MURASOLI' MARAN 1934-2003

'MURASOU' MARAN played an important role in the dy namics of the Dravida Munnetra Kazhagam (DMK) in Tamil Nadu and national politics. He commanded respect in New Delhi as a Member of Parliamentand built up a formidable reputation as the Union Minister for Commerce and Industry. He was a Union Minister for Leave of 680 and the politics of the profile of the period of the commerce of the profile of the period of the peri portfolio when he died at the age of 69 after protracted illness, in Chennai on

after protracted interest, in critical survivals November 23.

Maran was the conscience-keeper of his maternal uncle and mentor, DMK president and former Chief Minister M. Karunanidhi. He was handpicked by Karunanidhi to be the handpicked by Karunanidhi ib be the party's face in New Delhi. He was continuously elected to the Lok Sabha or the Ray's a Sabha for 36 years from 1967 on the DMK ticket. Three top pditicalleaders of the day, Rajaji, DMK founder C. N. Annadura and Quald-Milleth of the Indian Union Muslim League, proposed Maran's name for the by election in 1967 to the South Madras Lok Sabha constituency, which fell vacant when Annadural resigned the seat to become Chief Minister. Maran was the architect of the DMKs political alliances in New Dehi. Hetrosaw quite early the shit tow ards multi-party coalitions from

That Maran pitched for the BJP was not a surprise because at a personal level, he was not allergic to it. He had even declared that "no party is untouchable". He once told this correspondent, "The BJP is the most cardier-based party after the DMK." In his aubbiography Nenjukku Needhi (Julsice to the Hearth), which was serialised in the Tamil daily Murasol, it po DMK capgan, Karumanhi recalls how C.M. He told the developed nations frate they could nothope to have ns that they could not hope to have non-tariffbarriers in agriculture with high subsidies to their farmers while Third World countries were asked to dismantle their subsidy regime. Maran is a writer of repute in Tamil. His book Manila Suy atchi (State Autonomy), published in 1974, is a seminal work on the demand for State autonomy, federalism and various aspects of Centre-State relations. In his foreword to the book, Dravidal yakka Varalaru, which was first published in September 1991. Maran attems to noviect the history. first published in September 1991, Maran attempts to project the history of the Drav idian movement in an accessible format to the DMK cadre and prov ide them an ideological bearing. Maran had completed about three-fourths of he second volume of the book before he fell ill. Another book on the Dravidian movement

writen by him is En Vendum Inbath Dravidam? (Why Do We Need This Pleasurable Dravidam?) He authored most of the election manifestoes of the DMK rightfrom 1977. He had a hand in the drafting of the Common Minimum Programme of the United Front government and the National Agenda for Gov ernance of the NDA government.







in the arm when in October 2021 the Civil Av iation Minister Jyotiradity a Scindia announced a new helicopter policy at the Helicopter Summitorganised by the industry body FICCI in Dehradun. Under this policy besides many other norms dedicated hubs and corridors would be established and landing charges and parking deposits abolished to boost commercial

abolished to boost commercial helicopter operations in the country.

Under the new policy, the government will put together a dedicated helicopter acceleration cell in the CivilAviaton Ministry hatwill look at helicopter industry's issues.

Look at helicopter industry's issues. As part of flepolicy there will be no landing charges or parking deposits to heliports or helicopter companies. To begin with four Heli Hubs and Training Units will be set up in Mumbai, Guwarta Ebalii, and Bengaturuand helicopter comdors will be set up in 10 cities and 82 routes in the country. Experts withwhom THE WEEK spoke found that the helicopter policy and development of heli hubs is the need of the hourtogive a push of the slow moving civilian helicopter sector in the country. "Since the first civil helcopter book to he sikes in Indiain November 1953 the commercial use of helicopters in Irdia was limited to small aviation companies involved in communication and crop spraying until 1986. The formation of the Helicopter Corporation of India in 1986 (later

Paw an Hans Helicopters Ltd), was the turning point in the civil helicopter industry in India. Though Paw an Hans now holds and operates the largest fiele of helicopters in the country, it could only add a mere 292 units during its 26 years period up to 2012. Post that the firm began facing tough times due to higher cost of operations and regulatory norms," remarked former pilot.

Interestingly if one goes by the numbers India at present has only 266 civil registered helicopters in the country, operating with non scheduled operators, private category, government (central and state) and PSUs. The Non-Scheduled Operators hold the major chunk of helicopters in numbers (200 plus) the balance operate under the category of private and Government and PSUs. Surprisingly his numberis very less compared to the global statistics.

"As per he available data, the ball divil helicopter across he world is more than 34,000 and lindia accounts for less than one percent. India currently has very few civil helicopters compared to advanced countries like Switzerland. Even Brazil, which is one of the

developing countries, is muchahead of India inhelicoptars. The Brazilancity of Sao Paulo alonehas 750 helicopters. But despite allodds the market and industry in India remain optimistic. The establishment offinit ventures in India by helicopter manufacturing firms like AgustaWestand, Skorsky and Eurocopter are positive moves," remarked aviation and aerospace expert Girish Lingarnaw ho is also

A majority of helicopters in India are used in the energy sector, both onshore and offshore. The remaining are used in communication, medical evacuation (air taxi or ambulance

The helicopters are gauged by their performance criteria, which is speed, safety, reliability etc. The single engine helicopters such as Eurocapter C1:31 AS350, BELL 407, Robinson R-66 and AW109 are the most nonularones and are currently ASSO, BELL 407, ROUTISOTIR-06 and AW tog are the most popular ones and are currently in use in India. The medium twin engine AW 139, AW 169, BELL 412 and Sikorsky S-76 are in demand in the energy sector considering their safety aspects. The next in

The next in line are the multi engine helicopters, which are most ty used in the defence sector considering their high oper atonal cost and specialised features, "added Linganna.
