Talking to Andaman Sheekha Daily, Mr. Girish Joshi, a resident of Laxmi Nagar Panchayat alleged that on 3rd January 2023 an old lady of the area got injured and sustained grievous head injuries and suffered blood loss but when she was taken to the sub-centre it was found closed. Later she was rushed to PHC Campbell Bay for treatment.

Further Mr. Prahlad Singh, Pradhan of Laxmi Nagar Gram Panchayat told Andaman Sheekha said that in Laxmi Nagar Panchayat all the villagers are settlers and most of them belong to ex-serviceman category and are old. "Here we have one Sub-Centre which should function 24x7 as per Administration but in reality it functions only between 08:00AM to 01:00PM," he added.

He said that the Sub

Centre is functioning with only one CHO, one ANM and one Ayia who are deputed by Health Department but due to staff shortage in Campbell Bay most of the time the staff deputed in other Health Centre. He requested the Administration to look into the

matter and depute sufficient staff in Laxmi Nagar Sub Centre. In this regard Andaman Sheekha contacted a senior officer of Campbell Bay who said that there are only 03 staff in the Sub Centre of Laxmi Nagar since the

## South Korea warns of ending military pact if North violates airspace: Report

South Korean President Yoon Suk-yeol said on Wednesday he would consider suspending a 2018 inter-Korean military pact if North Korea violates its airspace again, Yonhap news agency reported, citing his press secretary. Yoon made the comment after being briefed on countermeasures to North Korean drones that crossed into the South last week, calling for building an "overwhelming response capability that goes beyond proportional levels," Yonhap said. Inter-Korean relations have been testy for decades but have grown even more tense since Yoon took office in May pledging a tougher line against Pyongyang.

Yoon has criticised the military's handling of the drone incident, in part blam-

ing the previous administration's reliance on the 2018 pact banning hostile activities in the border areas.

He has urged the military to stand ready to retaliate. Yoon ordered the defence minister to launch a comprehensive drone unit that performs multi-purpose missions, including surveillance, reconnaissance and electronic warfare, and to set up a system to mass-produce small drones that are difficult to detect within the year, Yonhap said, citing his press secretary, Kim Eun-hye. "He also called for accelerating the development to produce stealth drones this year and quickly establishing a drone killer system," Kim said, according to Yonhap.

## 'Signs of change in...?': Congress on Ram Mandir Trust's support for Bharat Jodo

Senior Congress leader Jairam Ramesh on Wednesday wondered whether there were "signs of change" in Uttar Pradesh, claiming the Bharat Jodo Yatra participants were greeted by people in the BJP office in Baghpat's Barauli as the Rahul Gandhi-led march passed through the area. Ramesh also mentioned the recent letter of support from Ram temple chief priest Acharya Satyendra Das and Ram Mandir Trust secretary Champat Rai's words of appreciation for Rahul Gandhi.

"After a letter from the head priest of the Ayodhya Ram temple welcoming Bharat Jodo Yatra and praise for Rahul Gandhi from VHP leaders like Champat Rai, the yatriis were greeted with enthusiastic hand-waving from the BJP office in Baghpat's Barauli today," Ramesh said



in a tweet in Hindi. "Signs of climate change in Yogi's state?"

Rai had lauded Rahul Gandhi for undertaking the Bharat Jodo Yatra, saying he is walking in harsh weather and that must be appreciated. "I appreciate his move. There is nothing wrong in it. No one can be against Bharat Jodo Yatra."

"I am a worker of Rashtriya Swayamsevak Sangh and the RSS never condemned Bharat Jodo Yatra," Rai told media persons in Ayodhya on Tuesday. He called Rahul the 'young man who is walking on foot for the country'. A day before the yatra entered UP,

Ram temple chief priest Acharya Satyendra Das wished Rahul success in the yatra, good health and long life. "Whatever work you are doing for the country is for the benefit of all. My blessings are with you. Lord Ram's blessings be with you (Rahul Gandhi)," Das wrote in the letter. The leaders of other political parties in Uttar Pradesh who were invited to join the Yatra, including Samajwadi Party president Akhilesh Yadav and Bahujan Samaj Party chief Mayawati, wished the march a success. However, they gave the yatra a miss.

## Sultanpuri horror: Autopsy shows no sign of alcohol, says family doc

The family doctor of the woman, who was killed after being hit and dragged by a car here, rejected her friend's claims that she was heavily drunk on the night of the incident, saying the autopsy report did not find any trace of alcohol in her stomach. The victim's friend, who was riding pillion on her scooter, had told the media that Anjali was drunk and had insisted on driving the two-wheeler on the fateful night. Anjali was killed in the early hours of the New Year after her scooter was hit by a car, which dragged her for 12 kilometres. Her body was found in outer Delhi's Kanjhawala. Five men who were allegedly in the car have been booked for culpable homicide among other sections. All five accused were sent to a three-day police custody on Monday. "According to the autopsy report, there was food inside the stomach. If she would have been drunk, the report would have mentioned the presence of a chemical. But the report says only food has been detected (inside the stomach),"



Bhupesh told reporters. Bhupesh said this was not a normal murder. "A murder is considered sadistic when a victim is brutally tortured before death. As per the autopsy report, she suffered 40 injuries," the doctor said. The victim's friend had earlier said the five men accused of dragging the woman under their car killed her deliberately as they kept driving despite knowing she was stuck under the vehicle. Recalling the fateful night, Anjali's friend, who was traced by the police after they examined the CCTV footage, said they had gone to meet some friends at a hotel on New Year eve and alleged that despite being 'drunk', the victim wanted to ride the scooter after the

party. Contrary to other eyewitness accounts, the victim's friend asserted that no music was playing in the car that hit them and claimed that the driver was aware that Anjali was being dragged under the wheels. Delhi Commission For Women (DCW) chief Swati Maliwal cautioned against victim shaming and demanded a probe into the friend's claims. The victim's friend said after the impact, Anjali got stuck under the car and was dragged by the vehicle, with its occupants not once trying to slow down or save the woman. Anjali's friend said she did not inform anyone about the accident as she was scared and feared that she would be blamed for it.

## Dist-level summit to attract investors in Bahraich on Jan 6



**BAHRAICH** On the lines of the Global Investors' Summit, which is aimed at attracting investments into Uttar Pradesh, a summit at the local level will be organised in Bahraich on January 6 to bring in entrepreneurs to invest in the district. The summit is being arranged by Bahraich district magistrate Dr Dinesh Chandra Singh.

On 02.01.2023 at around 1100 hrs he left the house by saying his wife that he will return back in a moment but by 03.00 PM, when he did not return, his family members got worried and started to look for him in

nearby areas.

The matter was then reported to PS Ograbraj in the late evening hours after which police and public intensified the search for the missing person.

Witnesses informed that the police team conducted the search operation all night. Later, early morning on 03.01.2023 a police

team was successful in finding Mr. Sunder (Name Changed), who lost his way and was found lying in a muddy drain and was barely speaking.
