The Chief Secretary, A & N Administration, Shri Keshav Chandra launched an end-to-end online solution <https://pcs.andaman.gov.in> for Port Clearance and berthing permission from Home Department and

PMB for foreign vessels today in the presence of Secretary (Home), Secretary (IT), Secretary (Shipping) and Special Secretary (IT). The portal will provide a platform to all the registered applicants to submit their request for berthing

permission from Port Management Board well in advance. The details so entered will be scrutinized by respective agencies and if found complying to the conditions, the approval will be granted within 7 days which will be gradually reduced with

experience. It will provide easy coordination between security agencies and other stakeholders, plug in the loopholes in the present procedure and help curb the procedural delay in the permission. This will obviate the need for the applicants to go to several

Government agencies and manually chase it to expedite the approval. The portal also has built-in facility for express approval subject to fulfillment of certain conditions.

Thus, end-to-end online solution will not only

The Flag Code of India, 2002 has been recently amended vide Orders dated 30.12.2021 and 20.07.2022. Vide the amendments, it has been provided that "the National Flag can be made of hand spun and hand woven or machine made, cotton / polyester / wool / silk / khadi bunting; and "where the Flag is displayed in open or displayed on the house of a member of public, it may be flown day and night, a press release from the Director (Art & Culture) said.

Salient Features of Flag Code of India, 2002

- The Indian National Flag represents the hopes and aspirations of the people of India. It is the symbol of our national pride and there is universal affection and respect for, and loyalty to, the National Flag. It occupies a unique and special place in the emotions and psyche of the people of India.
- The hoisting/use/display of the Indian National Flag is governed by the Prevention of Insults to National Honour Act, 1971 and the Flag Code of India, 2002. Some of salient features of the Flag Code of India, 2002 are listed below for the information of the public.
 - The Flag Code of India, 2002 was amended vide Order dated 30st December, 2021 and National Flag made of polyester or machine made Flag have been allowed. Now, the National Flag shall be made of hand spun and hand woven or machine made, cotton/polyester/wool/silk khadi bunting.
 - A member of public, a private organization or an educational institution may hoist/display the National Flag on all days and occasions, ceremonial or otherwise, consistent with the dignity and honour of the National Flag.
 - The Flag Code of India, 2002 was amended vide Order dated 19 July, 2022 and clause (xi) of paragraph 2.2 of Part-II of the Flag Code of India was replaced by the following clause:-
 - "where the Flag is displayed in open or displayed on the house of a member of public, it may be flown day and night;"
 - The National Flag shall be rectangular in shape. The Flag can be of any size but the ratio of the length to the height (width) of the Flag shall be 3:2.
 - Whenever the National Flag is displayed, it should occupy the position of honour and should be distinctly placed.
 - A damaged or dishevelled Flag shall not be displayed.
 - The Flag should not be flown from a single masthead simultaneously with any other flag or flags.
 - The Flag should not be flown on any vehicle except of the dignitaries mentioned in Section IX of Part III of the Flag Code, such as President, Vice-President, Prime-Minister, Governors etc.
 - No other flag or bunting should be placed higher than or above or side by side with the National Flag.

streamline the process of permission, it will bring in necessary efficiency, transparency and accountability in the approval process.

Apart from, Home Department, the web portal connects 22 agencies like Port Management Board, A & N Command, Coast Guard, Police Marine Force, CID, Immigration/FRU, CISF Customs, Health, Forest, Tourism, ANIDCO on a real time mode for prompt processing of request as per the Standard Operating Procedure. The portal has been developed by IT Department with assistance from SOVTECH and DBRAIT. The applicant will be able to track the status of his application online and it would be possible to fix accountability in case of any delay.

The entire process of end-to-end online solution was coordinated and piloted by Home Department. All the registered applicants and the other stakeholders will be provided training for two weeks. Thereafter, the Department will not entertain the manual mode of submitting request, a press release from Secretary (Home) said.

has produced large quantity of planting materials of different fruit plants such as Jackfruit, Guava, Mango, Papaya, Tamarind, Garcinia, Sapota, lemon, Cashew, etc. alongwith spices and ornamental plants. The Department is collecting seeds from various sources i.e. general public, PRIs and PBMC for making available adequate quantity of planting materials for distribution. So far, the Agriculture Department has produced about 71,200 nos. of planting materials of various fruits, ornamental and flowering plants, outof which, about 24,320 nos of planting materials were supplied to Govt. Departments, various Institutions, Anganwadies, etc. Apart from this 15,400 nos. of planting materials were also distributed to farmers and general public. Under this programme, about 150 nos. of fruit plants were planted in the Secretariat Complex.

Presently, more than 31500 nos. of planting materials are available in stock with the Department at various zones. Interested person or organisation can contact Farm Incharge, Organic Horticulture Farm, Sippighat in any working day between 7 am and 3 pm for South Andaman Zone and in case of other Islands, they may contact their respective Zonal Agriculture Office.

In addition to this, under the relentless distribution of vegetable seeds, 50000 mini kits were distributed in South Andaman district in association with Rural Development Department and Port Blair Municipal Council to every household. Another 35,600 nos. seed mini kits have been procured and sent for distribution in the other two districts of Andaman and Nicobar Islands, a press release from Department of Agriculture said.

Thereafter, the Flag formation will be carried out by the PBMC staff at JNRM Ground, a press release from PBMC said.

Elaborate Traffic arrangements made for Independence Day & Full Dress Rehearsal

Port Blair, Aug. 12

In connection with the Independence Day celebration, elaborate traffic arrangements have been made for the rehearsals of the Independence Day celebration on 13th August, 2022 (Full Dress Rehearsal) and for the main function on 15th August, 2022.

Accordingly, the arcade of Hon'ble Lt. Governor and other dignitaries, holders of parking card 'P' shall be parked inside the Netaji Stadium and near the Andaman Club. The holders of car parking label 'P', may use any route of their choice to approach the place of function, but are requested to reach the place of function latest by 0830 hrs., failing which, their vehicles will be stopped near the Gymkhana Crossing, RK Mission and Fire Brigade (HQ) crossings.

After the departure of the Chief Guest from the place of function, the vehicles bearing parking label "P" shall follow the route Scout Hut Junction-Vikas Bhawan (ANIDCO Office)- Fire Brigade- APWD Crossing to their destinations.

The holders of 'P-I' parking labels will arrive at the Netaji Stadium via Model School-Clock Tower-Gymkhana Crossing to Netaji Stadium. Thereafter, the vehicles shall proceed to the parking on the western side of the main gate of Netaji Stadium and near Swimming Pool.

After the departure of all vehicles parked inside the stadium and near Andaman Club having "P" parking label the vehicles of "P-I" parking label will be released to come to the main entrance of Netaji Stadium to pick up the guests and shall leave via Scout Hut Junction-Girls School Crossing-RK Mission and RGT Road.

All other vehicles without any parking label including two and four wheelers will be parked near Water Sports Complex and Girls School parking. The vehicles intending to proceed to South Point from Aberdeen Bazaar shall be diverted towards Model School Crossing - Bengali Club - Goalghar- Secretariat Junction - Police Line and Nayagaon.

No heavy vehicles, private and STS buses will be allowed to proceed towards Cellular Jail from 0700 hrs to 1100 hrs and shall be diverted to other routes from Bengali Club Junction. The vehicles intending to proceed to Aberdeen Bazaar from South Point shall follow the route of South Point-Shadipur-Nayagaon Junction-Police Line-RBV-Secretariat Junction and Goalghar. Heavy vehicles shall be diverted to Goal Ghar and Junglighat from Bengali Club from 0700 hrs to 1100 hrs. No vehicles shall be allowed to proceed towards the place of function from Y- Narayan Junction, RK Mission, Fire Brigade Junction and Water Sports Junction after 0830 hrs.

No vehicle shall be allowed to proceed towards Aberdeen Bazaar after the start of the function from any direction till the dispersal of the crowd.

The vehicles carrying parade contingents after dropping the contingents in front of Netaji Stadium shall proceed to Water Sports Complex/Girls School Parking and will remain stationed there. After culmination of parade they will come to Netaji Stadium via Y- Narayan Junction and proceed to their respective units with the parade contingents.

Further, the vehicles intending to proceed to GB Pant Hospital shall follow the routes from 0700 hrs to 1100 hrs.

➤ Gandhi Statue- Marine Gate - Sisty Nagar - Dignabad Sea Shore Road - Khan Jn. - exit gate of Hospital and then GB Pant Hospital.

local public preference which was finalised through public meetings and door to door survey by the Forest Department. About 8.5 Lakhs seedlings were raised by the Forest Department for the campaign by 30.6.2022.

The plantation drive started with the message of the Hon'ble Lt. Governor, Andaman & Nicobar Islands on 15.7.2022, urging islanders to actively participate in the campaign. The plantation of the campaign included awareness activities such as poster display at prominent places, pamphlet distribution, soft media campaign, announcement through vehicles, distribution of seedlings at different parts of the islands, etc. by the Forest Department.

Extensive consultations with the PRIs and Government Departments were also carried out to finalise the action plans to distribute the seedlings and taking the programme forward.

As a result of these efforts, fruit seedlings of species like Bael, Sitaphal, Cashew nut, Jack Fruit, Amla, Jamun, Drumstick, Tamarind, Sapota, Papaya, Lemon and other indigenous fruit trees were planted in homesteads, housing sites, schools and other office spaces. Besides this, a large number of seedlings were also distributed among the general public and school children by the Andaman & Nicobar Forest Department for planting in the homesteads. The Administration directed all the Government Servants to plant minimum two seedlings to make the campaign a success.

Due to these efforts, more than two Lakhs seedlings of high quality fruit tree seedlings have so far been distributed in the Islands as on 12.8.2022. The campaign would enhance fruit availability for the general public in long run and will secure their nutritional security.
