UTGST Department celebrates GST Day

Port Blair, July 1

The Goods and Services Tax (GST) is India's biggest indirect tax reforms which started on July 1, 2017 and in 2022, the sixth year of successful implementation of GST after braving some serious challenges, it was worth a celebration. On the 5th anniversary of the most notable and unprecedented tax reform of the country, the implementation of the Goods and Service Tax (GST), UTGST Department, Port Blair celebrated GST Day today.

The commemoration began in the presence of the chief guest, Shri Suneel Anchipaka, Commissioner of UTGST, Andaman &



Nicobar Islands.

Addressing the gathering, Shri Suneel Anchipaka recalled the pre-GST taxation system in India was one of the most complicated tax systems in the world. Multiple taxes, multiple returns to be filed by assessees, interface with multiple tax authorities, cascading effect of taxes, rising inflation, no free flow of goods across the country, fragmented markets across the country, inter alia, were some of the

tenuous issues plaguing the indirect taxation system in India. GST has persuaded people to do businesses in a transparent manner without evading taxes, Shri Anchipaka added.

He appreciated all the initiatives taken by the Officers of UTGST Department towards smooth functioning of the GST Department and helping the tax-payers in every possible way. He further appealed the tax-payer to cooperate with the

Government in making the country an Economic Powerhouse of the future.

The Commissioner, UTGST concluding his address thanked the tax-payers without whose cooperation GST could not have been a success that it is today. Though GST has given a lot of reasons to cheer about with its achievements, the best of GST in terms of its contribution to the society is yet to come, he added. He further requested the tax-payers to file their GST returns on time and discharge off their tax liabilities in a timely manner in order to avoid the additional burden of interest and penalty, a press release from Commissioner, UTGST said.

Ban on Single Use Plastic comes into force

New Delhi, July 1

Ban on manufacture, import, stocking, distribution, sale and use of identified single use plastic items has come into force from today across the country. Single-use plastics are those items that are used only once and discarded. The items covered under the



ban include ear buds with plastic sticks, polystyrene (Thermocol) for decoration, plastic plates, plastic cups, plastic glasses and plastic cutlery.

The Ministry of Environment, Forest and Climate Change said that national and State level control rooms will be set up for checking illegal manufacture, import, stocking, distribution, sale and use of banned single for the effective enforcement of ban. (Source: india.gov.in)

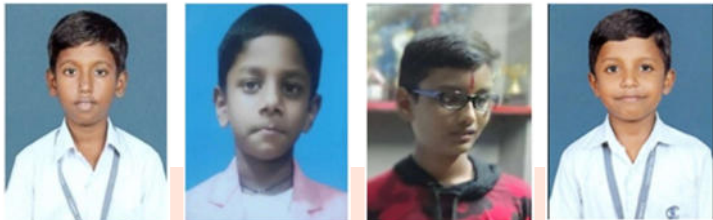

School recently participated in the 13th Chennai Open International Grandmasters Chess Tournament 2022 held at Chennai and performed reasonably well which led them to open the FIDE Rating. J.S Virat of VKV and V Yashwant of Kamaraj School participated in the National School Chess Championship 2022 at Bhubaneswar and performed well and accordingly their FIDE Rating has been opened. Road Safety Awareness Drive by A&N Traffic Police

As part of the Road Safety Awareness drive, an awareness camp on first aid treatment was organized by A&N Traffic Police in collaboration with GB Pant Hospital on June 28 in the conference hall of PS Aberdeen. Shri Sanjay Kumar Jain, Inspector General of Police (I&O), was the chief guest during the camp. Shri Kalaivanan R, SP (South Andaman District/Traffic), Shri Abhishek Gupta, SDPO (SA)/Dy. SP (Traffic) and more than 100 people participated in this programme.

At the outset, Shri Sanjay Kumar Jain sensitized the public about the importance of wearing helmet and seat belt. He also highlighted about the importance of 'Golden Hour' while providing First Aid to the injured, as this period is

very critical as the chances of survival depend on this window period and also explained the responsibilities of a 'Good Samaritan'. Shri Kalaivanan elaborated on first aid which is the first and immediate assistance given to any person suffering from either a minor or serious illness or injury and everyone of us must have the basic training of providing first aid, he added. Shri Abhishek Gupta remarked that many a times it is the commercial drivers such as auto rickshaw/tour and travels who are asked by public for giving assistance to the injured for taking him to hospital. In the meantime, if commercial drivers have some basic first-aid training, they can save a precious life in the golden hour.

Dr Amitabha De, CMO (NFSG) of GB Pant Hospital in his audio-video presentation educated the A & N Police personnel, general public and auto/truck/van/bus drivers about the procedures of performing CPR and providing first aid techniques to the victims of road accidents/venomous bites/drowning/fire/electric shock. Practical demonstration of CPR was also given to the participants. To create wide awareness amongst general public, various road safety awareness programmes are being conducted by A&N Traffic Police. Apart from this, road safety awareness classes, meetings with public service vehicle drivers, Nukkad Nataks and free eye testing camp are being conducted, a press release from A&N Police said.

COVID-19 status in A&N Islands

Port Blair, July 1

During the RTPCR conducted on 180 incoming flight passengers, who arrived here yesterday, three positive cases have been detected. Today, 11 flights with 1710 passengers arrived, out of which, 1506 passengers were vaccinated with both doses while RT-PCR test was conducted on 164 passengers and the reports are awaited.

During RAT conducted on 35 passengers bound for North & Middle Andaman at Ferrargunj, no positive case has been detected. At Phoenix Bay Jetty, 92 passengers were tested with RAT, one positive case has been detected. At Helipad test was conducted on 5 passengers and reports were negative. RAT was conducted on 50 passengers at Mohanpura Bus Terminus, no positive case has been detected, a press release from Directorate of IP&T said.

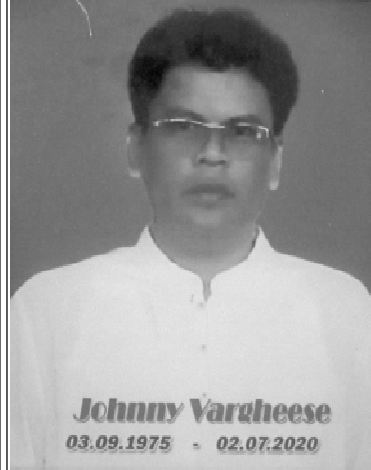

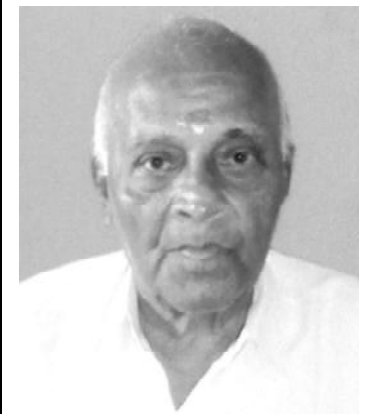
