

## PM Modi holds talks with President Ibrahim Mohamed Solih India-Maldives partnership is source of peace, stability, and prosperity for region: PM

New Delhi, Aug. 2

Prime Minister Shri Narendra Modi held delegation-level talks with President of Maldives Mr Ibrahim Mohamed Solih in New Delhi today. Both sides reviewed bilateral ties and discussed ways to strengthen linkages in areas of development partnership, trade, connectivity, and P2P ties, among others.

In the joint press statement after the talks, Shri Modi said they reviewed projects



for the construction of 4000 social housing units in Greater Male. He said India will

additionally provide financial support for 2000 social housing units. He said India has

decided to provide an additional line of credit of 100 million dollars so that all projects can be

completed in a time-bound manner.

Shri Modi highlighted that the threat of transnational crime, terrorism, and drug trafficking is serious in the Indian Ocean. He said that therefore, close contact and coordination between India and Maldives in the field of defense and security is vital for the peace and stability of the entire region.

## Self employment opportunity through PMEGP; individual above 18 years eligible under the scheme

Port Blair, Aug. 2

The Government of India has been implementing Prime Minister Employment Generation Programme (PMEGP) with the objectives to generate employment opportunities in rural as well as urban areas through setting up of new self-employment ventures, projects and micro enterprises. The purpose of the Scheme is for setting up of

eligible viable activities under the scheme. The nature of credit facility is term loan & cash credit facility only for new projects sanctioned specifically under the scheme.

Any individual, above 18 years of age is eligible under the scheme, there will be no income ceiling for assistance for setting up projects under PMEGP. The beneficiaries should be at least VIII

pass for setting up of project costing above Rs.10 lakhs in the manufacturing sector and Rs.5 lakhs in the business/service sector under the scheme. The rates of subsidy are 15% for the general category and 25% for the special category in urban area. Whereas 25% for the general category and 35% for the special category in rural area.

## Towards digitally empowered A&N Islands Rural Development Deptt. working with DoT to bring 4G connectivity to uncovered rural villages

Port Blair, Aug. 2

The Government of India has undertaken a vision to transform India into a digitally empowered society and knowledge economy which focuses mainly on availability of high-speed internet as a core utility for delivery of services to its citizens. In this connection, various initiatives towards establishing, 'Smart Gram Panchayats' are being undertaken by States/ UTs across the Country. To provide high bandwidth capacity, expansion of

mobile services and broadband connectivity in rural & remote areas, the Department of Telecom (DoT) is implementing the 'BharatNet Project' in phased manner.

In these Islands, there are still a large number of villages in the far-flung islands of Nancowry, Campbell Bay, Nicobar, Rangat and Diglipur which suffer due to poor mobile coverage. This largely affected the students of A&N Islands for accessing their classes and

resources online especially during the pandemic. Moreover, during that period the lockdown had put the country in the unique position, wherein, people were reluctant to move outside the protection of their homes. In this situation, online financial services became the safest option because it allows individuals to carry out online transactions from their homes which is not the case in these rural villages of the islands.

## 11932 lakh precautionary dose of vaccine administered in Isles

Port Blair, Aug. 2

The vaccination drive is continuing smoothly in A&N Islands. As per data available, a total of 6,93,118 doses of vaccine have been administered to beneficiaries in the age group of 18 and above so far.

Similarly, 23913 beneficiaries have been vaccinated in the age group of 15 to 18 years. 26,905 beneficiaries in the age group of 12 to 14 years have been administered both doses

of vaccine. The number of beneficiaries administered precautionary dose of vaccine so far stood at 111932.

A total of 6764 eligible beneficiaries were vaccinated in A&N Islands today. 4175 beneficiaries were vaccinated in South Andaman District, out of which, 14 beneficiaries were in the age group of 18 to 44 and the number of beneficiaries administered precautionary dose of

The Govt. of India has, therefore, as part of the Universal Service Obligation Fund (USOF) under Department of Telecommunications, launched a project to provide 4G Mobile Connectivity in the Union Territory along with installation of 124 towers for providing 4G mobile coverage to uncovered villages and also across the National Highways in Andaman & Nicobar Islands. M/s Reliance Jio Ltd. has been identified as the executing agency under the USOF project. The agency is in the process of preparing land allocation applications (forest, tribal, revenue land etc.) for USOF sites in A&N UT and was in need of NOCs from Gram Panchayats and Tribal Villages.

The Department of Rural Development is resolutely working hand in hand with the Department of Telecommunication to bring the 4G connectivity to the uncovered rural villages in its jurisdiction. Necessary NOCs have been obtained from the concerned Gram Panchayats and Tribal Villages and furnished to the Department of Telecom for installing 4G mobile towers in the approved USOF sites. With the introduction of 4G technology in uncovered villages, the residents will get seamless access to internet and other broadband services, especially the younger generation of mobile device users who can stream music, videos and movies at a much faster rate than ever before.

The 4G technology will have an even greater impact on people's lives, leading to changes in lifestyles and transforming their living environments, way of business and the social system. Even in times of disasters and calamities, people from far flung villages will be able to make contacts immediately from virtually anywhere, thereby improving the living standards, a press release from DCSA said.
