### Vessel equipped with 'Safe Return to Port' compliance which is envisaged to be 'first' in Asia

Port Blair, Aug. 13

The second in the series of two 1200 Pax capacity passenger vessel named 'Atal' under construction in Cochin Shipyard Limited (CSL) for the Andaman & Nicobar Administration was launched yesterday at CSL's Kochi shipyard.

The vessel was launched by Smt. Rameetha K, Scientist 'G', NPOL (DRDO) wife of Shri Madhu S Nair, CMD, CSL.

The Vessel named 'Atal' is designed as a modern high-quality passenger vessel with electric propulsion



suitable for carrying 1200 passengers and 1000T cargo for 'all-weather' operation. The ship is built to the highest standards of the Indian Register of Shipping and Lloyd's Register of Shipping overseen by the DG Shipping of India and

meets the requirements of 'Class III Special Trade Passenger Ship' as per Indian Merchant Shipping rules. The specialty of this vessel is that it comes with 'Safe Return to Port' (SRT) compliance which is envisaged to be a 'first'

The main stakeholders of LGD are the State Panchayati Raj Department, State Urban Department, State Revenue Department, or any other Department of the State

## National seminar on India's Independence movement held at JNRM

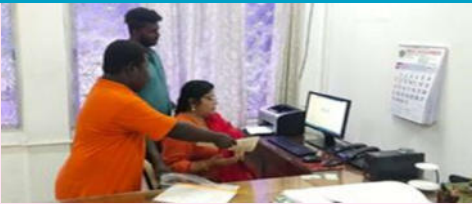
Port Blair, Aug. 13

Out of the total 400 pre-litigation cases including 158 pre-litigation BSNL recovery cases and 935 cases pending in different courts at Port Blair were referred to the National Lok Adalat, out of which, 36 pre-litigation bank recovery cases, 4 pre-litigation BSNL recovery cases and 923 Criminal cases including 1 bank recovery case were disposed of by the National Lok Adalat at Port Blair. Disposing of 36 bank recovery cases, the involved amount of Rs. 1,03,36,897/- have been settled at Rs.81,50,084/-. A sum of Rs.1,27,000/- was realized on the spot. Disposing of 04 BSNL recovery cases, the involved amount of Rs. 10,13,212.10/- was settled at Rs. 2,47,000/- and Rs. 17,000/- was realized on the spot. Disposing of 922 Criminal cases a sum of Rs. 47,850/- was realized as fine.  
In Mayabunder, one bench was constituted and 39 pre-litigation BSNL cases were referred, out of which, 9 pre-litigation BSNL cases were disposed of and settled at Rs. 28,000/-. 32 cases pending in different courts were taken up, out of which, 30 criminal compoundable cases were disposed of and a fine amount of Rs. 52,600/- was realized. In Diglipur, two benches were constituted and 155 pre-litigation cases were referred, out of which, 19 pre-litigation cases were disposed of and settled at Rs. 3,91,000/-. 40 cases pending in different courts were taken up, out of which, 19 criminal compoundable cases were disposed of and a fine amount of Rs. 38,350/- was realized.

in Asia. The ship would not only enable safe & comfortable passenger movement, but will also be a boost to the tourism sector.  
The vessel of about 157 Mtr long has modern cafeteria and recreation rooms with accommodation consisting of Deluxe Cabins, First Class Cabins, Second Class Cabin and Bunk Class facility. With a speed of 18 knots, the ship combines speed with comfort and would have a complement of 104 staff. The vessel will now undergo further outfitting of all machinery, the accommodation & living quarters, after which it will undergo testing & sea trials prior to delivery to the A&N Islands.  
This vessel is part of the order for a series of 4 vessels viz; 02 nos 500 pax cum 150T cargo vessels already delivered and 02 nos 1200 pax cum 1000T cargo vessels, placed on CSL by the A&N Administration under the Government of India's 'Make In India' policy.  
Once deployed, these vessels will bring better connectivity and best in class travel experience to the Islanders for their needs, a press release from CSL said.

which is responsible for the formation of new districts, sub-districts/Tehsils, villages, panchayats, or any other type of Local Government bodies.  
The Directorate of RD and PRIs and ULBs is the Nodal Department for overseeing the implementation of LGD in the Islands. The Department has defined the Local Government setup (panchayats/urban local bodies/traditional bodies) that is applicable in the UT of Andaman & Nicobar Islands. All the revenue and other forest villages under Andaman and Nicobar Islands have been defined in the LGD Directory. These villages have been mapped with the wards, and all the wards are mapped with the Gram Panchayats or Urban Local Bodies. All the above is hierarchically mapped under the districts.  
The Department has also generated unique code for each local body, Department, ward, etc. These unique codes have been adopted by all the other modules of the Panchayat Enterprises Suite (PES). The Department has also captured the organization structure as well as the designation of Central and State Departments and the organizations associated with them. To report issues and discrepancies, the Department has deputed State Nodal Officers for Panchayats, Urban Local Bodies, and Revenue. The details of State Nodal Officers (Panchayats/urban local bodies/revenue) are also updated in the LGD portal.  
In a review meeting conducted by the Ministry of Panchayati Raj, Govt. of India yesterday, the Secretary, Ministry of Panchayati Raj applauded the efforts of the UT Administration in its effort to implement the Local Government Directory (LGD) in the Islands with Zero Discrepancy, a press release from Secretary (RD) said.

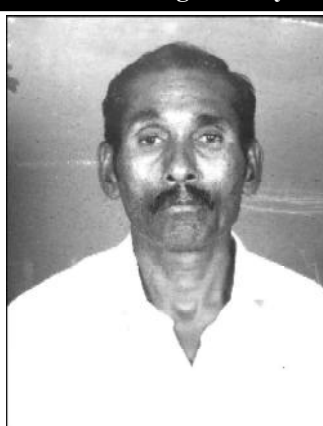

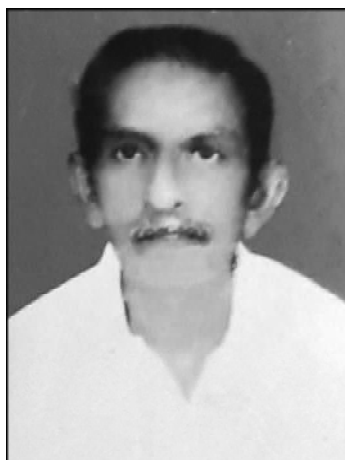

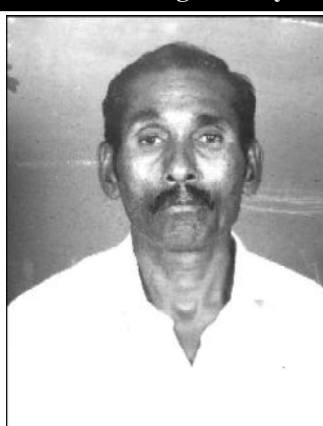
