

## Lt Governor addresses Islanders on the eve of 73<sup>rd</sup> Republic Day Outlines major developmental projects and achievements made under different sectors in A&N Islands

Port Blair, Jan. 25

*The Hon'ble Lt Governor, A&N Islands, Admiral D K Joshi, PVSM, AVSM, YSM, NM, VSM (Retd.) while addressing the Islanders on the eve of 73<sup>rd</sup> Republic Day which was broadcast over All India Radio and telecast on DDK Port Blair, has extended his heartiest congratulations and best wishes to all the Islanders on the occasion. Paying tributes to the freedom fighters and the framers of the Constitution, the Lt Governor said due to their sacrifices and tireless efforts, India as a strong democratic Republic is progressing towards a self-reliant and vibrant future.*

The Lt Governor stated that the fight against COVID is continuing and to further tackle COVID-19, 3 PSA Plants of 2000 LPM capacity has been installed in GB Pant Hospital while two 500 LPM capacity PSA Plants have been installed one each in CHC Diglipur in North and Middle Andaman and BJR Hospital, Car Nicobar. In North & Middle Andaman and Nicobar Districts, both doses of COVID vaccination have been administered to beneficiaries and 6,29,722 eligible persons have been vaccinated so far. Currently, the vaccination of 15-18 yrs. beneficiaries and Precautionary third dose vaccination for eligible beneficiaries is continuing.

The Lt Governor mentioned that despite COVID-19 challenges, the development and welfare oriented activities are continuing in these Islands. He said that during the visit of the Hon'ble Home Minister, Shri Amit Shah in the month of October, 2021, many projects have been inaugurated while foundation stone for several other projects were laid.

Outlining the various initiatives and developmental projects taken up in the Islands, the Lt Governor informed that under the Islands

Development Agency (IDA) projects phase-I, the RFQ evaluation of the PPP Eco-Tourism Resorts to be developed with an estimated investment of Rs. 660 crores in Long, Aves, Smith Island and Shaheed Dweep is expected to be completed this month. Under Phase-II, the Draft Master Plan for the 11 PPP projects in North/Middle and South Andaman will be completed by March, 2022 by the consultant appointed by NITI Aayog. All these projects are based on ecologically sustainable and international development norms like GRIHA, LEED, GREEN GLOBE and Star Categorization and 60% employment will be reserved for the local youth of these Islands.

The Lt Governor stated that with the completion of the Aerial LiDAR Survey at Port Blair last month, the proposed work for the development of two 'Green Field Airports' in A&N Islands is under progress. There is a proposal for Expression of Interest (EoI) for introducing the services of Sea Planes and Helicopter on 'No Cost No Commitment' (NCNC) basis. To promote tourism and economic growth in the Islands, the VAT on Aviation the Turbine Fuel has been reduced from 10 percent to 1 percent.

The Lt Governor said that the new 'Integrated Terminal Building' of the Port Blair Airport is expected to become operational by September, 2022. The Humphrey Bridge named as 'Azad Hind Fauj Setu' constructed at NH-4 has been inaugurated while another bridge at Middle Strait is expected to be completed by this year. The double laning of NH-4 and the construction of both these bridges will reduce the travel time between Port Blair and Diglipur. The 500 Pax-cum-150 Ton cargo vessel MV 'Sindhu' is providing its services while another vessel MV 'Nalanda' of similar capacity is expected to join the shipping fleet soon.

The Lt Governor said that in-principle approval for seafarers holding Near Coastal Voyage (NCV) Certificate of competency to travel to South East Asian Countries has been received and a multilateral agreement with these countries is expected shortly. The initiative of introducing Electric AC Buses 'Go Go' (Get On-Get Off) in Port Blair has fetched us the award for excellence in urban transport under the 'City with Best Green Transport Initiatives' category and for which, the Lt Governor has congratulated everyone. He further

stated that with the implementation of CANI Submarine Cable project, the peak mobile data has increased to 2.4 Gbps and the daily mobile data to 24 TB. Under the Prime Minister Wifi Access Network Interface (PMWANI), 14 Wifi hotspot have been made available in various places, the Lt Governor remarked. The Lt Governor informed that for the exploration of offshore Oil and Natural Gas in A&N Islands, the Oil India Limited has started Seismic Survey in two offshore blocks. He said, the 6.6 MLD capacity Rutland Water Supply Project has been completed and the trial run of this project was done successfully.

Under the Smart City Mission, the Lt Governor said, machines and STP has been procured for Solid Waste and Sewage Management. Apart from this, work for several infrastructural development projects such as water supply and sewerage system, Integrated Command and Control Centre, Heritage Circuit (Patriot Walk) etc. are under progress at an approximate cost of Rs. 353 crores. The work for the Marina Walkway is also progressing rapidly.

The Lt Governor stated that these Islands secured the first position in implementation of P M - S V A N i d h i

Scheme in the small States and Union Territory category. Similarly, under Pradhan Mantri Awas Yojana (Urban), 21 dwelling units have been allotted to the beneficiaries, the construction work of which is under progress at Prothrapur and Brookshabad areas. Under the Pradhan Mantri Awas Yojana (Rural), a total of 995 houses have been constructed which includes 63 new houses, he said.

To augment Power Supply, the work for the installation of 0.4 MW DG Set is underway at Swaraj Dweep while the

### 73<sup>rd</sup> Republic Day to be celebrated in A&N Islands today

## Lt Governor to unfurl the National Flag at Netaji Stadium

Port Blair, Jan. 25

Every year on 26<sup>th</sup> January, the Nation celebrates Republic Day with grandeur, gaiety, fervour and enthusiasm. This year too, the Republic Day will be celebrated in a manner befitting the occasion, however with some extra precaution and measures in view of the prevailing COVID-19 situation. In A&N Islands, as per the tradition, the National Flag would be unfurled at all Govt. offices/institutions including schools, dispensaries, post offices etc.

The Hon'ble Lt Governor, A&N Islands, Admiral D K Joshi, PVSM, AVSM, YSM, NM, VSM (Retd.) will grace the function at Netaji Stadium, Port Blair and will unfurl the National Flag at 8.35 am after laying wreath at the 'Martyrs' Column' at the National Memorial - Cellular Jail. The parade and guard of honour will comprise of the armed contingents of the Army,

Navy, Air Force, Coast Guard, A&N Police and also contingents from Fire Brigade and NCC along with their bands. In view of the COVID-19 situation no public or school children will take part in the ceremony.

The repeat telecast of the pre-Republic Day-2022 address of Lt Governor through Doordarshan will be at 8.30 am on Jan. 26.

### Vaccination drive in A&N Islands 6,03,443 doses of vaccines administered to beneficiaries in the age group of 18 and above so far

Port Blair, Jan. 25

The vaccination drive is continuing smoothly in A&N Islands. As per data available, a total of 6,03,443 doses of vaccines have been administered to beneficiaries in the age group of 18 and above so far in A&N Islands. Similarly, 21,921 beneficiaries have been vaccinated in the age group of 15 to 18 years against the target beneficiaries of 23,000. The number of beneficiaries administered precautionary dose of vaccine so far stood at 4764.

A total of 406 eligible beneficiaries were vaccinated in Nicobar A&N Islands today. 320 beneficiaries were

vaccinated in South Andaman District, out of which, 39 beneficiaries were in the age group of 15-18 years, 40 beneficiaries were in the age group of 18-44 years and the number of beneficiaries administered precautionary dose of vaccine stood at 100.

57 beneficiaries were vaccinated in North & Middle Andaman District, out of which, 7 beneficiaries were in the age group of 18-44 years and the number of beneficiaries administered precautionary dose of vaccine stood at 34.

29 beneficiaries were vaccinated in Nicobar District, out of which,

It is notified for the information of the General Public that the following Traffic arrangements have been made for the Main Function of Republic Day on 26<sup>th</sup> Jan. 2022 (Wednesday).

1. The movement of all vehicular traffic shall be closed from 0815 Hrs at the following points.

(i) Raj Niwas to National Memorial Cellular Jail via Old Telephone Exchange, Vikas Bhavan (ANIIDCO), Scouts Huts Crossing, Andaman Club, Y-Narayan Junction and CRPF Barrack.

(ii) Gymkhana Crossing to R. K. Mission via Dharamshala and Girls School Crossing.

(iii) Clock Tower to Dharamshala

(iv) R. K. Mission to Raj Niwas via Machi Line and Murugan Temple.

2. The carcade of Hon'ble Lt. Governor and other special invitees shall be parked inside the Netaji Stadium.

3. After the departure of the Chief Guest from the place of function, the vehicles of the special invitees shall follow the route Scout Hut Junction-Vikas Bhawan-Fire Brigade-Old Telephone Exchange-APWD Crossing to their destinations.

4. The vehicles intending to proceed to South Point from Aberdeen Bazar shall be diverted towards Model School Crossing - Bengali Club - Goalghar- Secretariat Junction - Police Line and Nayagaon.

5. No heavy vehicles including Private and STS buses will be allowed to proceed to Aberdeen Bazar from Gandhi Statue and Bengali Club Junction from 0700 hrs to 0930 hrs.

6. The vehicles intending to proceed to Aberdeen Bazar from South Point shall follow the route of South Point-Shadipur-Nayagaon Junction-Police Line-RBV-Secretariat Junction and Goalghar.

7. Heavy vehicles proceeding to long route shall be diverted to Goal Ghar and Junglighthat from Bengali Club.
