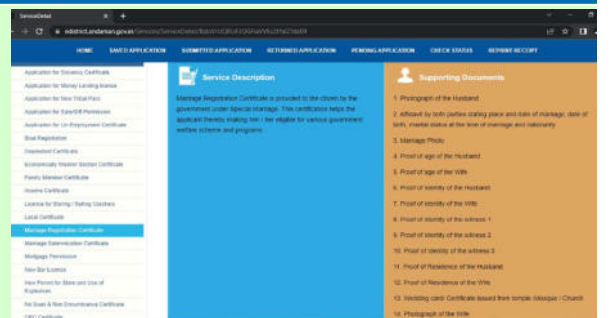
Port Blair, May 9

Under the able guidance of the Chief Secretary, Shri Jitendra Narain, the A&N Administration is continuously in pursuit to make the services being offered by the Administration citizen friendly. Until now, the Officers were designated as Registrars under the Special Marriage Act, 1954, as such no marriages were being registered under the Hindu Marriage Act, 1955.

In this connection, the A&N Administration vide its notification dated 5<sup>th</sup> May, 2022 in pursuance of the provisions of clause (d) of Rule 2 of the Andaman and Nicobar Islands Hindu Marriage Registration Rules, 1958, and supersession of the Administration's Notification No.AN/HMRR/2(d)/1/58 dt. 31<sup>st</sup> July 1958, has appointed the following Officers as Registrars for the purpose of said rules to exercise jurisdiction in the areas specified against each of them with immediate effect:-

With the publication of the above notification, the long pending demand of large section of the general public in these Islands to get their marriages registered under the



Hindu Marriage Act, 1955, at their respective places has been fulfilled. The above arrangement has been put to place for the purpose of facilitating proof of Hindu marriages. The benefits of registration of marriages under this Act is also applicable to all Hindus, Buddhists, Jains and Sikhs.

As of now all marriages were solemnised/registered under Special Marriage Act, 1954, wherein the intending parties have to wait for a period of 30 days as notice period calling for claims and objections. In sharp contrast to this provision, now, under Hindu Marriage Act, 1955, married people residing within the jurisdiction of the Registrar for the local area for a period of not less than thirty days immediately preceding the date of application for marriage registration are eligible to apply for registration and the same shall be done without any delay, a press release from Deputy Commissioner (SA) said.

agencies etc. To identify drug addict and sensitize prisoners/jail staff on ill-effect of drug usage, de-addiction camp is being organized. Surprise inspections are also being done by IG and Supdt. of Jail to identify usage of contraband and psychotropic substances in Jail premises.

For creating awareness on ill effects of drugs and psychotropic substances, 40 health awareness programmes were conducted from February 2022 to till date in association with Social Welfare Department & Education Department in Schools, Colleges and community on the tagline 'Say Yes To Life, No To Drugs' throughout A&N Islands. 150 drug addicted patients attended the de-addiction programme held during January 2022 to till date.

In addition to this, Drug Inspectors have been deputed to inspect Retail Drug Shops randomly. Regular awareness/discussion about the ill effects of drugs and substance abuse to sensitize parent/guardians are being conducted during the School Management Committee (SMC)/Parent Teacher Meeting.

## Govt. working holistically in health sector with synergy between preventive health care, modern medical facilities : Health Minister

New Delhi, May 9 Union Health Minister, Dr. Mansukh Mandaviya has said that the Government is working holistically in the health sector with synergy between preventive health care and modern medical facilities. 
