

ISRO to move operational activities to NSIL, to focus on R&D, says its Chairman

Bengaluru, Nov. 07: The "connection" between the ISRO and scientific organisations in the country need to be scaled up to create greater research and development activities in space technology, Mr. Somanath said.

The Indian Space Research Organisation (ISRO) would move its operational activities to its marketing arm NewSpace India Limited (NSIL) and

focus on research and development in the area of advanced space technologies in the coming years, its Chairman S. Somanath said on Monday.

He said the ISRO has over the years been focusing more on delivering applications for the government and the public; having created systems, and building, launching and operating satellites, providing communication, earth

observation and navigation services.

Following the government directives, all those operational activities would now move to NSIL, also a central public sector enterprise under the Department of Space (DoS), Mr. Somanath said in his address to a function marking the launch of platinum jubilee year celebrations of the Raman Research Institute (RRI)

Indian Army's operational readiness should always be at peak: Rajnath Singh to force commanders

NEW DELHI, NOV. 09: The Defence Minister commended the force for maintaining a high operational readiness towards ensuring security and national sovereignty.

say, the 1st April, 2023, the 1st July, 2023, or the 1st October, 2023, may also file his or her claim for inclusion of his or her name in the Electoral Roll, in Form-6, in advance, and the same shall be considered and decided in the respective quarter of the year with reference to the respective qualifying date. Similarly, data of any eligible PwDs voters in A&N Islands should also be shared with the Electoral Officers for inclusion. Any issues or grievance can be addressed to the Electoral Team, the CEO said.

CEO also urged representatives of political parties to urge voters to check and verify the data provided and if any changes are to be made it can be

intimated to the respective BLAs. BLOs have been directed to conduct awareness camps and nukkadnataks among general public regarding the special summary revision for its wide publicity. As per the draft roll published, the A&N Islands has 3,04,413 voters, out of which 1,59,923 are male voters, 1,44,479 are female voters and 11 are transgenders. The gender ratio is 903.

The CEO while explaining the schedule of the Special Summary Revision-2023 informed that the publication of Integrated Draft Electoral Roll commenced today and the period for filing claims and objection is from Nov. 9 to Dec. 8, 2022 while the

Special Camps will be held on Nov. 26 & 27 and Dec. 3 & 4, 2022. Disposal of claims and objections will be held on Dec. 26, 2022 and final publication of electoral roll will be on Jan. 5, 2023. He said, to have a correct electoral roll, the Special Summary Revision-2023 is important. He said, all applications received on CEO's website on day to day basis shall be shared with recognized Political Parties in order to bring more transparency in the process of electoral registration.

The CEO also handed over copies of the draft electoral rolls to the representative of recognized political parties who were present during the meeting, a press release said.

NMMSS Examination in A&N Islands on 17th Dec, 2022

Port Blair, Nov 9: The State Institute of Education, Port Blair will be conducting the NMMSS Examination in A&N Islands on 17th December, 2022 under the guidance of Ministry of Education (MoE). The selection test/ examination will be conducted to select students presently studying in Class VIII for award of Scholarship under the centrally sponsored scheme 'National Means-cum-Merit Scholarship Scheme' (NMMSS) for the academic session 2022-2023.

Students who have secured minimum 55% marks or equivalent Grade in class VII examinations (relaxable by 5% for SC/ST candidates), presently studying in Class VIII (Eighth) in Government, Govt.-Aided and Local Body Schools of State/ UT and whose parental income does not exceed Rs.3.5 Lakh per annum from all sources are eligible to appear in NMMSS Examination.

The students of Kendriya Vidyalayas, Jawahar Navodaya Vidyalayas and Residential Schools run by State Government and Private unaided Schools are not eligible for scholarship under the National Means-cum-Merit Scholarship Scheme (NMMSS).

For NMMSS

examinations, students have to produce mark statements of the qualifying examinations (i.e. Mark statement of class -VII for NMMSS examination). To appear in the NMMSS Examination students should produce parental income certificates issued from Revenue Authority not below the rank of Tehsildar concerned with their application forms. Category certificate are also to be produced by the candidates who come under reserved categories.

The Army said the Defence Minister commended the force for maintaining a high operational readiness towards ensuring security and national sovereignty.

"I have full faith and confidence in the Indian Army and its leadership," he said. The Defence Minister also noted that the Army ought to be prepared for any operational contingencies and hence, the operational readiness should always be at its peak level.

Mr. Singh also referred to the stellar role played by the

Army in guarding the country's borders and fighting terrorism, apart from providing assistance to the civil administration whenever called for.

The Defence Minister complimented the forces for the high standard of operational preparedness and capabilities, which he has been experiencing first-hand during his visits to forward areas, according to the Army.

"He commended the Army's efforts to develop niche technologies in collaboration with civil industries, including premier educational institutions, and thereby progressing towards the aim of 'modernisation through indigenisation' or 'Aatmanirbharta' [self-reliance]," it said in a statement.

Conference is an apex-level biannual event that is held in April and October or November every year.

The conference is an institutional platform for conceptual-level deliberations, culminating in making important policy decisions for the Indian Army.

students in different schools are also suffering heavily due to frequent power cuts in the South Andaman region during school hours, considering the hot and humid season.

The Member of Parliament mentioned that power cuts are also causing huge problems in G B Pant Hospital as due to insufficient power backup many medical equipment and expensive machines could not be operated in the desired manner, which could be a threat to the patients.

He pointed out that small and Medium business owners, who can't afford generators, are also equally hit by frequent power cuts as they are witnessing heavy loss in business because during power cuts they are unable to operate computers and other machines. He added that people of every sector are going through huge problems due to such frequent power cuts, which amounts to around 8 to 10 power cuts a day, combined with voltage fluctuations.

"On Large Scale Corruption and Siphoning Off Huge Amount from A&N Islands to Mainland": CPI (M)

Port Blair, Nov 09: 'The meeting of the Andaman & Nicobar State Organising Committee of CPI (M) held on 5th November, 2022 at Port Blair observes with grave concern and anguish that corruption is increasing in these islands with the overt or covert patronage of the BJP-led government at the centre. During the last 2 - 3 years, particularly during the tenure of the rape accused former Chief Secretary, the corruption was at its zenith with the allegations of large scale collection of money from the businessmen and others by some of the officials of the Administration. The meeting observed that there was allegations of corruption of in grant of Bar licenses, renewal of bar licenses, quarry licenses, purchase of buses in the Transport Department, etc. It was alleged in the media that

about 300 to 400 crores of rupees have been siphoned off to mainland during the last 2 years. CPI (M) observes that one or two official cannot be solely held responsible for it as the money might have gone to the political bosses in Delhi. In this context, allowing the former Chief Secretary in the post for more than 17 months despite knowing that he was allegedly indulging in corrupt, unethical and illegal activities, by the BJP government at the centre speak voluminous about the nefarious activities of the political-bureaucratic combine in the islands. The meeting noted that instead of taking action against the officers concerned, the central government continued to protect such corrupt officers which implies the allegations as true that the political bosses on the mainland are also

beneficiaries of such large scale corruption taken place in the islands during the last 2 - 3 years.

CPI (M) is of the view that a thorough investigation into the corrupt practices indulged in by the officers and siphoning of large scale money to mainland should be investigated by CBI to bring to fore the people involved in it and to send a strong signal that people of these islands will no longer tolerate politically-backed corruption by bureaucrats during their tenure in these peaceful and historic islands. Therefore, CPI (M) meeting called upon the central government to conduct a CBI probe into the allegations of corruption and siphoning off large amount of money to mainland during the last 3 years particularly during the period of the rape accused former Chief Secretary' the CPI (M), a press release says.
