

Raksha Mantri commissions INS Visakhapatnam into Indian Navy Describes it as a symbol of India's growing maritime prowess

New Delhi, Nov. 21 (PIB)

INS Visakhapatnam, a P15B stealth guided missile destroyer, was commissioned into the Indian Navy in the presence of Raksha Mantri, Shri Rajnath Singh at the Naval Dockyard, Mumbai today. The event marks the formal induction of the first of the four 'Visakhapatnam' class destroyers, indigenously designed by the Indian Navy's in-house organisation Directorate of Naval Design and constructed by Mazagon Dock Shipbuilders Limited, Mumbai.

In his address, the Raksha Mantri termed INS Visakhapatnam as a symbol of the growing maritime prowess of the country and a major milestone in achieving Prime Minister, Shri Narendra Modi's vision of 'Make in India, Make for the World'. He added that the ship is a reminder of ancient and medieval India's maritime power, shipbuilding skills and glorious history. Shri Rajnath Singh exuded confidence that the state-of-the-art ship, equipped with latest systems and weapons, will strengthen the maritime security and protect the interests of the Nation. He defined the ship as one of the most technologically advanced guided



missile destroyers in the world which will cater to the present & future requirements of the Armed Forces and the Nation as a whole.

Shri Rajnath Singh appreciated the self-reliance efforts of the Indian Navy, terming Navy's order of 39 of the 41 ships and submarines from Indian shipyards as a testament to their commitment towards achieving 'Aatmanirbhar Bharat'. He described the development of Indigenous

Aircraft Carrier 'INS Vikrant' as an important milestone in their path to achieve 'Aatmanirbharta'. "The carrier will increase our reach from the Indian Ocean to the Pacific and Atlantic Ocean. Its commissioning will be a golden moment in the history of the Indian Defence. It will be the best occasion to celebrate the 75th anniversary of India's independence and the 50th anniversary of India's

The Administration is strictly implementing the five-fold strategy of Testing, Tracing, and Treatment, COVID-appropriate behaviour and Vaccination for effective COVID-19 management in Isles. In order to curb the chain of transmission of the virus and to reduce the number of positive cases, various steps have been initiated. Ever since

the outbreak of COVID-19, A&N Islands has augmented its testing manifold. As on date, 625682 samples have been tested in A&N Islands and the Islands' Test Per Million (TPM) presently stands at 1564205.

Apart from this, the incoming flight passengers those who are not fully vaccinated are also being retested with RT-PCR upon arrival



at Port Blair, as

double checking measure. Similarly, RAT is also being conducted on Inter-Island bound passengers travelling by ship, roadways as well as by Heli. This way, the Administration has been able to curb the transmission of the virus and that has contributed to bringing down the number of active cases in the Islands to 2.

As per health data, the new active case in the last 24 hours is 0 while the total number of active cases during the 2nd wave (since 01.03.2021) is 2 in the entire Islands. Out of the total, 7676 confirmed cases of COVID since March 2020, 7545 patients have been cured / discharged so far.

Meanwhile, the vaccination drive is also progressing

and Fair Price Shop dealers from time to time to get their Aadhaar number seeded with the ration card data base. 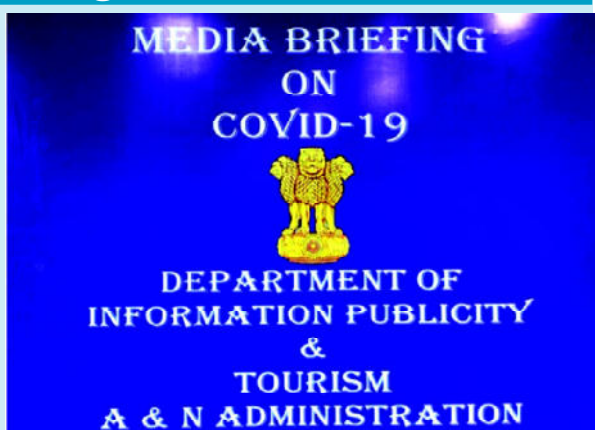

Farmers' Corner- A Knowledge Hub

Quail production Techniques in Andaman Nicobar Islands

Quails ("Bater" in Hindi) are hardy birds and does not suffer from common poultry diseases. Their eggs and meat are highly nutritious and is relished by children and aged persons. This is said quail meat and egg is good for allergic asthma patients. Quail farming requires only a low capital investment and gives early return (within 35-40 days) over the investment. They start egg laying at 6th week of age and produce around 250 eggs in a year. The farming activities are simple and timings can be flexed. Hence, this farming can be adapted by home makers, employees and naive farmers as well. Scientists of ICAR-CIARI have standardized package of practices for quail rearing in Andaman conditions and imparting training for the interested farmers. The quails maintained in ICAR-CIARI reaches an average body weight of 180-190 gm at 6 weeks of age. A proper brooder management, nutrition and correct light settings are critical in successful quail farming. A brooding period of minimum 2 weeks is needed for chicks. The feed require a higher protein content than normal broiler ration. At layer stage i.e above 6 weeks, they need a 16-18 h of light compared to chicks (24 h of lighting) while grower stage (3-6 weeks) quail does not require any additional light than natural 12 h lighting. The selection of male and female are easy in quail and can be done by 3-4th weeks of age. A proper male-female ratio of 1:3 is important for better hatchability.

Benefit: Quail rearing in Andaman Nicobar Islands is profitable venture as it is a tourist place. It ensures early return over initial investment.

victory in 1971 war," he said.

Shri Rajnath Singh reiterated that India, as a responsible maritime stakeholder, is a supporter of consensus-based principles and a peaceful, open, rule-based and stable maritime order. "In the 'United Nations Convention on the Law of the Sea' (UNCLOS) of 1982, territorial waters of nations, exclusive economic zones and the principle of 'Good order at sea' have been propounded.

INS Visakhapatnam measures 163m in length, 17m in breadth with a displacement of 7,400 tonnes and can rightfully be regarded as one of the most potent warships to have been constructed in India. The ship is propelled by four powerful Gas Turbines, in a Combined Gas and Gas (COGAG) configuration, capable of achieving speeds in excess of 30 knots. The ship has enhanced stealth features resulting in a reduced Radar Cross Section (RCS) achieved through efficient shaping of hull, full beam superstructure design, plated masts and use of radar transparent materials on exposed decks.

The ship is packed with sophisticated state-of-the-art weapons and sensors such as Surface-to-Surface missile and Surface-to-Air missiles. It is fitted with a modern surveillance radar which provides target data to the gunnery weapon systems of the ship. The anti-submarine warfare capabilities are provided by the indigenously developed rocket launchers, torpedo launchers and ASW helicopters. The ship is equipped to fight under Nuclear, Biological and Chemical (NBC) warfare conditions.

A unique feature of this ship is the high level of indigenisation incorporated in the production, accentuating the national objective of 'Aatmanirbhar Bharat'. Some of the major indigenised equipment/system onboard INS Visakhapatnam include Combat Management System, Rocket Launcher, Torpedo Tube Launcher, Integrated Platform Management System, Automated Power Management System, Foldable Hangar Doors, Helo Traversing system, Close-in Weapon System and the Bow mounted SONAR.

- Individual micro food processing enterprises availing credit linked grant under the Scheme.

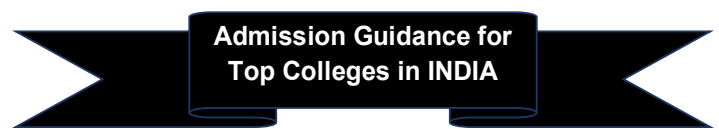
