US-based economists win 2021 Nobel Prize for Economics

Stockholm, Oct. 11

Three US-based economists have won the 2021 Nobel Prize in the field of economics for pioneering the use of "natural experiments" to understand the causal effects of economic policy and other events. They were Economists David Card of the University of California at Berkeley, Joshua Angrist from the Massachusetts Institute of Technology; and Guido Imbens from Stanford University. Ensuring availability of quality medicines for Islanders

Chief Secretary directs to lift the samples of medicines for Quality testing at undisclosed Mainland Laboratories

Health Deptt. collects random samples of Allopathic, Ayurvedic & Homeopathic Medicines for test

Port Blair, Oct. 11

The Chief Secretary, A & N Administration, Shri Jitendra Narain recently reviewed the procurements and Quality Control mechanism of Allopathic, Ayurvedic and Homeopathic medicines under the Health Department. He directed the Health Authorities to send the samples of medicines periodically for quality testing at Govt. approved undisclosed laboratories in mainland. This is to ensure that the Islanders are provided quality medicines. Quality medicine is important and therefore, nobody will play with the lives of the Island

people.

Accordingly, a number of random samples of Allopathic, Ayurvedic and Homeopathic medicines have been collected by the respective Drug Inspectors of Drugs Control Cell. A total of 20 samples were collected and sealed concealing the name of the manufacturing company and have been sent to the designated laboratories in different parts of the country. The Allopathic samples consisted of various categories viz. tablets, syrups and injections; and Ayurvedic samples included Tailam, Kashayam, Arishtam, Vati Churna etc., while Homeopathic samples contained biochemics,

dilutions etc.

This mechanism of periodical quality checks of medicines under the Directorate of Health Services will continue and samples will be lifted regularly and periodically as per the direction of the Chief Secretary.

Under the leadership of the Chief Secretary, the UT Administration is committed to provide Quality Health Care to the public and also to ensure availability of good quality medicines of all systems across the Islands as per the norms of Govt. of India, a press release from Health Deptt. said.

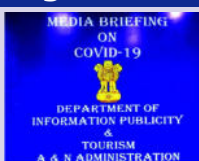

Farmers' Corner- A Knowledge Hub

Mangiferanicobarica - an endemic wild mango species of Nicobar

Mangiferanicobarica is a rare, endemic species of South Nicobar region having better adaptation and potential use in crop improvement. The species has been reported closely allied to *M. andamanica* and *M. quadrifida* but differs from them for leaf and floral characteristics. The trees of the species are tall, reaching about 20 m height with spreading canopy habit. The branches of the tree are reddish brown with oblong or oblanceolate leaves. Flowers are white or yellowish in colour and fruits are medium sized and the fruit weight ranges from 80 to 150g. The fruit peels greenish in colour at unripe stage and turns to yellow or purplish on ripening. The fruit pulp is aromatic, yellow or deep yellow in colour and fibrous. The taste of the fruit is sweet and consumed by the Nicobari communities of the island. This species has been collected from Great Nicobar through joint exploration by ICAR-CIARI and ICAR-NBPGR and is conserved at ICAR-CIARI with IC No 630971. The trees of this endemic wild mango species is sporadically seen in the region and hence more efforts are needed to conserve them in various field gene banks for further utilization to realize the potential use for crop improvement in mango for traits such as aroma, taste, climate resilience etc as the species is adaptable to the fragile island ecosystems.

Benefit: *M. nicobarica* can be a potential rootstock and as source of desirable traits for breeding commercial mango varieties. Hence this genetic resource should be conserved.

planned, integrated economic strategy. A strategy that will make India a global manufacturing powerhouse by enhancing the skills capabilities of India's entrepreneurs and India's youth. A strategy that will make India a global centre of innovations, based on India's technological expertise. He added that it is a strategy, which will play a big role in global development, enhancing the prestige of India's human resources and talent, globally.

The Prime Minister said the Government is moving ahead with a clear policy regarding public sector enterprises and is opening most of these sectors to private enterprises where the Government is not required. The decision regarding Air India shows our commitment and seriousness, he said. The Prime Minister said that, during the last 7 years, space technology has been converted into a tool of last-mile delivery and leakage-free, transparent governance. He gave examples of the use of geotagging in housing units for the poor, roads and infrastructure projects. Development projects are being monitored by satellite imaging. The space technology is being used in settlement of Fasal Bima Yojna claims, NAVIC system is helping fishermen, disaster management planning is also being carried out through this technology, the Prime Minister informed. The Prime Minister emphasized the importance of making technology accessible to everyone. Giving an example of digital technology, he said that India is among the top digital economies today because we could make the power of data accessible to the poorest of the poor.

The Prime Minister noted how the 20th-century tendency of trying to rule the space and the space sector, divided the countries of the world. Now in the 21st century, India will have to ensure that space plays an important role in uniting and connecting the world, he concluded.

with both doses while RT-PCR test was conducted on remaining 455 passengers and the reports are awaited.

The Director further mentioned that RAT was conducted on 280 passengers bound for North & Middle Andaman at Ferrargunj and no positive case has been detected. Apart from this, RAT was conducted on 49 passengers travelling to & fro to Shaheed/Swaraj Dweep at Phoenix Bay Jetty and no positive case has been detected. At Mohanpura Bus Terminus, test was conducted on 144 passengers and all were found negative. At helipad, test was conducted on 11 passengers and no positive case has been detected. Today, till 3 pm, 463 persons were administered doses of vaccines, out of which, 437 were in the age group of 18-44.

The Director (ANIIMS), Dr. AK Mandal informed that 4 COVID patients are undergoing treatment at GB Pant Hospital.

discouraged. In case idols are to be painted, water soluble and non-toxic natural dyes are to be used. There shall be a complete ban on the use of synthetic colour for painting of idols that would require immersion as part of final ritual of the festival.

Materials used in worship like flowers, vastras (clothes), decorative materials (made of paper and plastic) etc. should be removed before immersion of idols. Biodegradable materials should be collected separately for recycling or composting at designated sites whereas the non-biodegradable materials should be collected separately for disposal in sanitary landfills or as prescribed by the local Municipal Authority or local body. Clothes may be sent to local orphanage(s). Idol Immersion should be done between low tide line and high tide line (irrespective of its depth) in identified places with permission of District Administration only. Single use plastic should not be used during celebration, a press release from Member Secretary, Andaman and Nicobar Pollution Control Committee said.
