## India's first solar observatory mission, **Aditya-L1**, successfully lifts off from Sriharikota Space Centre

## PM congratulates Scientist & Engineers of ISRO for the successful launch of the Mission



Sriharikota, Sept. 2

India's journey towards the Sun began today as the maiden flight mission took off precisely at 11. 50 am at the Sathish Dhawan Space Centre Sriharikota. It took almost one hour and three minutes for Aditya L1 to begin its 125 days journey to the sun. On the sunny afternoon, the PSLV C57 rocket carrying Aditya L1 soared into the clear skies with a reverberating sound and with the crowds at ISRO expressing their happiness with whistles and claps. The Prime Minister, Shri Narendra Modi has congratulated scientists and engineers of ISRO for the successful launch of India's first Solar Mission, Aditya - L1. In an X post, the Prime Minister said; "After the success of Chandrayaan-3, India continues its space journey. Congratulations to our scientists and engineers at @isro for the successful launch of India's first Solar Mission, Aditya -L1. Our tireless scientific efforts will continue in order to develop better understanding of the Universe for the welfare of entire humanity."

Scientists at the Control Centre shared smiles with each other as the rocket went up to the skies. India's ambitious mission to the sun comes close after the achievement of Chandrayaan - 3. PSLV C 57 carrying Aditya L1 is the XL variant with longer strap on motors carrying higher fuel quantity. All the flight parameters were absolutely normal. 51minutes after the launch, the first signal was received from the ship borne terminal for tracking the second part of the fourth stage. In a period of four months, Aditya L1 will reach the Lagrange 1 point where the gravitational forces of a two body system like the Sun and the Earth produce enhanced regions of attraction and repulsion.

Aditya's L1 mission is to study the solar winds and the Sun's atmosphere. It carries seven payloads to observe the photosphere, chromosphere and the outermost layers of the Sun, the Corona.

This will help understand the problems of coronal heating, Coronal mass ejection, pre-

flare and flare activities, dynamics of weather and the study of the propagation of particles and fields in the interplanetary medium. Soon after India's successful mission to the Moon on the 23<sup>rd</sup> of August, Indian Space Industry witnessed another journey to the Sun which has been undertaken by four other Space Centres in the World. ISRO's service includes not only orbiting India's own satellites but also hundreds of foreign satellites and in the process earn foreign exchange for the country. India has till date launched 431 foreign satellites belonging to 36 countries since 1999 with its rockets and bulk of the numbers were by the PSLV rocket. The rocket has also been used to put into orbit 104 satellites in a single flight.(Source:india.gov.in)

PS Swaraj Dweep team solves blind murder case

Port Blair, Sept. 2

The dedicated staff of PS Swaraj Dweep successfully solved a blind murder case within 48 hours. This extraordinary achievement underscores the dedication and competence of Andaman & Nicobar Police. On 31/08/2023, a gruesome murder case came to light when the lifeless body of victim named Laxman Roy, 42 years, Pvt. Worker, R/o Govind Nagar Swaraj Dweep was discovered buried in the sand on Radhanagar beach.

The circumstances surrounding the murder were shrouded in mystery, with no immediate leads or clues of the perpetrators. Immediately, a FIR was registered at PS Swaraj Dweep and a police team

comprising of Inspector N. Zainuddin, SHO PS Swaraj Dweep, SI Sumit Singh, Head Constable Jerome Edward, Police Constables Suraj Kumar, AP Mohd. Asif, Sujoy Mazumder, Mohd. Sharif, Rohit Khatkar, Abdul Basheer, Gurjeet Singh, Aurangzeb Ahmed, G. Dev Raju, Sandeep Tiwari, IRBn Constables Shankar Rao, G. Tarkesh, Police Drivers Nishal Ruben Ekka, Sandeep Kumar was constituted to investigate the case. Working professionally, the team analyzed multiple CCTV camera footage and conducted a local enquiry to trace out the accused persons. The relentless determination of the team soon turned the tide and finally led to apprehension of three accused persons namely Shiva Toppo, S/o Sukru Toppo, Age- 18 yrs, R/o Betapur, North & Middle Andaman presently working at a Dive Centre at Swaraj Dweep, Surju Pahan, S/o Pandu Pahan, Age- 21yrs, R/o Jharkhand, presently working at a Resort at Swaraj Dweep & a Juvenile in conflict with Law. Further investigation of the case is under progress.

The entire investigation was carried out under the direct supervision of Shri Manasvi Vashishta, SDPO Swaraj Dweep and under the overall supervision of Shri Kalaivanan R., IPS, Superintendent of Police South Andaman District, a press release from SP (SA) said.
