

EDITORIAL

India must pick the world's best spinner, each time

The Indian men's cricket team is fortunate to have a man who is, arguably, one of the world's best batsmen and another who is, definitely, the world's best spinner. The first is out of form in conditions where he has struggled in the past, and the second has sat out the first three games because the conditions, we have been told, are unfavourable. If the logic applied to the non-selection of the second is applied across the team, some others, including the first, would be unlikely to be selected. Yet, cricket has always treated bowlers and batters differently.

There is a simple rule in any team sport. If there's someone who is best in the world, pick them. Apologists for the Indian cricket establishment have sought to paper over the cracks in selection by pointing to successes. The team's performance in Australia, where they won a series, is one such — never mind that the world's best spinner had a role to play in it, the captain did not play much, and some of the wins were a result of old-fashioned scrapping, not dominance. There is nothing wrong with scrapping it shows character — but it doesn't always work.

India must pick R Ashwin — as long as he is fit. He has been repeatedly told he is not good enough to make the team. This to a man who has more wickets than three of the five Indian bowlers who played the third test taken together. India is lucky to have him. Just as it is to have Virat Kohli. There is a bunch of batsmen that, on current form, is the world's best (Kohli is missing from the grouping, hopefully temporarily); there's simply no other spinner in the world currently as good as Ashwin.

Secretary (IP&T) appeals to citizens to adhere to **COVID** appropriate behavior & get themselves vaccinated

Secretary The (IP&T), Shri Sunil Kumar Singh briefing media persons on COVID-19 in the conference hall of IP&T here this evening has urged the general public to adhere to COVID appropriate behavior to protect themselves from the virus and also get themselves vaccinated. Giving details about the test being done to check the spread of the virus, he said, during the RT- PCR test conducted 684 on passengers who arrived here yesterday, three positive cases have been detected. Today, 5 flights with 860 passengers arrived and the RT-PCR reports are awaited. He further disclosed that RAT was conducted on 385 passengers bound for North & Middle Andaman at Ferrargunj and all the tests

were found negative. During the RAT conducted at

Phoenix Bay Jetty on 78 passengers bound for Swaraj Dweep, all were found negative. Similarly, on the return journey, test was conducted on 65 passengers and here too all were found negative. During RAT conducted on 46 passengers who arrived from Rangat by ship, all samples were found

At Mohanpura Bus Terminus, 202 passengers were tested and all the reports e negative.

The Director, ANIIMS, Dr. AK Mandal informed that one COVID positive patient is undergoing treatment at GB Pant Hospital.

The Deputy Director, GB Pant Hospital, Dr. Amitabha De said that presently COVID Care Centres are free from corona cases.

It has been the endeavor of A & N Administration to deliver better quality of services to the Citizen at their doorstop and continuously improve it for enhancing the quality of lives. In order to provide quick service in a transparent manner, the Transport Department made the services online by implementing National software Vahan 4.0 on 15.08.2020. In a further step towards adoption of e-Governance, the services related to Driving Licence have also been made online on 20.05.2021. A total of 29,581 transactions amounting to Rs. 1.09 Cr have been made by the citizen to avail various services of Motor Vehicle Department during the period 15.08.2020 to 17.08.2021. Encouraging response has been receiving from the General Public as more and more people are opting for the online services.

Further to minimize personal visits to RTO office especially during the ongoing pandemic situation, some of the services have been made completely faceless and at the same time, fee payment pro-

He hailed the role of Coast Guard in providing pro-active help in saving Very large crude carrier MT 'New Diamond' last year, and the cargo ship MV 'X-Press Pearl'. Raksha Mantri also commended the efforts of Coast Guard for its assistance provided to Mauritius during the oil spill from the 'Wakashio' motor vessel.

On the occasion he also lauded the efforts of Coast Guard towards realising the vision of SAGAR (Security and Growth for All in the Region) envisaged by the Hon'ble Prime Minister with focus on spirit of friendship, openness, dialogue and coexistence with the neighbours with keen sense of duty as its core.

The Ship will be based at Visakhapatnam and operate on India's Eastern Seaboard under the Operational and Administrative Control of the Commander, Coast Guard Region (East). ICGS Vigraha is commanded by Commandant PN Anoop has complement of 11 Officers and 110 men.

The 98 meters OPV has been designed and built indigenously by M/s Larsen & Toubro Ship Building Ltd., and is fitted with advanced technology Radars, Navigation and Communication Equipment, Sensor and Machinery capable of operating in tropical sea conditions. The vessel is armed with a 40/60 Bofors gun and fitted with two 12.7 mm Stabilised Remote Control Gun (SRCG) with Fire Control System. The ship is also equipped with Integrated Bridge System (IBS), Integrated Platform Management System (IPMS), Automated Power Management System (APMS) and High-Power External Firefighting (EFF) system. The ship is designed to carry one Twin Engine Helicopter and four high speed boats for Boarding Operation, Search and Rescue, Law Enforcement and Maritime Patrol. The ship is also capable of carrying limited pollution



response equipment to contain oil spill at sea. The ship displaces approx. 2200 tons (GRT) and is propelled by two 9100 KW diesel engines to attain a maximum speed of 26 knots with endurance of 5000 nm at economical speed.

The ship, on joining the Coast Guard Eastern fleet, will be deployed extensively for EEZ surveillance and other duties as enshrined in the Coast Guard Charter, to safeguard the maritime interests of India. The Indian Coast Guard with this ship joining the fleet,

will have 157 Ships and 66 Aircraft in its inventory.

INDIAN COAST GUARD PROVIDED ASSISTANCE TO DISTRESSED FISHING BOAT SALETHMATHA-II



In a swift response and deftly coordinated Search and Rescue Operation on 25 Aug 21, Indian Coast Guard located rescued a distressed fishing boat 'Salethmatha-II' with 10 crew onboard off Keating Point.

The Indian Coast Guard Regional Headquarters at Port Blair received a distress call from IFB Salethmatha-II regarding drifting of fishing boat alongwith 10 crew onboard off Keating Point at around 1845 hrs on 24 Aug 21. As per the information received from sources, the fishing boat 'Salethmatha-II' ventured into sea with 10 crew for fishing on AM 22 Aug 21 from Junglighat fishing harbor, Port Blair. On 24 Aug 21, the engine of the fishing boat became non ops due to rough weather. Efforts of the boat crew were in vain to repair the engine. The boat crew dropped anchor off Keating Point to prevent from drifting towards land.

Coast Guard Ship ICGS Aruna Asaf Ali on routine patrol was immediately diverted to locate the distressed boat and provide assistance. The information was also shared with Fisheries and Police Marine Force for rescue efforts.

Coast Guard Ship Aruna Asaf Ali reached in area at 0620 hrs on 25 Aug 21, ship's boarding party and technical team embarked the fishing boat by 0915 hrs. The defect was rectified by the Coast Guard technical team and thereafter the boat was escorted safely off Car Nicobar Island for having shelter view prevailing inclement weather. All ten crew are safe and healthy.

This entire search and rescue operation reflects commitment of Indian Coast Guard towards safeguarding precious lives at sea against all odds. The operation reflected effective coordination between Indian Coast Guard and Fisheries Department and resulted in saving 10 precious lives at sea amidst prevailing rough and severe sea conditions.

MP demands special ferry vessel from Port Blair to Rangat, Mayabunder and Diglipur till normal Bus Service resumes in ATR

Port Blair, Aug 28:

On the issue of landslide near Middle Strait, JPP, Mr. Kuldeep Rai Sharma, the Member of Parliament of Andaman and Nicobar Islands has requested the Chief Secretary of Andaman and Nicobar Administration to operate a special ferry from Port Blair to Rangat, Mayabuder and Diglipur till the normal ATR Bus Service for North and Middle Andaman is resumed.

Following information received from the public of North and Middle Andaman, the Member of Parliament today mailed a letter to the Chief Secretary in which he mentioned that a landslide near Middle Strait JPP has disrupted the ATR Bus Service for North and Middle Andaman and due to restrictions on the movement of Express bus services many passengers are stranded on both sides of ATR.

In this regard, Mr. Kuldeep Rai Sharma requested the Chief Secretary operate a special ferry from Port Blair to Rangat, Mayabuder and Diglipur so that those who are in urgent need of travelling to Port Blair or North and Middle Andaman for medical and other reasons, can do so.

The MP mentioned that presently only small vehicles are allowed to travel across the ATR but not all Islander can afford to book private vehicles to reach Port Blair or N&M Andaman.

Paralympics 2020: Avani Lekhara wins gold in shooting, Yogesh clinches silver in discus throw

Indian paralympic shooter Avani Lekhara won country's first gold medal in shooting at the Tokyo Paralympics in the women's 10m air rifle standing SH1 event on Monday. While making India proud, India's discus thrower Yogesh Kathuniya clinched silver in the final F56 category. Yogesh came up with the best attempt of 44.38m to finish at the 2nd spot.

Lekhara, 19, won the gold medal with a total score of 249.6 in the final. She equalled the world record. She qualified for the final finishing 7th in the qualification round with a total score of 621.7. Avani staged a good recovery after a slow start to advance to the finals of the showpiece event.

The 10m Air Rifle shooter hails from Jaipur, Rajasthan and she trains in the JDA Shooting Range in the Pink City. She suffered Traumatic Paraplegia caused by an acci-

dent in 2012. Hailing the shooting's feat, Prime Minister Narendra Modi congratulated on Twitter. He wrote," Phenomenal performance @AvaniLekhara! Congratulations on winning a hard-earned and well-deserved Gold, made possible due to your industrious nature and passion towards shooting. This is truly a special moment for Indian sports. Best wishes for your future endeavours."

India's first individual Olympic gold medal-winning shooter Abhinav Bindra also heaped praise on Avani.

Yogesh Kathuniya misses

The 24-year-old, a B.Com graduate from New Delhi's Kirorimal College, sent the disc to a best distance of 44.38m in his sixth and last attempt to clinch the silver. On Sunday,

India had picked up a silver (high jump) and a bronze (discus throw), which is on hold due to a protest.

Son of an Army man, Kathuniya suffered a paralytic attack at the age of eight which left him with coordination impairments in his limbs.

Brazil's defending champion, reigning world champion and world record holder Claudiney Batista dos Santos won the gold with a best throw of 45.59m while Leonardo Diaz Aldana (43.36m) of Cuba took the bronze.

In F56 classification, athletes have full arm and trunk muscle power. Pelvic stability is provided by some to full ability to press the knees together.

He won a bronze medal in the 2019 World Para Athletics Championships in Dubai with a best throw of 42.51m which also booked him a Tokyo berth.

It was during his time at the KMC that his potential was noticed by several coaches and he soon came under the tutelage of Satyapal Singh at the Jawaharlal Nehuru Stadium.

A few years later, he came under the guidance of coach Naval Singh.

He created a world record in F36 category in his first ever international competition in 2018 at the Para-athletics Grand Prix in Berlin.
