

PM to embark on 3-day visit to Germany, Denmark and France from today

New Delhi, May 1

Prime Minister, Shri Narendra Modi will pay an official visit to three European Countries- Germany, Denmark and France from 2nd to 4th May. Shri Modi would be visiting these three countries for bilateral as well as multilateral engagements. Giving details about the Prime Minister's visit, Foreign Secretary, Shri Vinay Mohan Kwatra told the media in New Delhi that on the first leg of his visit to Berlin in Germany on 2nd May, Prime Minister, Shri Narendra Modi will meet German Chancellor, Mr Olaf Scholz. Shri Kwatra said the two leaders will co-chair the sixth edition of the India-Germany Inter-Governmental Consultations.

The biennial IGC is a unique dialogue format that also sees participation of several Ministers



last year.

After concluding the visit to Germany, Prime Minister, Shri Modi on 3rd of May, will travel to Copenhagen on an official visit at the invitation of Prime Minister of Denmark, Mr Mette Frederiksen. This will be Shri Modi's first visit to Denmark but his third summit-level interaction with the Danish PM and the discussions will focus on bilateral issues as well as issues of global and regional interest.

During the visit, Shri Modi will hold talks with Prime Minister, Mr Frederiksen and pay a call on Queen Margrethe II. The visit would provide both sides an opportunity to shape new elements of partnership in the field of skill development, shipping, agri technology and mobility. During the visit,

On 4th of May, Shri Modi will participate in the 2nd India-Nordic Summit along with Prime Minister's of Denmark, Iceland, Finland, Sweden and Norway. The Summit will focus on subjects like post-pandemic economic recovery, climate change, innovation and technology, renewable energy, the evolving global security scenario and India-Nordic cooperation in the Arctic region. The 1st India-Nordic Summit took place in 2018 in Stockholm.

He thanked the Administration for lending their helping hand specially Police & Health Department during the COVID-19 pandemic situation for their remarkable works. A short documentary on Water Sufficient Village was screened which depicted the geographical details of GP Tushnabad highlighting the key achievements of the village in the particular sector and in other flagship programmes of Govt. of India.

In the village, under Jal Jeevan Mission envisioned to provide safe and adequate drinking water through individual household tap connections by 2024 to all households in rural India, 598 Households have been covered with tap water connection ensuring 100 percent FHTC in the village.


