Farmers' Corner- A Knowledge Hub

Mangifera griffithi - an endemic wild mango species of conservation interest

Wild mango (*Mangifera griffithi*) is an endemic species of the Island and is found distributed in specific locations like Mt. Harriet, Shoal Bay and Nancowry Islands as single tree. Due to limited population, the species is more vulnerable to extinction and hence efforts have been taken to characterize and conserve the graft of the species at ICAR-CIARI. This wild mango species is also registered with NBPGP (ICAR- National Bureau of Plant Genetic Resources, New Delhi) with IC No 409079 to receive national identity. *Mangifera griffithi* is characterized as a huge tree with oblong crown shape and spreading tree habit. Leaves are dark green, small sized and dense. The characteristic feature of this fruit is the purplish blue colour peel which is reported to have high anthocyanin content. The fruits are oblong shaped, small sized (4.0 cm length and 3.5 cm width) weighing 34 -40 g per fruit. The taste of the fruit is pleasant and fruit pulp is yellow in colour. No major pest or disease is reported from this endemic mango species. There is a great necessity to preserve this endemic mango species of the Island by collection and planting them in field gene banks, botanical gardens and keep them preserved in wild.



Benefit: This endemic wild mango species is strength of our Island and storehouse of gene pool for evolving commercial mango varieties with unique qualities and disease resistance.

launched by the Govt. of India with an aim to bring the uninsured population under insurance cover. This accident insurance scheme offers a one-year accidental death and disability cover, which can be renewed annually.

As per the salient feature of the scheme, people in the age group 18 to 70 years are eligible. They should have a bank account and give their consent to join/enable auto-debit on or before 31st May for the coverage period 1st June to 31st May on an annual renewal basis. Aadhaar would be the primary Know Your Customer (KYC) for opening bank account. The risk coverage under the scheme is Rs. 2 lakh for accidental death and full disability and Rs. 1 lakh for partial disability. The premium of Rs.12 per annum will be deducted from the account holder's bank account through 'auto-debit' facility in one installment, as per the consent to be given on enrolment. Members may also give one-time mandate for auto-debit every year till the scheme is in force, subject to re-calibration that may be deemed necessary on review of experience of the scheme. In case of a joint account, all holders of the said account can join the scheme provided they satisfy the eligibility criteria and pay the premium at the rate of Rs.12 per person per annum through auto-debit.

State Adoption Resource Agency; registration being done through CARINGS Illegal adoption will attract legal action

Port Blair, Oct. 9

The State Adoption Resource Agency under Directorate of Social Welfare is functioning in these Islands as a unit to coordinate, monitor and develop the work of adoption program, disseminating information and awareness on adoption process. The adoption registration is done through 'Child Adoption Resource Information and Guidance System' (CARINGS) which is a centralized software containing database of children and registration of parents. Parents can also adopt through relative adoption or children of spouse from earlier marriage as step-parents adoption.

The parents willing to

adopt can register themselves by logging in as PAPs (Prospective Adoptive Parents) through www.cara.nic.in or CARINGS 3.1. Documents such as family photographs, birth certificate, income and address proof, medical certificate along with marriage/divorce certificate have to be uploaded on the portal. After registration, Home Study Report will be prepared by social worker of Adoption Agency after which parents will be shifted to a centralized seniority list. Parents will get reference of three legally free children on the basis of seniority and preference of child as entered on CARINGS portal. It is for the information of general public that no

illegal adoptions may be encouraged failing which legal action as per Section 32, 33, 34 of Juvenile Justice (Care & Protection of Children) Act, 2015 or 6 months imprisonment or a fine of Rs.10,000/- or both will be imposed. SARA appeals to the general public to report any cases of illegal adoptions.

As regards, adoption details/queries in the adoption processes to be carried out, the same can be obtained from the State Adoption Resource Agency (SARA) which is functional in the Directorate of Social Welfare (Room No. 308), Ph. No: 9972750391; E-mail ID: sara4andaman@gmail.com, a press release from Directorate of Social Welfare said.
