Soon after arrival, the Hon'ble Union Minister will visit the National Memorial Cellular Jail and lay wreath at the Martyrs' Column. He will also visit the cell of Veer Savarkar and pay homage. The Hon'ble Minister will witness a cultural programme as part of 'Azadi Ka Amrit Mahotsav' followed by Sound & Light Show based on patriotic theme. The Union Minister of Home Affairs and Minister of Cooperation, Shri Amit Shah, today laid the foundation stone of the 3<sup>rd</sup> Campus of the National Forensic Science University (NFSU) at Dharbandoda, Goa. The Chief Minister of Goa, Shri Pramod Sawant, Union Minister, Shri Shripad Naik and the Union Home Secretary were present on the occasion among many dignitaries.

The Union Minister of Home Affairs and Minister of Cooperation in his address, remembering the Late Shri Manohar Parrikar, the former Chief Minister of Goa and former Defence Minister of India, said that Parrikar, as the Chief Minister of Goa, began the transformation of the state. Shri Amit Shah said that as the then Defence Minister under the leadership of Prime Minister, Shri Narendra Modi, Shri Manohar Parrikar achieved two important tasks for which the country will always remember him. **Farmers' Corner- A Knowledge Hub**

**Bread fruit -a versatile crop for Bay Islands**

Bread fruit (*Artocarpus altilis*) and Breadnut (*Artocarpus camansi*) are important food crops in several island nations. The different types of these species yield starch rich fruits wherein the bread fruit trees bear seedless fruits and Bread nut trees bear seeded fruits. The fruits can be cooked and eaten at all stages of development. Immature fruits can be sliced and cooked as a vegetable. Matured breadfruit is widely used as boiled, steamed or baked for many recipes. Thinly sliced breadfruit leaving the core is also fried to make chips. Ripe fruits are creamy and sweet and can be eaten raw or used to make pies, cakes, and other desserts. The nutritious seeds in bread nut reported to resemble chestnuts in flavour and texture, and they are boiled, roasted, or ground into meal for consumption. All parts of the plant produce latex which is used for sealing joints and leaking pipes etc. Breadfruit is widely known as an energy-rich food and considered as a good source of carbohydrates, fibre, and minerals such as potassium, calcium, iron, magnesium, phosphorus, manganese, and zinc. The fruits can be sliced, dried, made into powder and stored for long time. The flour from fruit which is categorized as gluten free and could be used for preparation of breads, roti, cakes, biscuits etc with or without addition of other flour. Considering the potential of this crop in the Islands, ICAR-CIARI, Port Blair has located 11 accessions of these for further promotion. The trees commence flowering in about 4 to 5 years after planting. Yield assessment in 10- to 20-year-old trees revealed the average annual fruit yield per tree ranging from 150 to 250 fruits. The trees require lesser management practices, producing an abundance of food with lesser resources, and thrive under a range of island ecological conditions. Breadfruit can be used as an important component in plantation-based agro forestry systems in Islands and can be grown with a wide range of plants. They also give shelter and food to important plant pollinators and seed dispersers such as honeybees, birds, and fruit bats thereby aid to the natural farming of other crops in a harmonious way. **Benefit: The climate and soil in the whole of Andaman and Nicobar Islands is highly suitable for growing these trees. The tree has good potential to be promoted as future potential food crop in Andaman and Nicobar Islands as the presence of these trees would ensure food availability in remote places, possibly provide employment opportunities and reduce the dependency of transported food flour from far off places.** **Contact person with Name, Designation e-mail and phone no: Dr. B. National Forensic Science University. Shri Shah said that the motive behind this is to bring back the dangerous, habitual and new criminals. Shri Amit Shah said that the work of punishing the worst offenders can be done only when the investigations of the cases against them are increased. This is possible only when there is scientific evidence in the hands of the prosecution lawyer appearing in the court. The Union Home Minister said that in our country the forensic science concept was introduced and the university were started, but there was such a shortage of human resources that there was a long queue of cases, due to which cases were pending in court. He said that unless we prepare experts in the field of human resource and forensic science, it is impossible to take it to its height.

Shri Amit Shah said that our goal is to make forensic science investigation compulsory for all the offenses punishable with more than 6 years. For this, a good team and a district level forensic science laboratory will have to be formed within more than 600 districts of the country. He said that for this, at least 30,000 to 40,000 forensic scientists are needed and education is the only way, so he has worked for the establishment of Forensic Science University.

It will then be approved online by the Joint Director (Agriculture) HQ, License Issuing Authority of Seeds. Thereafter, seed License/Renewed License can be generated and downloaded online by the private dealers without visiting the office to get the license, a press release received from Agriculture Deptt. said.

## Vaccination- shield against the virus

## 4,62,189 doses of vaccines administered to beneficiaries in Isles so far

Port Blair, Oct. 14 The vaccination drive is continuing smoothly in A&N Islands. As per data available, a total of 4,62,189 doses of vaccines have been administered to beneficiaries so far in A&N Islands, out of the target beneficiaries of 2,81,603 (approx.). A total of 1487 people were vaccinated today in A&N Islands.

501 beneficiaries were vaccinated in South Andaman District, out of which, 103 beneficiaries were in the age group of 18-44 years. Similarly, 876 beneficiaries were vaccinated in North & Middle Andaman District, out of which, 9 beneficiaries were in the age group of 18-44. 110 beneficiaries were vaccinated in Nicobar District, out of which, 5 beneficiaries were in the age group of 18-44. A total of 1,71,609 eligible people in the age group of 18 to 44 years have been vaccinated till date, a press release from DHS said.

## COVID-19: No positive case detected during RT-PCR test conducted on incoming flight passengers

Port Blair, Oct.14

During the RT-PCR test conducted on 497 passengers who arrived here yesterday, no positive case has been detected. Today, 8 flights with 1384 passengers arrived, out of which, 923 were vaccinated with both doses while RT-PCR test was conducted on remaining 461 passengers and the reports are awaited. RAT was conducted on 209 passengers bound for North & Middle Andaman at Ferrargunj and no positive case has been detected. Apart from this, RAT was conducted on 28 passengers travelling to Swaraj Dweep at Phoenix Bay Jetty and one positive case has been detected. At Mohanpura Bus Terminus, test was conducted on 148 passengers and all were found negative. At Haddo Wharf, RAT test was conducted on 91 passengers travelling to various destinations and all were found negative. At helipad, test was conducted on 1 passenger who was found negative. Apart from this, test was conducted on 13 crew members of MV Chouldari and the reports are awaited. Two passengers intending to travel to Hut Bay were tested positive yesterday.

Today, till 3 pm, 279 persons were administered doses of vaccines, out of which, 254 were in the age group of 18-44. Presently, two COVID patients are undergoing treatment at GB Pant Hospital.
