

Second part of Budget Session of Parliament to begin from today with normal functioning schedule

New Delhi, Mar. 13

The second part of the Budget Session of Parliament will begin from tomorrow (March 14). During the second part of the session, which is scheduled to conclude on the 8th of next month, there will be 19 sittings and the Parliament is also set to return to its normal functioning schedule. Both Lok Sabha and the Rajya Sabha will sit from 11 AM to 6 PM. The decision has been taken in the wake of the decline in COVID-19 cases in the country.

In view of the third wave of the pandemic, the two Houses worked in shifts in the



first phase. Both the Houses will continue to use their chambers and galleries during the second leg of the Budget Session. This time, the Rajya Sabha will get 19 hours of additional business time over the

earlier schedule. The Budget Session of Parliament resumes after a month-long recess during which the Department Related Parliamentary Standing Committees examined the Demands for Grants

of various Ministries and Departments.

Several important bills are likely to be taken up during the second phase of the budget session of Parliament. These include Finance Bill 2022, Competition Amendment Bill, Pension Fund Regulatory and Development Authority Amendment Bill, National Dental Commission Bill, Energy Conservation Amendment Bill 2022.

The Budget Session of Parliament began on 31st January with President, Shri Ram Nath Kovind's address.

Centre asks National Board of Exams to reduce cut-off by 15 percentile for NEET-PG 2021

New Delhi, Mar. 13

The Centre has directed the National Board of Examinations (NBE) to reduce the cut-off by 15 percentile across all categories for NEET-PG 2021 to fill up vacant Post Graduate medical seats in the country. In a letter to NBE, Medical Counselling Committee (MCC) said, after due discussion and deliberations, it has been decided by the Health Ministry to reduce the cut-off by 15 percentile across all categories.

NBE has been asked to declare the



revised result and send the revised result data of the newly eligible candidates to the Medical Counselling Committee at the earliest. The decision was taken in consultation with the National Medical Commission (NMC). There are over 8,000 seats, which remain vacant, even after two rounds of all India and two rounds of State quota counselling. The National Eligibility cum Entrance Test (Post Graduate) is conducted for Post Graduate medical courses. (Source: india.gov.in)

Automobile companies to start making flex-fuel vehicles within 6 months: Minister

New Delhi, Mar. 13

Union Minister, Shri Nitin Gadkari has said that automobile companies will start manufacturing flex-fuel vehicles within six months. Addressing a Global Business Summit, he said, most vehicles in India will soon run on 100 percent ethanol. Flex-fuel or flexible fuel is an

alternative fuel with a combination of gasoline and methanol or ethanol. Government is enabling the use of various alternate fuels in an effort to shift from fossil fuels. Automobile and auto components of flex-fuel engines have been included in the Production Linked Incentive (PLI) scheme. NITI

Aayog has formulated the roadmap for ethanol blending for the period 2020-2025 to accelerate the introduction of flex-fuel vehicles. Shri Gadkari also said the Government is working to encourage the use of green hydrogen and other alternative fuels. (Source: india.gov.in)

Providing Child Health Screening & Early Intervention Services through Rashtriya Bal Swasthya Karyakram 7135 children screened in Anganwadi Centres & Govt. Schools across Isles

The Ministry of Health & Family Welfare, GoI, under the National Health Mission launched the Rashtriya Bal Swasthya Karyakram (RBSK), an innovative and ambitious initiative, which envisages Child Health Screening and Early Intervention Services, a systemic approach of early identification and link to care, support and treatment. Rashtriya Bal Swasthya Karyakram (RBSK) is an important initiative aiming at



early identification and early intervention for children from birth and developmental related defects in the age group of 0-18 years.

Child Health Screening and Early Intervention Services basically refer to early

detection and management of a set of 30 health conditions prevalent in children less than 18 years of age. These conditions are broadly defects at birth, diseases in children, deficiency conditions and

developmental delays including disabilities - 4D's. Children in the age group from birth to eighteen years including the newborn and those attending Anganwadi Centers and Government Schools

have been benefitted through this programme. Any effective health intervention will reduce both direct costs and out-of-pocket expenditure. Child Health Screening and Early

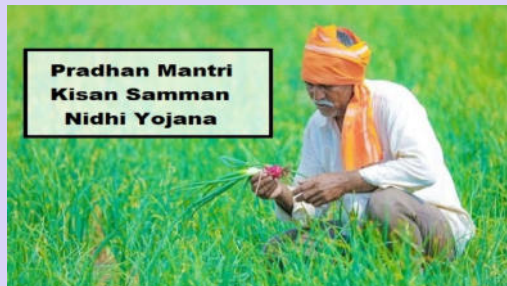
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e-KYC mandatory for smooth transfer of benefits to beneficiaries of PM-KISAN

Eligible registered farmers urged to update their KYC by May 31

Port Blair, Mar. 13

The Government with a view to augment the income of the farmers, launched the Central Sector Scheme - 'Pradhan Mantri Kisan Samman Nidhi' (PM-KISAN) during the financial year 2018-19 which is 100% funded by Govt. of India. Under the Scheme, eligible farmer families receive financial benefits of Rs. 6000/- per year payable in 3 equal installments of Rs. 2000/- each, every four months. The Hon'ble Prime Minister released the 10th instalment of the scheme on 1st January, 2022 directly to the bank accounts of the PM KISAN beneficiaries. The 11th installment is expected to be released soon for the period April 2022 to July 2022.



Now, the Govt. of India has decided to undertake e-KYC verification of all the eligible registered farmer-beneficiaries of PM-KISAN Scheme for smooth transfer of benefits. The verification is to be completed by 31st May, 2022.

It is therefore informed to all eligible registered farmers of PM-KISAN scheme to update their KYC before the schedule date. The e-KYC authentication of the beneficiaries can be done by both e-KYC OTP mode as well as e-KYC biometric mode.

The e-KYC authentication of the beneficiaries through OTP mode can be done on PM-KISAN portal free of cost by the beneficiaries or State functionaries and for e-KYC biometric authentication facility, the beneficiary may visit the nearest CSC center. The CSC will charge for bio-metric authentication from each beneficiary. For any query/doubt related to e-KYC, the beneficiaries can also contact the concerned Zonal Agriculture Office/ Field Extension functionaries of Agriculture Department.

The farmers have been advised to use only the official website of PM-KISAN portal and not to download any other App for e-KYC authentication, a press release from Agriculture Department said.

Awareness prog. on prevention & control of TB and new Treatment Strategy DOTS held

Under National TB Elimination Programme, the State TB Control Society, Port Blair organized an awareness programme on TB and new Treatment Strategy DOTS yesterday at Police Head Quarter, Police Line to create awareness on TB.

The programme was organized as part of observance of World TB Day, which falls on March 24.

Dr. S. P. Burma, Joint Secretary/ State TB Officer, State TB Control Society, A&N Islands delivered a lecture



on prevention and treatment and control of TB, new treatment strategy DOTS. He urged upon all the police people to propagate and spread the TB messages to the neighbours and in the community. Cough for more than two weeks may be TB, visit the nearest Health Centre for sputum examination and adopt DOTS for sure

cure of TB. Early detection and early treatment is the answer to eliminate TB from the society and advised to adopt proper dots to avoid emergence of multi drug resistant TB, he said. Lastly TB pledge was taken by all the participants to eliminate TB in India by 2025, a press release from Joint Secretary (NTEP) said.

Intervention Services also aims at reducing the extent of disability, at improving the quality of life and enabling all persons to achieve their full potential.

The Rashtriya Bal Swasthya Karyakram (RBSK) is implemented in these Islands by the Directorate of Health Services. Regular screening of the children is being carried by the staff of Health Department as per the age group. For new born (0 - 6 weeks), facility based new born screening is done at public health facilities especially at the designated delivery points by ANMs, Medical Officers/ Gynecologists. Community based new born screening is done at home through ASHAs during home visits for new born care to screen the babies born at home and the institutions till 6 weeks of age. For children 6 weeks to 6 years, Anganwadi Centre based screening is done by the dedicated Mobile Health Teams (MHT) while for children 6 years to 18 years: Government and Government aided school-based screening is done by dedicated MHT.

According to the data available with the DHS, altogether, 7135 children in the age group of 6 weeks to 18 years have been screened in Anganwadi Centres and Govt. Schools across the Islands from April 2021 to December 2021. Those children who needed early intervention for birth and developmental related defects, diseases etc in the age group of 0-18 years were referred to the respective PHC, CHC, District Hospital, G B Pant Hospital for further treatment.

HRD prog. on Integrated Pest Management on Vegetables (Rabi) held at Shaheed Dweep

Port Blair, Mar. 13

A two days HRD programme on vegetable crops i.e. tomato, green chillies, bottle gourd was conducted by Central Integrated Pest Management Centre (CIPMC) on March 10 & 11 at Sitapur, Shaheed Dweep. The focus of the programme was on management of major insect pests in vegetable crops through IPM practices-Cultural, Mechanical, Biological methods including various Indigenous Technical Knowledge (ITKs) of the region.

Plant Protection Officer (E), CIPMC, Port Blair, Shri H.P. Ramesh in his inaugural address emphasized on the



importance of natural enemies in field crops and residual effect of pesticides on vegetables & its perpetuation in Food Chain. Dr. Atul Gawande, APPO (PP) discussed briefly on identification of diseases of vegetable crops and their management through seed treatment with bio-pesticides and demonstrated types of pheromone/sticky Traps, Trap crops. Dr. Janardan Saikia,

APPO(E), discussed about insect life cycle and their management based on crop stages, importance of Trichocards for management of insect pests and need of IPM in organic farming. Dr. Chandan Lal, SCFA, Department of Agriculture, Shaheed Dweep expressed his views on biological pest control practices in present day sustainable vegetable farming, a press release from CIPMC said.
