Three days National Conference of State Tourism Ministers held at Dharamshala

National Flag to be installed at all Hotels & tourist places in the country: Minister

New Delhi, Sept. 21 (PIB)

The three days National Conference of State Tourism Ministers at Dharamshala, Himachal Pradesh concluded yesterday in the presence of Union Tourism Minister, Shri G. Kishan Reddy. Tourism Ministers of various States attended the conference.

During concluding remarks, Shri G Kishan Reddy thanked all the State delegates and sector representatives for their valuable suggestions. Shri Reddy urged that all States share and adopt best practices to boost the tourism sector. States

must organise such conferences at State level with district officers of different Departments and stakeholders to improve and promote tourism destinations. Shri Reddy emphasised on the importance of Yuva Tourism Clubs and said these clubs can become game changer for the sector. Shri Reddy also informed that National Flag will be installed at tourist places. He also appealed to the States and stakeholders to install flag at all hotels and tourist places. The Union Minister said that such conferences will be organised from time to time to provide an



opportunity to learn from one another and hoped that this will yield desired results very soon.

Talking about the outcome of the conference, Secretary, Tourism, Shri Arvind Singh said India will play a pivotal role in contributing towards global tourism recovery

driven mainly through domestic tourism. All the major tourism indices have started showing signs of recovery towards the pre pandemic levels such as domestic air passenger traffic, hotel occupancy and tourist footfalls. The National Tourism Policy has been drafted with a

holistic vision and strategy to revive India's Tourism and targets to achieve USD 1 Trillion by the sector in 2047. Against this backdrop, the Ministry is also paving the way for developing responsible and sustainable tourism destinations. The Government of India will continue to support MSMEs in tourism and capitalise on the employment generation potential in the sector. Various initiatives under the ongoing schemes of the Ministry of Tourism are planned to be strengthened to ensure complete recovery from the disruption caused to the

tourism economy due to the pandemic. Informing about the goals for the India Tourism Sector for 2024, he said that we will strive to recover to pre-pandemic level by mid 2024. The country is estimated to achieve 50 Bn USD GDP contribution from Tourism, 30 Bn USD in Foreign Exchange Earnings and 15 Mn foreign arrivals by 2024. He further said that India is estimated to grow at 7-9% CAGR in the coming decade and 250 Bn USD GDP contribution from Tourism, 137 Mn jobs in the Tourism sector, 56

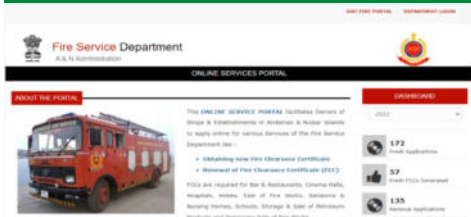
COVID-19 status in A&N Islands

for North & Middle Andaman at Ferrargunj, no positive case has been detected. At Phoenix Bay Jetty, 18 passengers were tested with RAT and no positive case has been detected. RAT was also conducted on 9 passengers at Mohanpura Bus Terminus and no positive case has been detected, a press release from IP&T said.

Mayabunder, Sept. 21

A&N Administration is committed towards the welfare of the Islanders and it will leave no stone unturned to resolve the issues and aspirations of the people of North & Middle Andaman region. Genuine issues/ demands highlighted by the people of the area, will be attended to on priority for its time bound redressal, said the Chief Secretary, A&N Administration, Shri Keshav Chandra, IAS during an interaction meeting held with the

PRIs and Head of Offices in the Panchayat Hall, Pokadera, Mayabunder today.

The Chief Secretary, who is currently on his third day visit to N&M Andaman District, took note of the grievances pertaining to various sectors which were highlighted by PRIs from different Gram Panchayats of Mayabunder area.

Opening the sectoral discussions, the Chief Secretary emphasized the need to understand the geographical

disadvantages, limitations of funds, shortage of manpower and technical capabilities of executing agencies. He explained that nation-wide there is shortage of manpower including Andamans, which cannot be filled overnight. The Heads of critical service Departments like Education, Health, Electricity, APWD were advised to work out some immediate solution to fill the gaps in remote part of the Islands and also to take strict action against the under performing

Govt. Servants and those reluctant to join or work in remote part of the Islands. The PRIs were also advised to remotely monitor and inform the Heads of Department in case any Govt. servant posted in their area fails to render desired services.

On the issue of scarcity of drinking water during dry spell to meet the ever increasing demand, the Chief Secretary instructed the concerned officials and PRIs to identify more water bodies/ water sources to find a permanent

solution. He further directed the officials of APWD to prepare detailed action plan and priority list in consultation with the PRIs.

Regarding the issue of poor road condition, the Chief Secretary informed that NHIDCL officials have assured that they will complete the critical stretch between Sitanagar and Kalara Jn. within two months time. He further informed that the works taken up under PMGSY have now been transferred to APWD and the PRI

members will be intimated as soon as the road work is sanctioned for their respective Panchayats. On the issue of shortage of LPG Cylinders, the Chief Secretary said that the Administration will resolve the issue and efforts are also on to increase the capacity of the LPG Bottling Plant for a permanent solution.

Inspecting the Karmatang Beach area where two eco-friendly resorts are to be developed under the aegis of NITI Aayog, the






